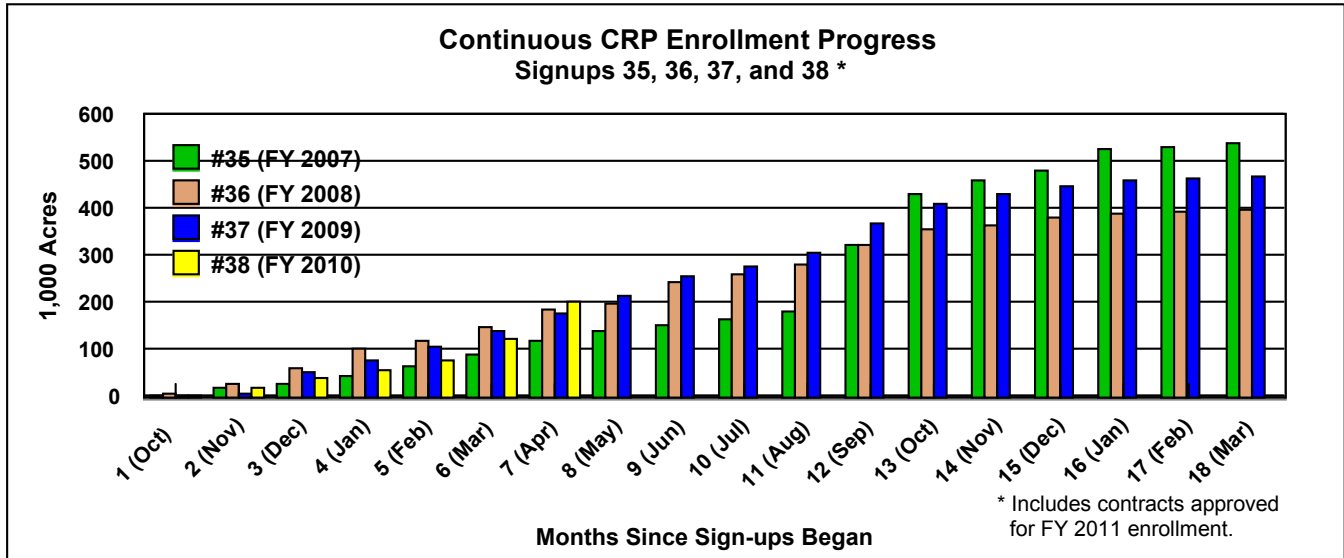

CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS –April 2010

- There are now 44,201 acres under signup 38 contracts that are approved for FY 2011 enrollment. This complicates the tables because some of these acres represent double counting if they are a re-enrollment of a FY 2010 expiring contract. Table and chart footnotes explain whether the FY 2011 contracts are included or not.
- On February 27th, the Secretary announced the expansion of acreage allocated to 3 continuous signup initiatives. State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement (SAFE) was increased 150,000 acres, Upland Bird Habitat Buffers was increased 100,000 acres, and Duck Nesting Habitat was increased by 50,000 acres.
- Early enrollments of the new FWP practices have been recorded. There are 3,981 acres of aquaculture wetlands (CP40) mostly in Louisiana and Mississippi, and 11,428 acres of flooded prairie wetlands (CP41), primarily in the Dakotas (p. 21).
- Sign-up 38 (FY 2010 continuous sign-up) increased 84,000 acres in April to 202,000 acres. Last year signup 37 had enrolled 176,000 acres through April. SAFE increased about 50,000 acres.
- FY 2009 enrollment ended at 33.72 million acres. Following the expiration of 2.79 million acres, FY 2010 began with 30.93 million acres under contract. Adding 341,000 acres under contracts approved since October 2009 puts enrollment at the end of April at 31.28 million acres, a net decline of 2.44 million acres from September (p. 16).

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 44 agreements in 33 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and the new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through April 30, 2010, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct mis-coded data in the active contract files.

Note: Contracts re-enrolled under 2006's re-enrollment and extension offer (REX) are not considered to expire when the current contracts expire, because new contracts will begin immediately after expiration.
