



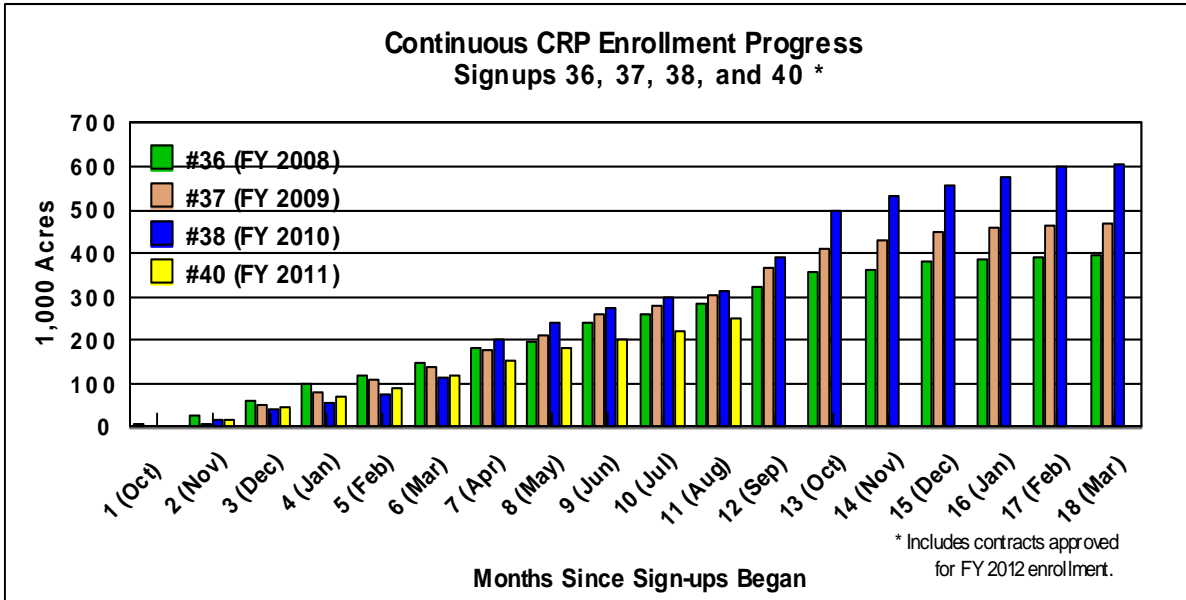

CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM

ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – August 2011

- FY 2011 general signup (#41) ended with 2.8 million acres approved for enrollment. Offers were received on 3.8 million acres. A table with preliminary approvals is located at: http://www.fsa.usda.gov/Internet/FSA_File/crpsignupresults.pdf
- FY 2011 continuous signup (#40) added 30,407 acres in July and now totals 249,271 acres. This is 64,000 acres below last year at this time.
- Enrollment either increased or decreased in August depending on whether you include acreage under contracts that do not start until FY 2012. Not counting contracts that start in FY 2012, CRP enrollment declined by 17,649 acres during August. Counting contracts starting in FY 2012, enrollment increased by 8,901 acres during August, as general signup enrollment declined by 20,458 acres (dropouts) and continuous signup increased 29,359 acres.
- In August, the Department re-allocated the State Acres for Wildlife (SAFE) initiative acreage limits and allocated an additional 107,000 acres out of reserve to various State SAFE projects.
- Also in August, the acreage allocation for Kansas' Upper Arkansas River CREP was expanded from 20,000 to 28,950 acres.

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Lands enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 45 agreements in 33 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through the end of August 2011, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct miscoded data in the active contract files.
