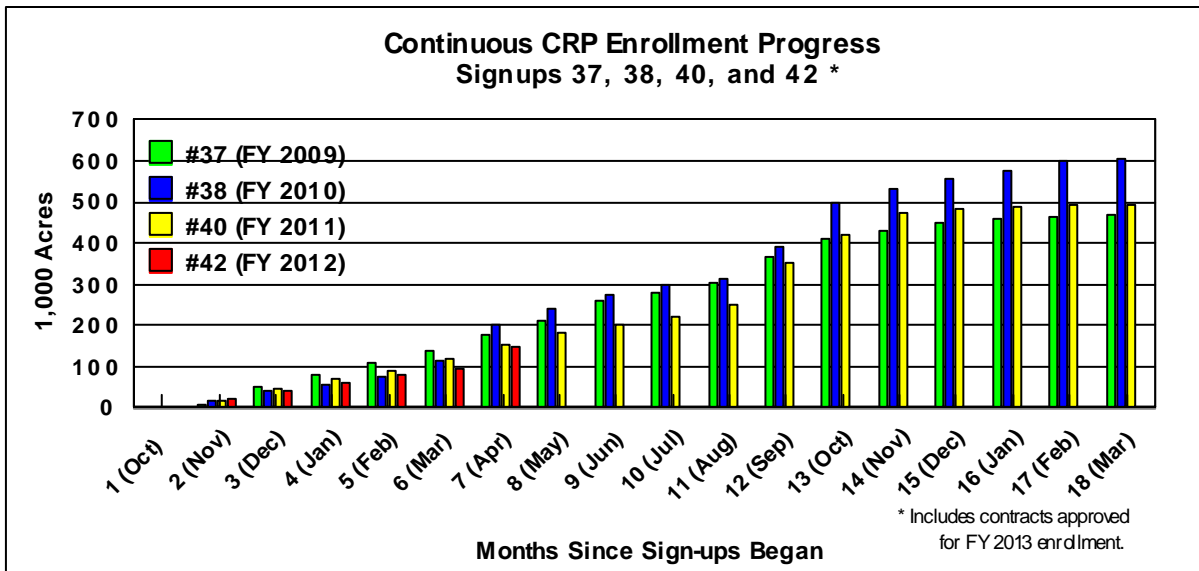

CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM

ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – April 2012

- April ended with enrollment at 29.6 million acres, unchanged from March.
- A general signup (#43) was held March 12 through April 13.
- FY 2012 continuous signup (#42) added 53,108 acres in April and now totals 148,310 acres, nearly matching last year's 152,709 acres through April. Acres added in April include 49,755 acres under FY 2013 contracts, which do not yet "count" as enrolled and are not included in the 29.6 million acres currently enrolled.
- A continuous signup initiative was announced that will target enrollment of 750,000 acres of cropland with erodibility index rating of 20 or above.
- Another continuous signup initiative will add 1,000,000 acres to be allocated among various wildlife and wetland initiatives, including 400,000 acres of State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement (SAFE). States invited to submit proposals for new or amended SAFE projects.
- Announced amendments to Arkansas' Illinois River CREP, including increased incentives and reduced acreage authority.

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Lands enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 45 agreements in 33 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through the end of April 2012, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct miscoded data in the active contract files.
