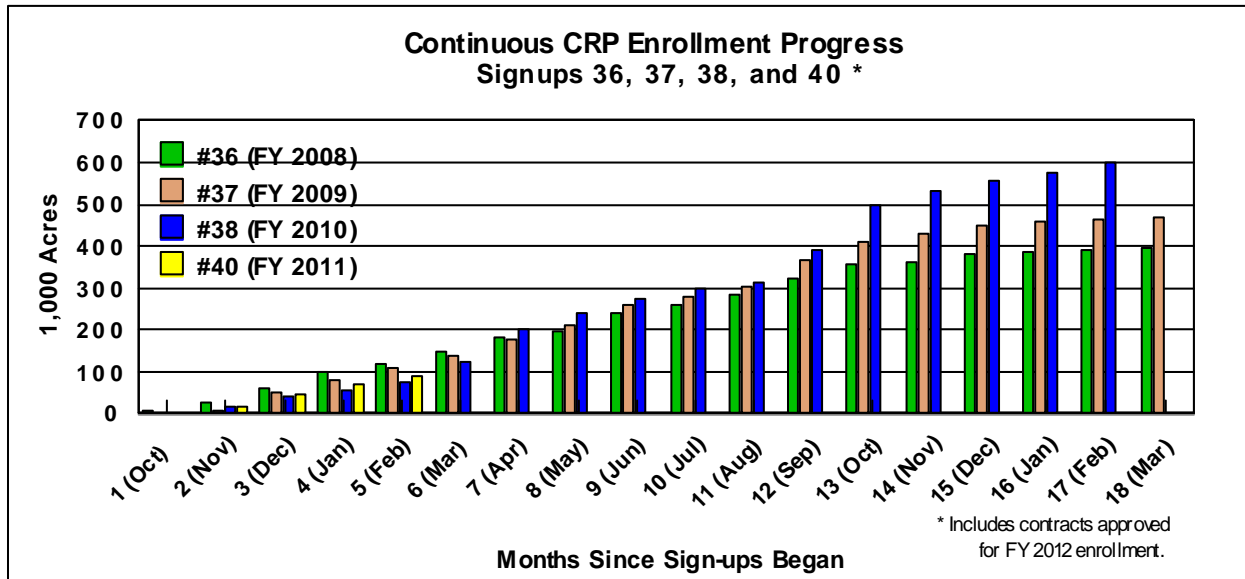

CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS –February 2011

- It now looks like 2010’s general signup (#39) will end up with about 4.0 million acres. State and county books, based on the 4.3 million acres preliminarily approved for enrollment, are posted at:

- The FY 2010 continuous signup (#38) added 25,841 acres in February and now totals 601,827 acres, about 130,000 acres more than last year’s continuous signup.
- FY 2011 continuous signup (#40) added 20,855 acres in February and now totals 89,606 acres.
- Secretary Vilsack announced that there will be a general signup starting March 14th.

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 44 agreements in 33 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through February 25, 2011, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct miscoded data in the active contract files.
