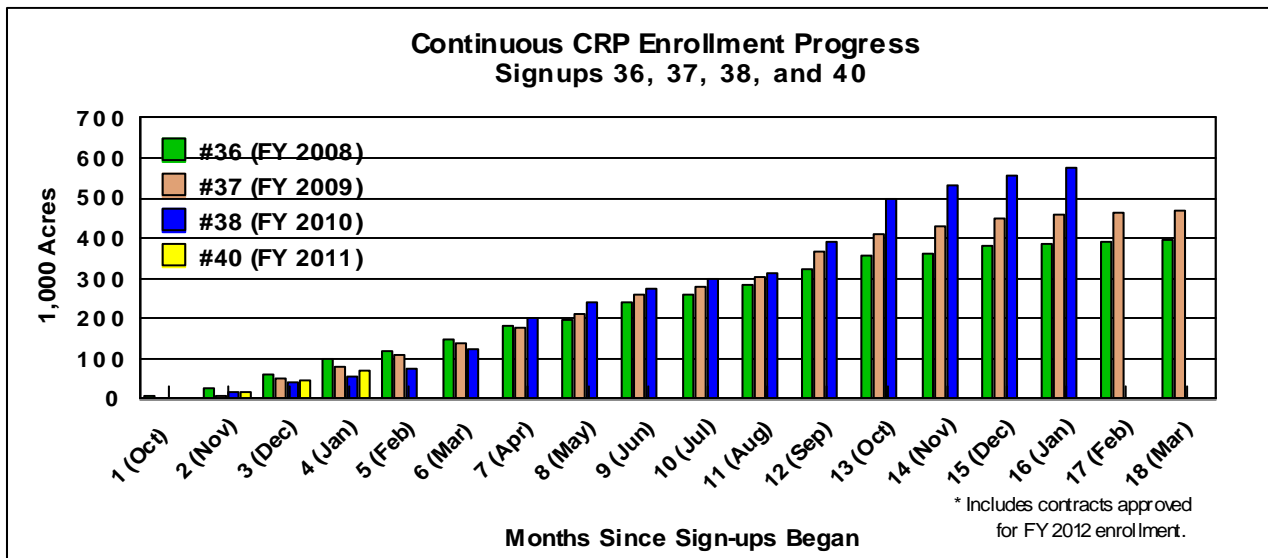

CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS –January 2011

- Contracts approved during the recently concluded general signup (#39) begin in FY 2011 and 3.9 million acres have been entered into the active contract file so far. 4.3 million acres were preliminarily approved for enrollment. Signup 39 State and county books, based on the 4.3 million acres, are posted at: <http://www.fsa.usda.gov/FSA/webapp?area=home&subject=copr&topic=crp>
- It now looks like signup 39 will end up with about 4.0 million acres under contract. Assuming an additional 100,000 acres from signup 39 had been approved, but not recorded as of January 31, current enrollment (at the end of January 2011) would be 31.2 million acres.
- There are now 575,987 acres of FY 2010 continuous signup (#38) contracts approved, about 115,000 acres ahead of last year's continuous signup. Signup 38 is now projected to end up at around 580,000 acres.
- FY 2011 continuous signup (#40) added 23,045 acres in January and now totals 68,751 acres.
- Secretary Vilsack announced that there will be a general signup starting March 14th.

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 44 agreements in 33 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through end of January, 2011, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct miscoded data in the active contract files.
