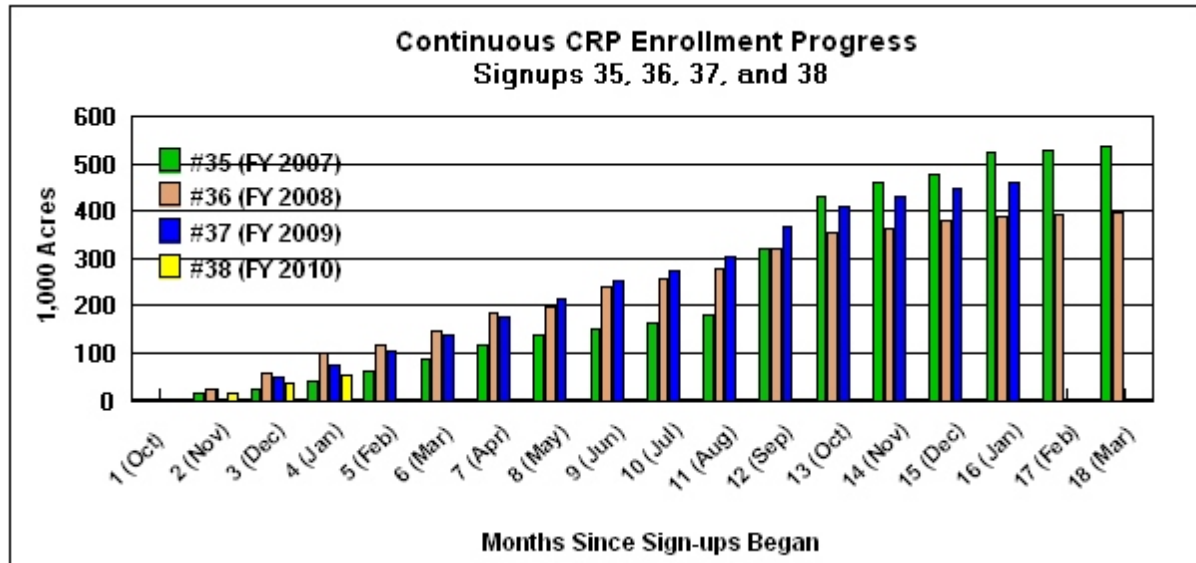

## *CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS –January 2010*

- Contract extensions on about 1.1 million acres have been recorded for contracts that were originally set to expire September 30, 2009. The 3- and 5-year extension offers were made on 1.5 million expiring acres. This extension increased FY 2012 expiring acres by 1 million acres to 6.5 million acres
- FY 2009 enrollment ended at 33.72 million acres. Following the expiration of 2.79 million acres, FY 2010 began with 30.93 million acres under contract. Adding the 0.25 million acres under contracts approved since October 2009 puts enrollment at the end of January at 31.19 million acres, a net decline of 2.53 million acres from September (p. 16).
- Sign-up 38 (FY 2010 continuous sign-up) increased 18,000 acres in January to 58,000 acres.
- Overall, enrollment increased 16,046 acres during January as continuous signup added 27,000 acres while general signup lost 11,000 acres (p. 13).
- Early enrollments of the new FWP practices have been recorded. There are 2,238 acres of aquaculture wetlands (CP40) mostly in Louisiana and Mississippi, and 4,237 acres of flooded prairie wetlands (CP41), primarily in the Dakotas (p. 21).

**General Signup.** Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

**Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up.** Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips and riparian buffers, at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

**Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP).** Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 43 agreements in 32 States.

**Farmable Wetland Program (FWP).** Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and the new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through January 31, 2010, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct mis-coded data in the active contract files.

**Note:** Contracts re-enrolled under 2006's re-enrollment and extension offer (REX) are not considered to expire when the current contracts expire, because new contracts will begin immediately after expiration.
