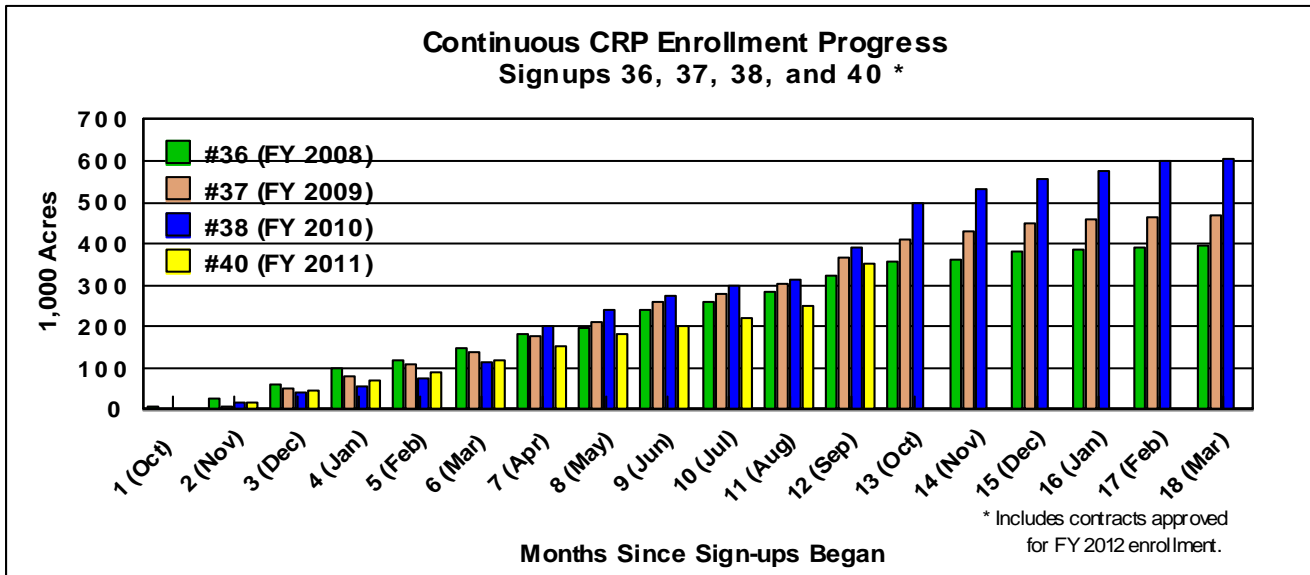

CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM

ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – September 2011

- FY 2011 general signup (#41) ended with 2.6 million acres accepted for enrollment. Offers were received on 3.8 million acres. A table with preliminary approvals (2.8 million acres) is located at: http://www.fsa.usda.gov/Internet/FSA_File/crpsignupresults.pdf
- FY 2011 continuous signup (#40) added 101,254 acres in September and now totals 350,525 acres. This is 41,000 acres below last year at this time.
- Enrollment either increased or decreased in September depending on whether you include acreage under contracts that do not start until FY 2012. Not counting contracts that start in FY 2012, CRP enrollment declined by 28,263 acres during September. Counting contracts starting in FY 2012, enrollment increased by 70,400 acres during the month, as general signup enrollment declined by 26,928 acres (dropouts) and continuous signup increased 97,327 acres. This continuous signup increase includes lands that are currently under contract and that have signed up for re-enrollment.
- In September, the Department announced the expansion of the areas eligible for the Platte-Republican River CREP in Nebraska.

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Lands enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 45 agreements in 33 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through the end of September 2011, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct miscoded data in the active contract files.
