If a man is married, with wife and family, the salary scale is computed from the excerpt below, taken from the third page of the second memorandum which was sent to the personnel of Project I. The rent is charged as per salary.

Rent	as per salary
Utilities	11.00
Service	5.00
Food	25.00 per person

If the baby is tiny, do not charge for food. If he or she is over 2 years old, charge 25.00 per month.

If a man has left either wife or family at home, he is housed at no charge.

If he is a bachelor, he is charged 35.00 per month.

Rent for furnished and equipped single rooms, including utilities and room service, are as follows:

1 person in a room	\$13.00 per month
2 persons in a room	8.00 " "
3 persons in a room	6.00 " "

Rents for unfurnished apartments (from one to three bedrooms and without utilities or room service) are based on salaries and not on space occupied, as follows:
