MEMO To: Capt Parsons

I was very much surprised to note the laxness in appearance of the young Naval officers who have just reported at Y from Tennessee. The summer uniform blouses were particularly bad.

I also noted a tendency, on the part of a few, not to leave Fuller Lodge in the morning in time to get to work on time.

I do not, as you well know, expect any unreasonable standards but I wish you would see what can be done.

I have already spoken to Colonel Tyler about the appearance of the Army officers, some of whom were also far from satisfactory and told him that I would mention the Naval officers to you.
