





- > Application requests authorization to operate unit for an additional 20 years












National Environmental Policy Act


- > NEPA requires Federal agencies to use a sematic approach to consider environmental impacts
- > An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required for major Federal actions significantly affecting the quality of the human environment
- Commission has determined that a supplement to the "Generic EIS for License Renewal of Nuclear Plant will be prepared for a license renewal application.
