Dear Secretary LaHood:

In response to your additional guidance dated September 24, 2009, this shall serve as a supplement to the State of Florida's May 22, 2009, certification pursuant to Title XII, section 1201(a) of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). I hereby certify that the enclosed revised list of DOT "covered programs" identifies the amount of funds the State of Florida plans to expend from State sources from February 17, 2009, to September 30, 2010, for the types of projects that are funded by the appropriation.

I understand that if the State of Florida is unable to maintain the level of effort certified, the State of Florida will thereafter be prohibited from receiving additional limitation pursuant to the redistribution of the limitation on obligations for Federal-aid highway and highway safety construction programs that occurs after August 1 for fiscal year 2011.

Thank you for your continued efforts in this regard.
