The Bonneville Power Administration's Power Business Line (PBL) will conduct a WP-07 Rate Case workshop on April 20, 2005, on risk mitigation, as a follow-up to the April 6, 2005, PFR Risk workshop.

BPA staff will discuss the models used to evaluate various rate design options for risk mitigation for the next rate period. We want to provide interested parties the ability to evaluate and compare for themselves alternative ways of mitigating BPA's large resource-related risk (e.g., hydro and market uncertainty) with varying combinations of tools such as CRACs, DDCs, rebates, reserves and PNRR. A tutorial of how to use the models to do this will be presented using a video demonstration. A telephone bridge will be available. However, it would probably be more useful to attend in person.

In addition, follow-up workshops have been tentatively scheduled for May 4 and May 18 (a change from the schedule presented at the April 6th PFR technical workshop) for follow-on discussions.

The workshop is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. but is not expected to take the entire day. The location is 911 NE 11th Avenue, Portland, OR, Rates Hearing Room, Room 223.
