### **To Customers, Constituents, Tribes, and Other Regional Stakeholders:**

This letter establishes that the results for the ninth true-up of the Load-Based Cost Recovery Adjustment Clause (Load-Based CRAC) are now final. The results presented at the workshop on June 14 have been modified as a result of the audit performed by PriceWaterhouseCoopers. The audit found a discrepancy between the forecast used to establish the Load-Based CRAC9 and the forecast used in the true-up calculations presented at the workshop. After removing that discrepancy, the Load-Based CRAC9 true-up increased by about \$330,000 from the amount presented at the June 14 workshop.

The Load-Based CRAC9 true-up calculation resulted in a total adjustment of \$17,892,229. Slice Customers will pay an additional \$4,242,013 and non-slice customers will pay an additional \$13,650,216. The true-up adjustment amount will appear on customers' bills for July 2006.

The next and last communication regarding the Load-Based CRAC true-up will be in December 2006, when the final true-up amount will be established.
