## **CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED**

Voting 311-107, the House on Thursday passed a bill, HR 965, making permanent a federal-state program that promotes citizen involvement in restoring the Chesapeake Bay ecosystem in Maryland, Virginia, Delaware, Pennsylvania, West Virginia and New York. The program, which is overseen by the National Park Service at a budget of about \$1 million annually, provides funds and technical assistance for the conservation of water trails, wildlife refuges, historic sites and other units in the ecosystem, which is the nation's largest estuary. A "yes" vote was to pass the bill.
