IRAN ECONOMIC SANCTIONS

Voting 403-11, the House on Thursday called for U.S. economic sanctions on any private or state-run company that exports gasoline or other petroleum products to Iran. The purpose of the sanctions is to derail Iran's nuclear program. With this non-binding vote, the House directed its conferees to take a hard line when they negotiate a pending Iran-sanctions bill, HR 2194, with the Senate.

A "yes" vote backed the sanctions.
