<b>Bush-Era Tax Cuts:</b> Members voted, 234-188, to extend beyond Dec. 31 Bush-era tax cuts on the first \$200,000 of income for singles and the first \$250,000 of income for couples filing jointly. The bill did not address Bush-era cuts for higher incomes. A yes vote was to pass HR 4853.	N	N	N	Y	Y
<b>School Meals, Nutrition:</b> Voting 264-157, the House sent President Obama a deficit-neutral bill to extend school meal programs; renew the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) nutrition program; remove junk food from school cafeterias and vending machines, and fund other initiatives to prevent hunger among young people. A yes vote backed S 3307.	N	N	N	Y	Y
<b>Charles Rangel Censure:</b> Voting 333-79, the House censured Rep. Charles Rangel, D-N.Y., for a wide range of improper conduct. A yes vote was to censure Rangel for actions such as his failure to report rental income to the IRS or fully disclose assets to the House. (H Con Res 1737)	Y	*	Y	Y	N
<b>Reprimand, Not Censure:</b> Members defeated, 146-267, a bid to reduce Rep. Charles Rangel's penalty for ethical violations from censure to reprimand on grounds he was not charged with seeking personal enrichment. A yes vote backed the lesser sanction of reprimand. (H Con Res 1737)	N	N	N	Y	Y
