

**Bonneville Power Administration
Regional Dialogue Technical Group
Summary of October 3, 2005 Meeting**

As agreed at the Sept. 30, 2005 meeting, participants began discussion of the following list of Service to Publics issues. Topics numbered 1-5 were discussed at the meeting. Topic six was held over until the Oct. 4, 2005 meeting, along with other topics agreed to by the attendees. See Oct. 4, 2005 notes for additional information.

1. Allocation methodology (% or megawatts).
2. Impact on certainty of allocation from annual net requirement determination, absence of resource removal right and BPA sale of excess entitlements.
3. Pooling, or determining in the initial allocation of full and partial service customers based on a net requirement done prior to 2011.
4. Where is the FBS capability used to determine the size of customers' allocations determined (Rate or contract issue)?
5. Should BPA decrement or augment if eligible loads exceed FBS capability?
6. What is the nature of BPA's contractual commitment to the rate methodology and what are the circumstances under which uncollected tier 2 costs could be included in tier 1 rates?
