Just a word about why I have wanted you to meet with Crandall. I am most grateful that you agreed to do so.

I want Bob to meet key folks who are working on an overview of policy coming from the White House.

Crandall was one of the CEO's who endorsed the President's economic program when it was presented.

Crandall is testifying tomorrow morning at Kennedy's committee in favor of mandated health benefits.

American Airlines provided early, generous in-kind support in the campaign and in the inaugural and transition periods.

And American Airlines took a real hit when the Administration approved the British Air/USAir joint operations.

It is important that he not feel like a pariah. It would even be good if he felt he had cordial, open dialogue with the Administration, even though there will be differences.
