Final Direct and Counter-Cyclical Payments (DCP) will be issued October 2012. However, the current Farm Bill has not been extended, and it appears the DCP program has been eliminated from the proposed new Farm Bill. Therefore, DCPs will not be used in cash flow calculating for 2013.

The intent of this price list is to assure compliance with policy and regulations that relate to prudent loan making and servicing actions. These prices will be used in developing Farm Business Plans in accordance with FSA Handbook 3-FLP.
