With RefGrab-It, you can quickly import web page information to your RefWorks account. RefGrab-It allows you to easily create citations for web pages. Here is how to get started:

Installing RefGrab-It

- 1. Sign in to your RefWorks account.
- 2. Go to Tools and select RefGrab-It.
- 3. A new window will open with instructions for downloading RefGrab-It. Choose the appropriate user type:

- 1. When you are viewing a web page you want to add to your RefWorks account, simply click on the RefGrab-It link in your toolbar or bookmark list.
- Next, you will see this RefWorks temporary results page that displays the web page information. When it is available, more complete reference information may be found by clicking "<u>show details</u>"

- 3. Click the check box on the left side of the web page information you want to add to your RefWorks account or the radio button for "All"
- 4. If the web page also contains RSS feeds, you will also have the option to extract that information and import it as a separate citation in your RefWorks database. To do this, click the check box on the left side of each feed.
- 6. You may import the web page information or the full citation for an RSS feed by clicking "Import To RefWorks"
- 7. You may be prompted to log-in to your RefWorks account.
- 8. You should receive a message that the import was successful. After importing any new information, you will be able to move it to a folder.
