

OUTSTANDING INTERNATIONAL STUDENT/GLOBAL CITIZEN AWARD 2013

UNT-International recognizes an outstanding undergraduate or graduate student who has contributed to the continued growth and sustainability of the international community and a culturally diverse environment at the University of North Texas. Students to be honored with this award are selected according to the following procedures:

QUALIFICATIONS

Students meeting the following criteria would be eligible to receive the Outstanding International Student Award:

- Students should be committed to excellence and have made a significant contribution to the growth and sustainability of the international community and a culturally diverse environment at the University of North Texas and/or in the community.
- Students should be actively involved in campus activities.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

******Please note that this is not an academic award - it does carry minimum academic requirements, but the award is based on campus and community service activities.

- Students must have <u>completed</u> one long semester at UNT and be currently enrolled full-time.
- **Graduate students** must have a cumulative grade point average on work done at UNT of at least 3.25 for Master's candidates, and 3.5 for Doctoral candidates. **Undergraduate students** must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on work at UNT.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the Outstanding International Student/Global Citizen Award may be made by faculty, administrators, staff members, students, and student organizations directly to the International Welcome Center. <u>Self-nominations will NOT be considered</u>. Nominations must be in writing on a nomination form and must be supported by two separate letters of recommendation from a professor, administrator, staff member, or student organization other than the person making the nomination. Nomination forms are available at the INTERNATIONAL WELCOME CENTER, Sycamore Hall, Room 286.

NOMINATIONS DEADLINE: Friday, March 1, 2013.

SELECTION

The Director of the International Welcome Center will appoint a selection committee made up of members of the staff of UNT International. The committee will report to the Director of the International Welcome Center, who will notify the University Honors Committee of the student to be honored with the Outstanding International Student /Global Citizen Award. The student will be honored at Honors Day and at the Celebrating Great Global Citizens Gala in April.
