## **Diesel prices continue to decrease**

---

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$4.01 a gallon on Monday. That's down 4.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.17 a gallon, down 3.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region and the Rocky Mountain States at 3.94 a gallon, down 5.4 cents and down 3.6 cents, respectively.
