## **Diesel prices decrease for the ninth consecutive week**

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.85 a gallon on Monday. That's down 3.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 3.99 a gallon, down 3.4 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.76 a gallon, down 4 ½ cents.
