U.S. Diesel prices decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.96 a gallon on Monday. That's down 1.1 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England and Central Atlantic regions at 4.18 a gallon, down 2.7 cents and down 9-tenths of a penny from a week ago, respectively. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.81 a gallon, down 1.1 cents.
