U.S. diesel prices continue to decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.89 a gallon on Monday. That's down 2.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.09 a gallon, down 3.2 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.77 a gallon, down 1.4 cents.
