Diesel prices continue to decrease

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel fell to \$3.87 a gallon on Monday. That's down 8-tenths of a penny from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the New England region at 4.06 a gallon, down 2-tenths of a penny from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast states at 3.77 a gallon, down 7-tenths of a penny.
