Gasoline prices continue to increase (long version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.58 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Pump prices were highest in the West Coast states at 3.85 a gallon, up 2.9 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Gulf Coast region at 3.34 a gallon, up 2.4 cents.
