U.S. gasoline prices continue to increase (short version)

The U.S. average retail price for regular gasoline rose to \$3.61 a gallon on Labor Day Monday. That's up 5.6 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.
