Monthly Guest Speaker

Larbi Hanni, Data Integrity and Analysis Branch Manager with TxDOT gave a presentation regarding crash data and Crash Records Information System (CRIS). He addressed numerous topics including:

- TXDOT Function as custodian of records for crash reports.
- Different methods of dissemination of crash data (dashboards, data file extracts, data request form link used by the public to request crash data by geographical

- area, time period, crash severity and other filtering criteria such as alcohol involvement, speeding, motorcycles....
- Submission Channels. TxDOT receives crash reports via paper, CRASH or submission services. Large majority of crash report are received electronically.
- Application of Crash Data from engineering and behavioral perspectives (he talked about crash rates as well as actual crash data used in campaigns such as Teen CIOT, CIOT, Drunk Driving Campaign.
- Mapping of crashes by severity in the San Antonio Districts.
