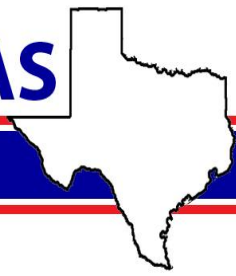

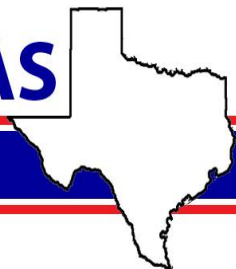
CROSS PLAINS RURAL TRANSPORTATION COUNCIL (CPRTC)

- Formed in August 2001
- Ensure rural communities' transportation needs are addressed
- Effort to take a proactive approach to Public Involvement in the transportation process.



Mission Statement

“To advise and influence the planning and development of rural transportation needs and projects relative to the rural region served by Cross Plains Rural Transportation Council (CPRTC) and communicate those needs and recommendations to all levels of government.”



Goals of CPRTC

- Promote open and consistent communication between TxDOT and its rural constituents
- Provide awareness of the project needs of their areas
- Assist TxDOT officials in prioritizing projects

Benefits of CPRTC

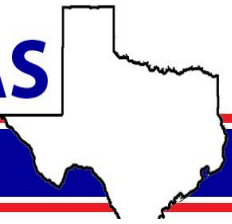
- Allows counties, cities, and rural communities the opportunity to get involved in the early stages of the highway project selection



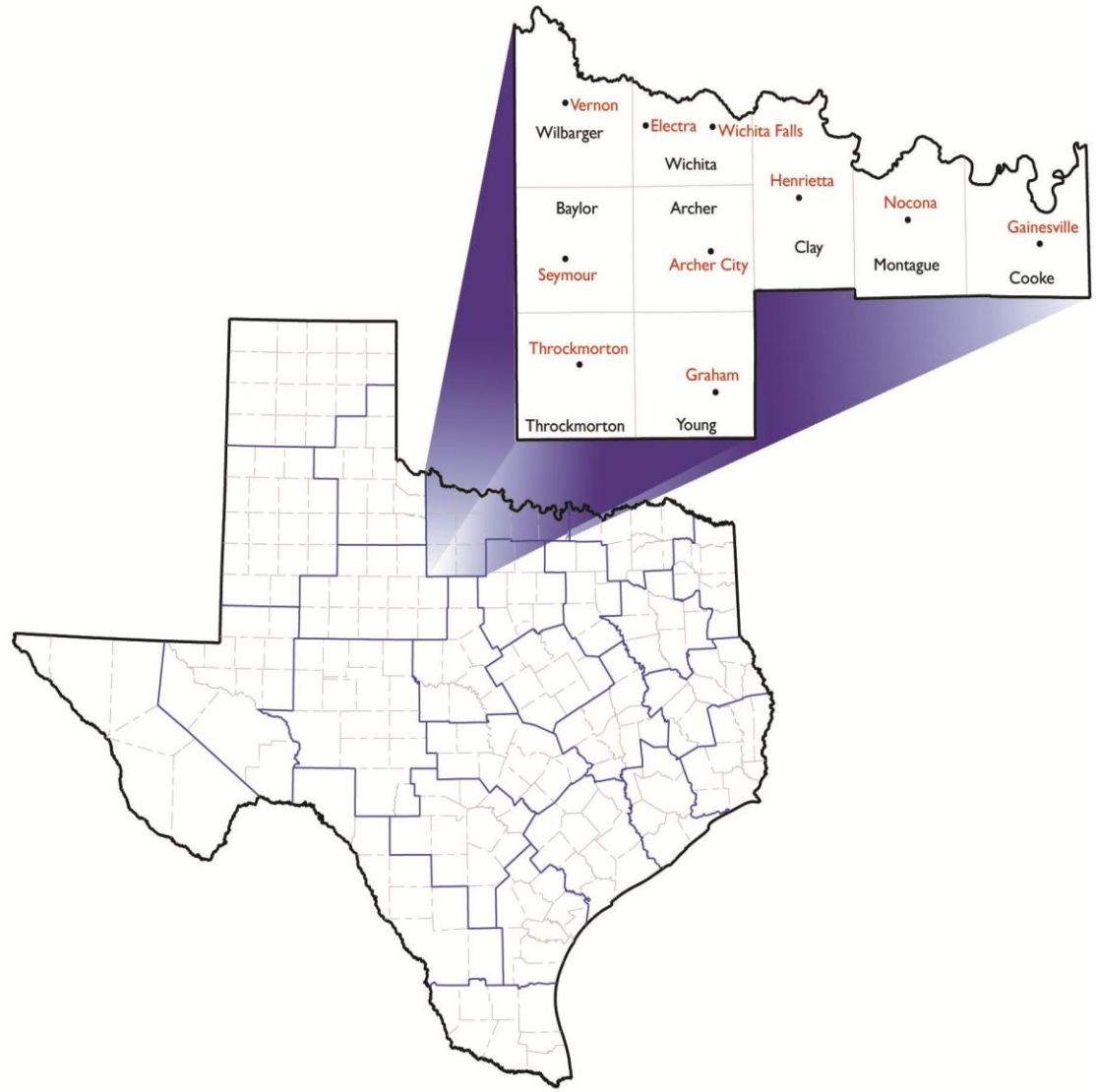
Benefits of CPRTC (cont'd)

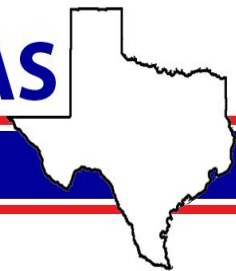
- Working to prioritize projects as a group has helped the counties and communities look at the overall roadway system.

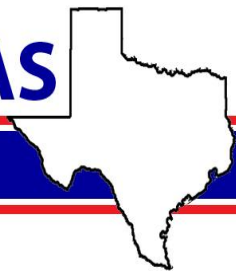

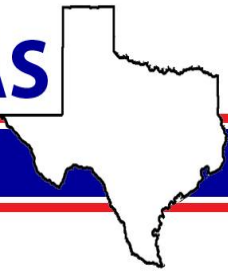
General Membership

- Others



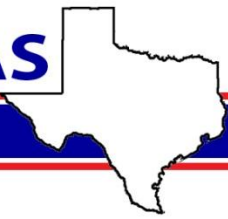
General Membership (cont'd)

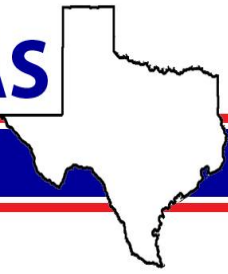
