MAINTENANCE: The Yoakum District spends \$10 million on average (200 miles) for seal coating projects each year. We also perform approximately 1,100-lane miles of crack sealing to preserve pavement life.

CORRIDORS: The Yoakum District is responsible for portions of I-10, US 59, US 87, US 77, US 183 and SH 36. The Yoakum District is conducting impact studies in preparation to upgrade US 59 in Wharton County to I-69 standards.

SAFETY: Our upcoming safety projects include approximately 200 miles of pavement marking texturing. We have many projects underway to widen roadways, add turn lanes and enhance motorist safety.
