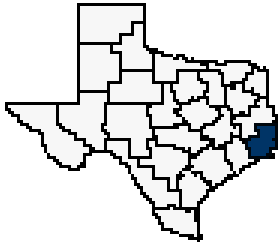




## DISTRICT PROFILE

The Beaumont District is responsible for the design, construction and maintenance of nearly 2,400 miles of state highway, and more than 1,500 bridges in Southeast Texas. The district covers eight counties and is located along the Gulf Coast and adjacent to Louisiana.

### MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- Purple Heart Memorial Bridge – Rebuild bridge carrying I-10 over Neches River in Jefferson/Orange counties – \$60 million (Completion in 2016)
- Concord Road – Widen from SH 105 to Lucas Road – City of Beaumont – \$11 million (Completion in late 2015)
- Ramp Relocation/Reconfiguration – relocate and reconfigure ramps along US 69 from the I-10/US 69 interchange to SH 105 –\$27 million (completion in 2016)
- I-10 – Reconstruct I-10 between Orange, Texas, and Louisiana state line –\$68 million (completion in 2017)

### PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- I-10 – Add lanes between Beaumont and Winnie – \$280 million
- Vidor Loop – FM 299 – Pass-through financing project in Orange County – \$29 million
- I-99/Grand Parkway – Construct segments H & I-1 – US 59 to I-10
- US 69 Corridor – New location of US 69 between Lumberton and Kountze-Hardin County – \$130 million
- US 59 Expansion/I-69 – US 59 through Cleveland in Liberty County – Expansion of US 59 to interstate standards – \$70 million

**MAINTENANCE:** The district is spending \$8.6 million on sealcoating projects and annually spends approximately \$42 million on routine maintenance.

**CORRIDORS:** The Beaumont District’s corridors include I-69/US 59, I-10, US 69, US 96, US 190, SH 105 and SH 99.

**SAFETY:** More than 52 miles of centerline texturing is being added throughout the district’s eight counties in 2015, and eight intersections will receive improved traffic signals.
