MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- US 290: reconstruction and widening from I-610 to FM 2920 – \$1.8 billion (2017)
- SH 99/Grand Parkway: design-build contract of Segments F1, F2 & G from US 290 to US 59 North - \$1.1 billion (2015)
- I-45 South: widening from Nyack to FM 2351 \$77 million (2015)
- I-45 South: widening from El Dorado to Medical Center Drive - \$93 million (2017)
- US 59/I-69S: widening from FM 762 to Spur 10 – \$135 million (2018)

PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- SH 288 toll lanes, Harris County: construct 4 toll lanes from US 59 to Harris/Brazoria County Line. Comprehensive Development Agreement awarded April 2015 for \$800 million. (Brazoria County to develop and construct toll lanes south of Beltway 8 to SH 6.)
- SH 99/Grand Parkway: Segments H-I. In procurement of design-build contract, conditional award late 2015 – estimated \$1.2 billion.
- SH 249 in Montgomery County & Grimes County. In procurement of design-build contract, request for qualifications (RFQ) anticipated second quarter 2015 – estimate \$400 million.
- I-45 North: from downtown to Beltway 8. In environmental impact statement phase – estimated approval 2017.

MAINTENANCE: The district spent \$97 million in fiscal year 2014 on preventative and routine maintenance. The I-45 corridor is maintained through a five-year \$27 million total maintenance contract.

CORRIDORS: The district's major thoroughfares include I-610 Loop, I-10, I-45, SH 288, SH 6, SH 225, SH 146, US 59/I-69, US 290, US 90 and Beltway 8.

SAFETY: \$7 million allocated for traffic signal, shoulder and striping improvements for fiscal year 2014.
