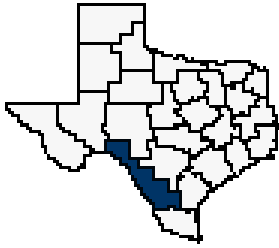




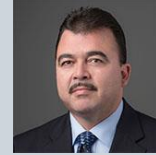
## DISTRICT PROFILE

The Laredo District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in its counties. The district primarily conducts asset preservation and mobility projects to ensure the safety of the traveling public. The Laredo District experiences varying weather conditions to include extreme heat, which result in varying challenges for maintenance crews and designers in order to maintain district assets and assure the safety of the traveling public year-round.

### MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- State Loop 79 Extension Project in Val Verde County – new location of non-freeway – estimated \$5 million (2014 local let)
- State Loop 20/SP 400 Interchange in Webb County – \$34 million
- Energy Sector Design Build Project in various counties – \$41.1 million

### PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- State Loop 20 over KCS Railroad New Frontage Roads and widening of existing bridge in Webb County – \$25 million
- State Loop 20/International Boulevard Interchange – \$22 million

**MAINTENANCE:** We spend \$11 million annually on seal coating projects and in-house operations. We also spend several million each year rehabilitating I-35 pavement.

**CORRIDORS:** The Laredo District's priority corridor effort is Loop 20/Future I-69; US 83 to US 277 Ports to Plains.

**SAFETY:** Safety projects total \$3.3 million to include traffic signal upgrade, rail upgrades, and texturing shoulders.

**BRIDGES:** The district has 873 on-system bridges and 183 off-system bridges, for a total of 1,056 bridges.
