- **2012-2013 Junior cohort of 32 students; 1 withdrew, 1 postponed senior studios to 2014-2015; retention rate, 97%; 30 advanced to fall 2013 semester senior class and 30 graduated spring 2014 with a graduation of 100%.
- ***2013-2014 Junior cohort of 31 students; 1 postponed senior studios to 2015-2016, retention rate, 97%; 30 advanced to fall 2014 semester senior class, but 1 returned from previous year and 31 graduated spring 2015 with a graduation rate of 100%.
