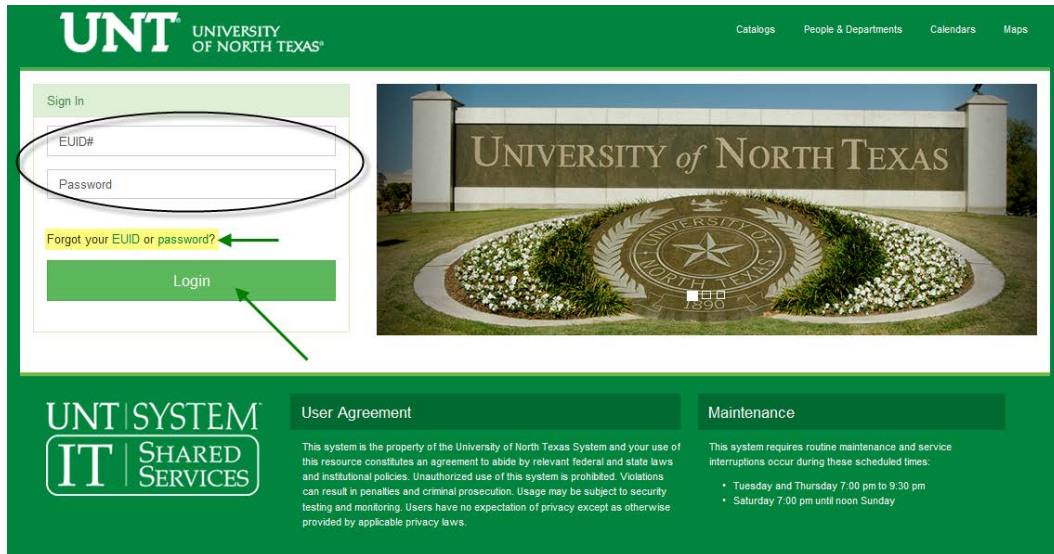


Instruction for Early Alert Referral System

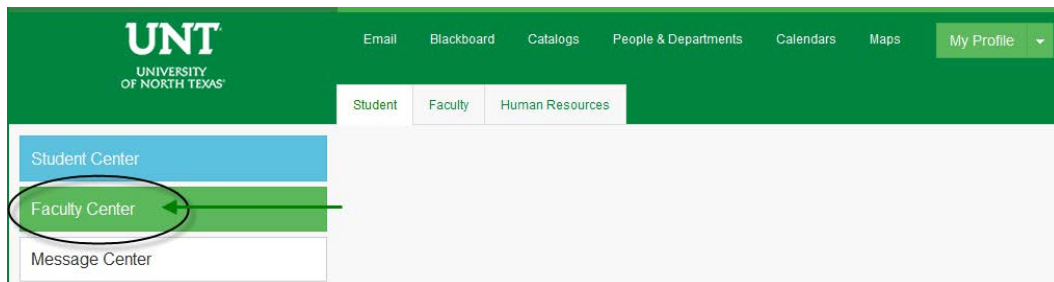
Early Alert Referral System (EARS) is an online referral system available for faculty to use when they have concerns about one of their students. The EARS form is available from within the Audit Roll or the Class Roster in the Faculty Center.

- Go to my.unt.edu and login to the website using your EUID and Password.

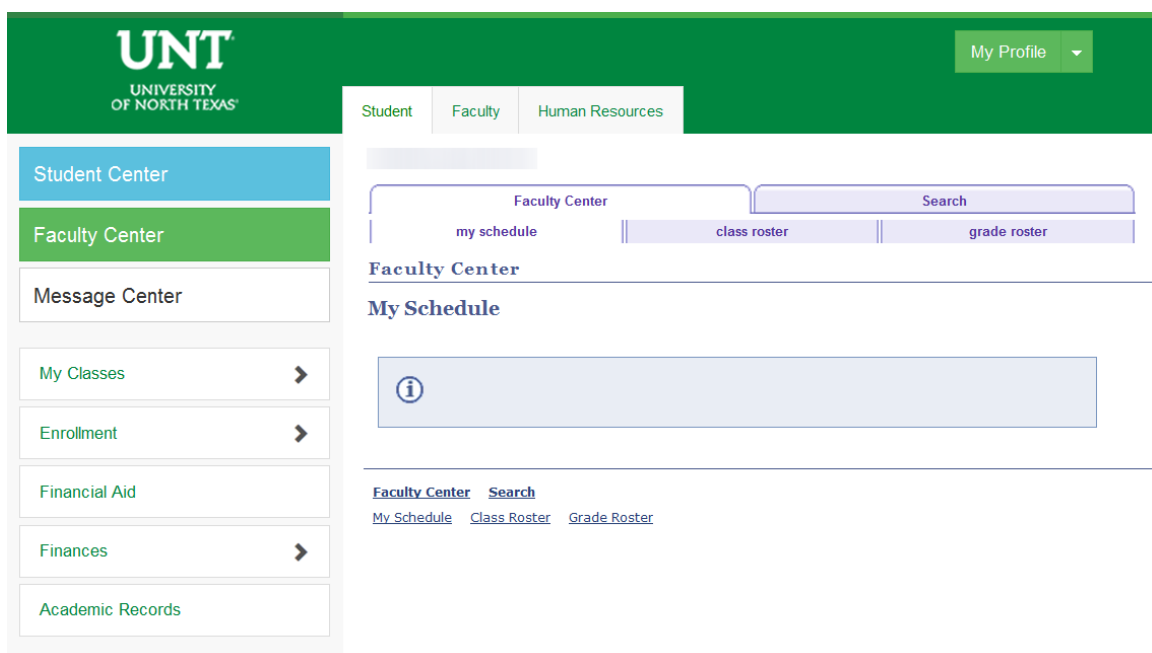


NOTE: If you do not know your EUID and password, use the links below the **Sign In** prompt to help you navigate for assistance.
