Title: Holiday Schedules for UNT, UNTD, UNTHSC and UNTS

Background:

Texas Government Code 662.011 allows the governing body of an institution of higher education to establish the holiday schedule on any days the Board chooses, but the number of holidays may not exceed the total number of days to which other State agencies are entitled. It has been determined that State agencies will observe fifteen (15) holidays during FY 2015, and fourteen (14) holidays during FY 2016. Schedules for the University of North Texas, the University of North Texas at Dallas, The University of North Texas Health Science Center and the University of North Texas System are included in the attached Board Order.

It is recommended that the Chancellor is authorized to modify the holiday schedule when such a change is deemed to be in the public interest.

Financial Analysis/History:

State Holidays represent a paid employee benefit and are considered in the UNT budget.
