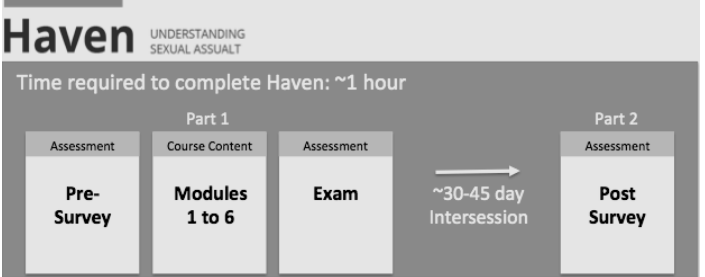


Dear Student,
