In addition to the proposed pay schedule, **tuition support** has to be factored for each student supported on research assistantships. Rates published below are consistent with UNT's published tuition and fees plus CENG fees for 2015-2016. In accordance with the graduate student tuition increase policy, 3.9% inflation rate should be used on proposals for calculating tuition costs each year. Pro-rated tuition support based on project duration will be permitted in special cases. Any tuition support waiver or prorated tuition support need to be approved by the Dean's office. Based on feedback from the Toulouse Graduate School, the pay-scales and tuition amounts will be revised annually and posted online.
