SEASON OPENER FOR NT AGAINST METROPLEX RIVAL SMU

→ North Texas opens the 2015 season on the road at SMU. The Mean Green is coming off a 4-8 season in 2014. NT is picked to finish in fifth in the West Division of Conference USA this year. SMU begins a new era as Chad Morris enters his first season as the head coach of the Mustangs. SMU is 0-1 on the year after falling in their season opener, 56-21, to Baylor.

- → The Mean Green and Mustangs are meeting for the 35th time, with SMU holding leading the series 28-5-1. The Mean Green has won three of the last five matchups with SMU, including a 43-6 win last season in Denton. NT has only one once in Dallas, however, a 7-0 win in 1933. SMU leads the series in Dallas 22-1-1. In fact NT has only scored more than 14 points once against SMU in Dallas, in the last game played at SMU in 2007 when the Mean Green scored 31 points.
- → North Texas is 38-58-3 all-time in the season debut. The Mean Green has won just three season openers in the last 18 years. NT is starting the year on the road for the 13th time in the last 14 seasons. In the last 16 season openers on the road, NT has a record of only 2-14.
- → North Texas, over the last four seasons, has compiled 22 wins, which is the most over a four-year run since 2001-04 and only the fifth time in the last 50 years that North Texas has won as many games over a four-year stretch. The previous times were 2001-04 (29), 1987-90 (26), 1975-78 (33), and 1966-69 (30).
- → Dan McCarney has 22 career victories as the head coach at North Texas, which has him in eighth place all-time at NT. He needs just one more win to tie Theron Fouts for seventh place. The SMU game is McCarney's 50th game at North Texas. He is only the seventh coach in school history to reach that mark and just the third since Hayden Fry.
- → Turnover margin is an area of immense improvement for North Texas under Dan Mc-Carney. In his first four years, North Texas is +21. From 2006-2010, the Mean Green was a combined -60 in turnover margin. Last season was the first year NT wasn't on the plus side of the turnover margin under McCarney as the Mean Green was a +0.

THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

- 1 North Texas has won at SMU only once in the series history, and that took place in 1933. Of the 24 previous meetings in Dallas against the Ponies, the Mean Green has scored in double figures only twice, 2007 and 1992. A win by North Texas against SMU would be the first winning streak of any kind in the series against the Mustangs. Despite have won three of the last five meetings, NT has never won back-to-back games against SMU.
- **31.3** In 2013, when North Texas won three road games, the Mean Green averaged 31.3 points a game on the road. In 2014, that number dropped to 19.5 points as NT went 0-6 on the road. SMU at home in 2014 was outscored by an average of 42-7.
- **136** North Texas was one play away from notching its first shutout since 2003 last season against SMU. The Mean Green had blanked the Ponies until the final play, a 33-yard hailmary pass for a touchdown that ended the shutout. NT has not had a shutout since October 30, 2003 against Troy. That stretch now covers 136 games.
- **200** In the match-up last season with SMU, NT pounded out 245 yards on the ground and three touchdowns. Under Dan McCarney, the Mean Green is 12-2 when topping the 200-yard mark rushing. SMU allowed 300 rushing yards in their season opener against Baylor.
- **601** The last visit to SMU for North Texas was one for the record books. Quarterback Daniel Meager set a school record with 601 passing yards and wide receiver Casey Fitzgerald had a school record 327 receiving yards, which still ranks seventh-most in NCAA history Meager's 601 passing yards is still 14th in NCAA history.
- **1.000** Entering the 2015 season, North Texas is going for a 1-0 start for the second time in the last three seasons. The Mean Green hasn't had a 1-0 start in two of three seasons since moving back up to FBS football in 1995. The last time is occured was in 1994 and '96. The last time NT was 1-0 in two of three seasons at the FBS level was under Hayden Fry in 1978-80.

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. Head coach Dan McCarney has 22 victories at NT, which ranks eighth all-time. With two more wins, he will pass Theron Fouts. If NT wins eight games, not only would that be the 500th victory, but McCarney would also move into sixth place for coaching wins at NT.

Walkons Making A Difference

Since he arrived, North Texas head coach Dan McCarney has built one of the nations most productive walkon programs. 34 players have been put on scholarship since 2011. Four players have been named all-conference: WR Darnell Smith (2013), center Kaydon Kirby (2013, Lombardi- and Rimington-Award nominee in 2015), DB Kenny Buyers (2013), punter Blake Macek (2013). Defensive lineman Brandon McCoy was the winner of the Armed Forces Merit Award in 2013 and, since 2011, walkons have made a total of 146 starts in four seasons. They have combined to rush for 1,686 yards and 19 TDs. The wide receivers have combined for 2,977 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns. In 2012, the top two receivers were walkons and three of the top-five were walkons. On defense since 2011, walkons have accounted for 391 tackles.

Award Candidates

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 25 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

Eight Is Enough

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

Apogee Advantage

Coach Dan McCarney is establishing a record of dominance at Apogee Stadium as North Texas has a home record of 16-7 at Apogee Stadium since 2011. The Mean Green went 5-1 at home in 2013, tying for the second most wins in school history. The three seasons before 2011, the Mean Green went just 1-16 at home.

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. Head coach Dan McCarney has 22 victories at NT, which ranks eighth all-time. With two more wins, he will pass Theron Fouts. If NT wins eight games, not only would that be the 500th victory, but McCarney would also move into sixth place for coaching wins at NT.

Ready To Roll

Six transfers for North Texas, five that had to sit out 2014, are eligible and ready to hit the field this season. Offensive lineman Sam Rice (SMU), linebacker Blake Bean (Buffalo), wide receiver Nate Grimm (NMSU), twin defensive backs Rashad and Vershad Jackson (New Mexico) and safety Jakii Moore (UAB) are eligible. Moore arrived at North Texas in the spring and was granted immediate eligiblity after transferring from UAB.

No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

Harris Hard To Stop

WR Carlos Harris led North Texas in receiving yards, all-purpose yards, kickoff-return yards and was second in punt-return yards in 2014. Harris also had the highest yards per carry at 10.2 in 2014, as he rushed nine times for 92 yards and a touchdown. He was third in Conference USA in receptions and fourth in receiving yards per game in 2014. Harris is the top-returning receiver in the league in both categories. He was fifth in scoring for NT in 2014. Harris had over 100 all-purpose yards in six games, over 150 yards in five games, and two games of over 200-yards, including a career-high 234 yards in 2014. Harris enters 2015 on the verge of the career top-10 in all-purpose yards at NT, while he already ranks in the top-10 in receptions.

Ground And Pound

The Mean Green rushed for over 200 yards on three different occasions in 2014, and NT has run for over 300 yards seven times in the last four seasons. The Mean Green ran for 21 touchdowns in 2014, which tied for the eighth most in school history. In the four-years of Dan McCarney, NT has run for 8,118 yards, the second most (2001-04) in a four-year stretch since 1981.

All He Does Is Catch TD's

Senior tight end Marcus Smith emerged as a big-play receiver in 2014. Despite making only 15 receptions, he made them count. Six of his catches were for touchdowns, and he led the team in receiving averaged at 15.9 yards a catch. He had five catches for over 20 yards in 2014. and his 15.9 yards-a-catch average was the highest by a North Texas tight end since Andy Blount in 2003.

Quarterback Carosel Ending

One position that has lacked consistency for NT has been quarterback. In 2014, the Mean Green had three different starters at quarterback. If Andrew McNulty starts the season opener, he will be the third different quarterback in three seasons to start the year for NT. From 2002-2011, nine different quarterbacks started the first game of the season for the Mean Green. Only a stretch of Derek Thompson starting from 2011-13 ended the run of a different starting QB. McNulty started the final six games of the 2014 season and has seven career starts.

Best In The Nation

North Texas was the best team in the country in red-zone offense in 2014, scoring 94.3 percent of the time once inside the 20-yard line. The Mean Green scored on 33-of-35 trips inside the red zone in 2014 to edge out UCLA for the best in the nation.

The Magic Numbers

Under head coach Dan McCarney, when scoring 30 points or more, North Texas is a perfect 16-0. When leading after three quarters, NT is 16-1 under McCarney. North Texas is 9-0 when allowing 10 points or less under McCarney, but that streak is 37-straight wins when holding opponents to 10 points or less, dating back to 1988.

One Final Act For The Jimmy Show

Senior Antoinne Jimmerson enters the 2015 season ranked 17th at NT with 1,579 rushing yards for his career. He was the leading rusher for the Mean Green in 2014 and with 499 rushing yards in 2015 he can vault his way into the top-10 all-time. Jimmerson can become just the 11th running back in school history to reach 2,000 career yards with 421 rushing yards. Jimmerson ranks tied for ninth all-time with 17 rushing touchdowns and he is tied for seventh place all-time with 22 career touchdowns.

Spreading The Wealth

In 2014, Carlos Harris was one of the top receivers in C-USA and was the leading receiver for NT. Harris had 70 catches, but the dropoff behind him was significant. Harris was responsible for 38.6 percent of the Mean Green receptions in 2014, but the next closest to Harris was Darius Terrell with 26 grabs. In 2013, the Mean Green had three receivers with over 40 receptions and 18 different players with at least one grab. Last season, the Mean Green had only Harris over 40 receptions.

Putting Up Points

The Mean Green offense has combined to average more points in a two-year stretch (2013-14) since 1968-69. NT's 27.2 points a game in 2014, along with the second-highest total in school history in 2013 of 31.6 points a game, made this the highest-scoring stretch in school history since 1968-69.

Air Attack

Under McCarney, North Texas has passed for nearly 10,000 yards (9,981) in four seasons. It is the third-most passing yards in a four-year stretch at North Texas in school history. The Mean Green has thrown 13 or more touchdowns in four-straight seasons, which is the third most in a four-year stretch in school history.

Rebuilding Up Front

The Mean Green offensive line, which featured a veteran group in 2014, enters 2015 with the possibility of only 33 combined starts among the five. Kaydon Kirby has 25 career starts, while Michael Banogu made two starts in the final two games of 2014. Transfer Sam Rice, who sat out 2014, made five starts at SMU. The rest of the potential starting offensive line does not have a start.

Cosh Inherits A Stingy Defense

New Mean Green defensive coordinator Chris Cosh takes over a unit that is coming off one of the best seasons statistically in nearly a decade. The North Texas defense in 2014 allowed the fewest yards a game since 2006 with 369.4 yards per contest. It was also a ball hawking defense, as North Texas had seven different defensive backs with an interception in 2014, which was a school record for most DBs in a single season with at least one pick.

Home Defense System

North Texas allowed an average of only 17.5 points a game at home in 2014. Over the last four seasons since Apogee Stadium opened, the Mean Green defense has allowed fewer than 20 points a game in three of four seasons and three-consecutive years. The four previous seasons, 2007-10, the Mean Green allowed over 30 points a game in three of four seasons.

Getting Behind The Line

The Mean Green defensive line produced 33 sacks in 2014, tied for the fifth most in school history. North Texas had a school-record 10 sacks in a game, and defensive end Tillman Johnson recorded a freshman school-record 3.0 sacks in a game. Johnson finished with a freshman-record 5.0 sacks on the season. The last two seasons, NT has recorded 72 sacks, which is the second most in back-to-back seasons in school history, only one shy of the record of 73 set in 1996-97.

Freshman All-America

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. Moore's field-goal percentage of 88.2 was the best in school history, and his 37-for-37 in PATs was tied for the most without a miss in a single season. Moore, a Lou Groza Award candidate, can break the school record for most PATs without a miss with by making 25 more. The 88.2 percent FG percentage was sixth in the nation last season and ranks fifth among active players heading into 2015.

That Kid Is One Of A Kind

Darvin Kidsy was one of six players in FBS to return a punt and a kickoff for a touchdown in 2014. He's one of three active players who completed the feat in 2014. The other five players are Marcus Murphy (Missouri), Tyreek Hill (Oklahoma State), William Likely (Maryland), Isaiah McKenzie (Georgia) and Kaelin Clay (Utah). It marked the second-straight season NT had a player return both a punt and kickoff for a TD, as Brelan Chancellor accomplished the feat in 2013.

Special Forces

Entering his third season, special teams coach Tommy Perry has completly remade the Mean Green units into perhaps the best in the nation. In 2013, the Mean Green special teams ranked first in the nation in blocked kicks, blocked punts, and block punts allowed. Last season, NT led the nation again in blocked punts allowed (0) and blocked kicks allowed. In 2014, the Mean Green was fifth in the nation in kick-return defense.

Can't Touch This

Dan McCarney has emphasized special teams since his arrival in 2011 and the North Texas punt team has delivered. North Texas has not had a single punt blocked in the Dan McCarney era. The last NT punt that was blocked was in 2010 by Rice, a streak that is currently at 59 games. That streak is the fourth longest in the nation.

Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive

Since 2011 under Dan McCarney, NT has scored 21 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 19 touchdowns and two safeties. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that has resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and six fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 21 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power 5 teams in the nation with 21 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26), Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power 5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.

Dan McCarney knows how to build football programs. He was a part of a historic turnaround at Iowa State, and now you can add North Texas to that list. McCarney has turned around North Texas and taken the program to heights that were unthinkable when he arrived in 2011.

On their way to the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl Championship, the Mean Green won nine games in 2013, tied for the second most in school history and just the sixth time in 100 years North Texas has won nine games. The season culminated with North Texas winning the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl 36-14 over UNLV on January 1.

In 2014 McCarney powered North Texas to a 43-6 win over rival SMU, just the fifth win for NT in 34 games against the Mustangs. North Texas posted 77 points in a game in 2014, the fourth-highest total in a game in school history. 2014 also saw one of McCarney's first recruits at North Texas, offensive lineman Cyril Lemon, earn his fourth straight all-conference honor as he was named to the Conference USA first-team.

Lemon was the only player in the nation to start 49 straight games and earn all-conference honors in four straight years.

McCarney led the Mean Green to a 6-2 record in the inaugural season in Conference USA, tying for second place and the second most conference wins in school history. Along the way, the Mean Green broke offensive, defensive, special teams and attendance records.

The Mean Green achieved the biggest single season turnaround since 1982-83. The North Texas offense set a new school record for total offense in a single season, topping the 5,000-

yard mark for the first time. North Texas rushed for over 300-yards three times in 2013, which is the most in a season since 1959.

The North Texas defense allowed the fewest points per game since 2002, and tied for the second most sacks in school history.

McCarney is establishing a record of dominance at Apogee Stadium as North Texas has a home record of 16-7 at Apogee Stadium since 2011. The Mean Green went 5-1 at home in 2013, tying for the

second most wins in school history. The three seasons before 2011, the Mean Green went just 1-16 at home.

McCarney has won 22 games at North Texas, which already ranks in the top-10 all-time as he enters the 2015 season eighth in coaching wins. McCarney reached 18 wins faster at North Texas than any coach since Rod Rust in 1967-69 after his first three seasons.

He has brought out the best individually at North Texas as the Mean Green had 12 players earn 14 spots on the C-USA all-conference team in 2013, the second most in school history. Brelan Chancellor became just the second player in league history to earn first-team all-conference honors as a kick and punt returner, and was the only player in the nation to rank in the top 10 in punt and kick returns in 2013.

The North Texas resurgence was fueled by all three phases: offense, defense and special teams. Under McCarney, the Mean Green ranked in the top 10 in the nation in 2013 in fourth down conversion defense (fifth), blocked kicks (first), blocked punts (first), blocked punts allowed (first), fumbles recovered (fourth), sacks allowed (seventh), punt returns (fifth), red zone defense (second), scoring defense (eighth), sacks (seventh) and turnovers (fourth).

With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, including 13 years as a head coach at Iowa State University, McCarney is an established leader. He came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach at the University of Florida where he had been since 2008. He helped win a national championship at Florida.

McCarney began his coaching career at the University of Iowa, where he was an assistant under Fry for 11 years. He continued his career as the defensive coordinator at the University of Wisconsin under Alvarez, directing some of the best defensive teams in that schools history. At Wisconsin, McCarney helped turn a team that had won 10 games in five years into a Big 10 Conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance in his fourth year.

McCarney took over as head coach at Iowa State in 1995, assuming responsibility of a program that had enjoyed just three winning seasons in the 16 years prior to his arrival. McCarney led Iowa State to five bowl games from 2000-05 and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2004 when his team earned a Big 12 North cochampionship.
