 \rightarrow The Mean Green is opening the 2015 season at Apogee Stadium with a battle against the Rice Owls. NT is looking to avoid an 0-2 start after falling to SMU, 31-13, while Rice is 1-1, coming off a 42-28 loss at Texas. Rice holds the series lead, 3-2, and has won three of the last four meetings. NT won the last battle in Denton, 28-16, in 2013.

 \rightarrow North Texas is 65-31-3 all-time in home-opening games. The Mean Green has won threestraight home-opening games and allowed only a combined 19 points in those games. Head coach Dan McCarney is 12-4 in his 16 previous home openers and 3-1 with the Mean Green.

 \rightarrow With a win over Rice, North Texas can have its fourth-straight 1-1 start to a season. It would mark the first time the Mean Green has been .500 or better in three-straight years since 1989-92, and the first time at 1-1 as an FBS member for four-straight years in 35 seasons. Not since 1977-80, as an FBS member, has NT had a 1-1 mark four-straight seasons.

→ Redshirt freshmen Brandon Garner, Tee Goree and Chris Miles made their first career starts against SMU. True freshman offensive lineman Jordan Murray saw significant action along with freshman DT Roderick Young, and WR D'Aundrey Bradley. Redshirt freshmen A.J. Ezzard, Cannon Maki, Cedric Fernandes and T.J. Tauaalo played key roles. In addition, sophomore Andrew Tucker made his first career start at RB.

 \rightarrow Blake Bean ranks fourth in Conference USA averaging 10.0 tackles per game. His nine solo tackles per game also leads Conference USA and ranks fourth nationally.

→ True freshman defensive tackle Roderick Young picked up a sack in his first collegiate game. He is the first true freshman to record a sack in his first game since Brandon Kennedy in 2000. Young is one of two Conference USA freshmen and one of four freshmen nationally to average at least 1.0 sack per game.

 \rightarrow Dan McCarney has 22 career victories as the head coach at North Texas, which puts him in eighth place all-time at NT. He needs just one more win to tie Theron Fouts for seventh place. The SMU game was McCarney's 50th game at North Texas. He is only the seventh coach in school history to reach that mark and just the third since Hayden Fry.

→ For just the second time under head coach Dan McCarney, North Texas came up short when leading after three quarters against SMU, moving to 19-2 under McCarney.

→ Running back Antoine Jimmerson moved into seventh all-time at NT with his 23rd-career touchdown against SMU. Jimmerson's 40 yards rushing moved into 16th all-time in career rushing yards, giving him 1,619 rushing yards.

3 - North Texas allowed SMU to convert 60 percent on third down in the opener, and the Rice Owls come in leading the nation in third-down conversions at 69.4 percent. The Owls

Rice Owls come in leading the nation in third-down conversions at 69.4 percent. The Owls have converted 25 times in 36 third downs this season.

7 - North Texas has always had success under Dan McCarney at forcing turnovers. The Mean Green forced three turnovers by SMU, and Rice through two games this season has seven turnovers and is a -4. The seven turnovers by Rice this season are tied for the second most in the nation. Only Colorado State has turned the ball over more than Rice in 2015.

33 - Last season in the loss at Rice, the Mean Green managed only 33 rushing yards. The Owls have been stingy against the run through two games, allowing just 117.5 yards a game. NT had 112 yards of rushing against SMU. NT gave up 273 yards on the ground against SMU while the Owls' rushing attack ranks first in C-USA and fifth in the country, averaging 314.5 yards a game on the ground in 2015.

34 – After boasting the nation's fifth-best kickoff-return defense (16.37 yards/return) last season, North Texas ranks 26th nationally this year, giving up a combined 34 kickoff return yards on two attempts. That unit will be tested as Rice enters the game with the second-best kickoff return unit in C-USA, averaging 31.4 yards a return, ninth best in the nation.

24:10 - The Mean Green lost the time of possession battle with SMU, holding the ball for just over 24 minutes in the game. Rice held the ball for over 44 minutes against Texas, and, for the season, the Owls rank first in C-USA and second in the country in time of possession at 37:28.

2010 – North Texas opens its C-USA slate looking for a 1-0 start in league play for the first time since 2010. The Mean Green has been 1-0 in league play only once in the last eight years. Since returning to FBS play in 1995 and joining a league in 1996, North Texas is 7-12 in conference-opening games.

MEAN GREEN NOTES

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. Head coach Dan McCarney has 22 victories at NT, which ranks eighth all-time. With two more wins, he will pass Theron Fouts. If NT wins eight games, not only would that be the 500th victory, but McCarney would also move into sixth place for coaching wins at NT.

Walkons Making A Difference

Since he arrived, North Texas head coach Dan McCarney has built one of the nations most productive walkon programs. 34 players have been put on scholarship since 2011. Four players have been named all-conference: WR Darnell Smith (2013), center Kaydon Kirby (2013, Lombardi- and Rimington-Award nominee in 2015), DB Kenny Buyers (2013), punter Blake Macek (2013). Defensive lineman Brandon McCoy was the winner of the Armed Forces Merit Award in 2013 and, since 2011, walkons have made a total of 146 starts in four seasons. They have combined to rush for 1,686 yards and 19 TDs. The wide receivers have combined for 2,985 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns. In 2012, the top two receivers were walkons and three of the top-five were walkons. On defense since 2011, walkons have accounted for 400 tackles.

Award Candidates

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 25 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

Eight Is Enough

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

Apogee Advantage

Coach Dan McCarney is establishing a record of dominance at Apogee Stadium as North Texas has a home record of 16-7 at Apogee Stadium since 2011. The Mean Green went 5-1 at home in 2013, tying for the second most wins in school history. The three seasons before 2011, the Mean Green went just 1-16 at home.

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. Head coach Dan McCarney has 22 victories at NT, which ranks eighth all-time. With two more wins, he will pass Theron Fouts. If NT wins eight games, not only would that be the 500th victory, but Mc-Carney would also move into sixth place for coaching wins at NT.

Ready To Roll

Six transfers for North Texas, five that had to sit out 2014, are eligible and ready to hit the field this season. Offensive lineman Sam Rice (SMU), linebacker Blake Bean (Buffalo), wide receiver Nate Grimm (NMSU), twin defensive backs Rashad and Vershad Jackson (New Mexico) and safety Jakii Moore (UAB) are eligible. Moore arrived at North Texas in the spring and was granted immediate eligiblity after transferring from UAB.

No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

MEAN GREEN OFFENSIVE NOTES

Still Perfect Inside The 20

After scoring on 94.3 percent of red-zone opportunities in 2014, best in the nation, North Texas is one of 37 teams with a perfect 100 percent conversion in the red zone this year, scoring a combined six points on two trips to the red zone. North Texas is one of 28 teams nationally with a perfect 100 percent conversion percentage offense on fourth down, converting on its lone fourth-down attempt, a fourth-and-one at the SMU 26-yard line that later led to a 25-yard rushing touchdown by Antoinne Jimmerson.

Third And Long

North Texas was unable to stay in front of the chains in the opener against SMU, forcing the offense into numerous third down sitations. On 13 of 16 third-downs NT had against SMU, the Mean Green needed six or more yards. The Mean Green had only three third-down sitations that were for four yards or less.

Targerting Harris

The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is tied for 10th in Conference USA averaging 5.0 receptions per game, hauling in five catches for 40 yards in the season opener against SMU. Harris moved into seventh place at North Texas with 141 career receptions. He needs 59 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris also moved into the top-10 alltime with 1,719 career receiving yards.

Ground And Pound

The Mean Green rushed for over 200 yards on three different occasions in 2014, and NT has run for over 300 yards seven times in the last four seasons. The Mean Green ran for 21 touchdowns in 2014, which tied for the eighth most in school history. In the four years under Dan McCarney, NT has run for 8,118 yards, the second most (2001-04) in a four-year stretch since 1981.

All He Does Is Catch TD's

Senior tight end Marcus Smith emerged as a big-play receiver in 2014. Despite making only 15 receptions, he made them count. Six of his catches were for touchdowns, and he led the team in receiving averaged at 15.9 yards a catch. He had five catches for over 20 yards in 2014. and his 15.9 yards-a-catch average was the highest by a North Texas tight end since Andy Blount in 2003.

The Magic Numbers

Under head coach Dan McCarney, when scores 30 points or more, North Texas is a perfect 16-0. When leading after three quarters, NT is 16-1 under McCarney. North Texas is 9-0 when allowing 10 points or less under McCarney, but, dating back to 1988, that streak is 37-straight wins when holding opponents to 10 points or less.

One Final Act For The Jimmy Show

Senior Antoinne Jimmerson moved up to 16th at North Texas with 1,579 rushing yards for his career. He scored his 23rd career touchdown against SMU and moved into seventh place all-time. He needs just 381 more yards to become the 11th running back in school history to reach 2,000 career yards.

Air Attack

Under McCarney, North Texas has passed for nearly 10,000 yards (9,981) in four seasons. It is the third-most passing yards in a four-year stretch in North Texas school history. The Mean Green has thrown 13 or more touchdowns in four-straight seasons, which is the third most in a four-year stretch in school history.

Rebuilding Up Front

The Mean Green offensive line, which featured a veteran group in 2014, entered 2015 with the possibility of only 33 combined starts among the five. The unit saw true freshman Jordan Murray and Creighton Barr see action against SMU, along with Ryan Rentfro and redshirt freshman Chris Miles. Kaydon Kirby has 26 straight starts while guard Sam Rice, who sat out 2014 after transferring, made his first start.

The Red-Zone Wall

One of the statistically worst red-zone defenses in the nation this past season (108th in red-zone scoring defense, 127th in redzone touchdown scoring defense), North Texas ranks 14th nationally in red zone defense, holding opponents to scores on just 60 percent of red zone opportunities and a combined 17 points on five trips to the red zone. SMU made three trips inside the North Texas five-yard line and can away with only three points. The Mean Green defense forced a fumble at the one, stopped SMU on downs, then held the Ponies to a field goal.

Home Defense System

North Texas allowed an average of just 17.5 points a game at home in 2014. Over the last four seasons since Apogee Stadium opened, the Mean Green defense has allowed fewer than 20 points a game in three-of-four seasons and three-consecutive years. The four previous seasons, 2007-10, the Mean Green allowed over 30 points a game in three of four seasons.

Getting Behind The Line

The Mean Green defensive line produced 33 sacks in 2014, tied for the fifth most in school history. North Texas had a school-record 10 sacks in a game, and defensive end Tillman Johnson recorded a freshman school-record 3.0 sacks in a game. Johnson finished with a freshman-record 5.0 sacks on the season. The last two seasons, NT has recorded 72 sacks, which is the second most in back-to-back seasons in school history, only one shy of the record of 73 set in 1996-97.

Freshman All-America

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. He has made 38 straight PATs, and had made seven-straight field goals until missing what would have been a career-best 48-yard kick at SMU. Moore ranks fifth nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 85.0. Moore, a Lou Groza Award candidate, can break the school record for most PATs without a miss with by making 24 more.

McClain Steps Up

Sophomore Kishawn McClain ranks fourth among all Conference USA defensive backs and is tied for 19th among all defensive backs nationally averaging 9.0 tackles per game. His seven solo tackles also ranks second in Conference USA and tied for 14th nationally.

That Kid Is One Of A Kind

Darvin Kidsy was one of six players in FBS to return a punt and a kickoff for a touchdown in 2014. He's one of three active players who completed the feat in 2014. The other five players are Marcus Murphy (Missouri), Tyreek Hill (Oklahoma State), William Likely (Maryland), Isaiah McKenzie (Georgia) and Kaelin Clay (Utah). It marked the second-straight season NT had a player return both a punt and kickoff for a TD, as Brelan Chancellor accomplished the feat in 2013.

Special Forces

Entering his third season, special teams coach Tommy Perry has compleity remade the Mean Green units into perhaps the best in the nation. In 2013, the Mean Green special teams ranked first in the nation in blocked kicks, blocked punts, and block punts allowed. Last season, NT led the nation again in blocked punts allowed (zero) and blocked kicks allowed. In 2014, the Mean Green was fifth in the nation in kick-return defense.

Can't Touch This

Dan McCarney has emphasized special teams since his arrival in 2011 and the North Texas punt team has delivered. North Texas has not had a single punt blocked in the Dan McCarney era. The last NT punt that was blocked was in 2010 by Rice, a streak that is currently at 59 games. That streak is the fourth longest in the nation.

Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive Since 2011 under Dan McCarney, NT has scored 21 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 19 touchdowns and two safeties. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and six fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 21 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power-5 teams in the nation with 21 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26), Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power-5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.

Dan McCarney knows how to build football programs. He was a part of a historic turnaround at Iowa State, and now you can add North Texas to that list. McCarney has turned around North Texas and taken the program to heights that were unthinkable when he arrived in 2011.

On their way to the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl Championship, the Mean Green won nine games in 2013, tied for the second most in school history and just the sixth time in 100 years North Texas has won nine games. The season culminated with North Texas winning the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl 36-14 over UNLV on January 1.

In 2014 McCarney powered North Texas to a 43-6 win over rival SMU, just the fifth win for NT in 34 games against the Mustangs. North Texas posted 77 points in a game in 2014, the fourth-highest total in a game in school history. 2014 also saw one of McCarney's first recruits at North Texas, offensive lineman Cyril Lemon, earn his fourth straight all-conference honor as he was named to the Conference USA first-team.

Lemon was the only player in the nation to start 49 straight games and earn all-conference honors in four straight years.

McCarney led the Mean Green to a 6-2 record in the inaugural season in Conference USA, tying for second place and the second most conference wins in school history. Along the way, the Mean Green broke offensive, defensive, special teams and attendance records.

The Mean Green achieved the biggest single season turnaround since 1982-83. The North Texas offense set a new school record for total offense in a single season, topping the 5,000-

yard mark for the first time. North Texas rushed for over 300-yards three times in 2013, which is the most in a season since 1959.

The North Texas defense allowed the fewest points per game since 2002, and tied for the second most sacks in school history.

McCarney is establishing a record of dominance at Apogee Stadium as North Texas has a home record of 16-7 at Apogee Stadium since 2011. The Mean Green went 5-1 at home in 2013, tying for the



second most wins in school history. The three seasons before 2011, the Mean Green went just 1-16 at home.

McCarney has won 22 games at North Texas, which already ranks in the top-10 all-time as he enters the 2015 season eighth in coaching wins. McCarney reached 18 wins faster at North Texas than any coach since Rod Rust in 1967-69 after his first three seasons.

He has brought out the best individually at North Texas as the Mean Green had 12 players earn 14 spots on the C-USA all-conference team in 2013, the second most in school history. Brelan Chancellor became just the second player in league history to earn first-team all-conference honors as a kick and punt returner, and was the only player in the nation to rank in the top 10 in punt and kick returns in 2013.

The North Texas resurgence was fueled by all three phases: offense, defense and special teams. Under McCarney, the Mean Green ranked in the top 10 in the nation in 2013 in fourth down conversion defense (fifth), blocked kicks (first), blocked punts (first), blocked punts allowed (first), fumbles recovered (fourth), sacks allowed (seventh), punt returns (fifth), red zone defense (second), scoring defense (eighth), sacks (seventh) and turnovers (fourth).

With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, including 13 years as a head coach at Iowa State University, McCarney is an established leader. He came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach at the University of Florida where he had been since 2008. He helped win a national championship at Florida.

McCarney began his coaching career at the University of Iowa, where he was an assistant under Fry for 11 years. He continued his career as the defensive coordinator at the University of Wisconsin under Alvarez, directing some of the best defensive teams in that schools history. At Wisconsin, McCarney helped turn a team that had won 10 games in five years into a Big 10 Conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance in his fourth year.

McCarney took over as head coach at Iowa State in 1995, assuming responsibility of a program that had enjoyed just three winning seasons in the 16 years prior to his arrival. McCarney led Iowa State to five bowl games from 2000-05 and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2004 when his team earned a Big 12 North co-championship.

DALLAS - An inconsistent North Texas offense, which had rolled up and down the field a year ago against SMU, coughed and sputtered and struggled in Saturday night's season opener, losing two fumbles, throwing two interceptions, and failing to generate scoring chances or to take advantage of opportunities presented to it in a 31-13 loss to the Mustangs at Gerald J. Ford Stadium.

The North Texas defense generated three first-half turnovers of its own, stopped SMU three times inside the Mean Green five-yard line, and kept SMU quarterback Matt Davis under control for three quarters, but wore down and surrendered 21-straight points in a decisive fourth quarter.

"They outplayed us in the second half," North Texas coach Dan McCarney said. "They made the plays, we didn't. You turn the ball over four times, you're rarely going to win football games. That was the difference in the game."


