OCTOBER ARRIVES WITH NT LOOKING TO BOUNCE BACK AT USM

→ NT dives back into Conference USA play with a road game at Southern Miss. The Mean Green is coming off a loss at Iowa and trying snap a four-game losing streak dating back to 2014. USM dropped a road game at Nebraska and this will be their conference opener. Southern Miss won 30-20 last season in Denton and holds a slim 5-4 edge in the series. NT won 55-14 in Hattiesburg in 2013 where the series is even at 2-2.

- → WR Carlos Harris added another notch to his belt of versatility as he threw his first TD pass against Iowa. He's non-QB player since Patrick Cobbs in 2005 to toss for a touchdown. He's also entered elite company, joining Cobbs as the only other person in school history to throw a TD, run for a TD and catch a TD.
- → The Mean Green ground attack got rolling against stingy Iowa defense. NT racked up a season-high 183 yards against what was the nation's fifth-best rushing defense. The trio of Jeffrey Wilson, Antoinne Jimmerson and Willy Ivery accounted for 179 of the 183 yards. The three averaged 5.1 yards a carry. NT is averaging 4.5 yards a carry as a team, which is the highest total in the McCarney era.
- → The turnover bug has gotten to North Texas the first three-games. NT is a -5 on the year and has 10 turnovers on the year, that have led to 44 points in three games. Under Dan McCarney, NT has won the turnover battle in 27 games, and won 18 of those. When losing the turnover battle under McCarney, the Mean Green is just 1-16.
- → RB Antoinne Jimmerson is averaging 7.0 yards a carry on first-down, ditto for Willy Ivery and Jeffrey Wilson is averaging 6.0 yards a run on first-down. NT as a team is averaging 5.7 yards a rush on first-down.
- → DE Jarrian Roberts coming in to the season had a total of 4.0 sacks in two season. He has matched that total through the first three games of 2015 with 4.0 sacks. He leads Conference USA with 1.33 sacks a game and eighth in the nation. He is on a potential record-breaking pace. Willis Hudson holds the school record for sacks with 14.5 back in 1994.
- → Dan McCarney has 22 career victories as the head coach at North Texas, which puts him in eighth place all-time at NT. He needs just one more win to tie Theron Fouts for seventh place. The SMU game was McCarney's 50th game at North Texas. He is only the seventh coach in school history to reach that mark and just the third since Hayden Fry.
- → Andrew McNulty's passing percentage is 46% through the first three games, but it has been 2nd down that has given him difficulty. McNulty is 18-for-35 on first-down and an even more impressive 19-for-32 on third-down, 59%. Of the 19 completions on 3rd down, 16 have gone for a 1st down. But on second-down McNulty is only 12-of-37, which is 32%.

THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

0 - North Texas is looking to end a eight-game road losing streak and avoid their first 0-4 start to a year since 2008. NT is also trying to avoid its second straight 0-2 start to the conference season.

1st and 3rd - The opening quarter to the game and to begin the second half for North Texas have put North Texas in a hole. The Mean Green has been outscored 21-6 in the first-quarter and 37-17 in the third-quarter. While Southern Miss has outscored its opponents 31-26 in the first-quarter and 52-23 in the third-quarters of games in 2015.

13 - North Texas has scored just 13 points off of opponent turnovers this season, while allowing 44 points from their own mistakes to their opponents. Southern Miss has given up just 13 points off of only five turnovers in four games.

14.1 - Southern Miss has been very good hitting the big play on offense, as they are averaging 14.1 yards per catch this season. 13 different receivers have made at least one grab for the Golden Eagles, and 11 of those are averaging over 10.0 yards a reception. The Mean Green has allowed 11 catches for 20-yards or more this season. Last season in Denton, USM QB Nick Mullens threw for 305 yards, two TD's and spread the ball around to 11 different receivers.

62.8 – 3rd-down has been the toughest one of them all this year for the Mean Green defense. They are allowing a conversion rate of 62.8 through the first three games, which is last in C-USA and the nation. Southern Miss enters converting 3rd downs at a 40 percent clip, fifth in the league. Last season NT allowed just a 38 percent conversion rate on 3rd down's and the highest percentage under coach McCarney was 45 percent in 2012.

215 - Both North Texas and Southern Miss have struggled to stop the run in 2015. Between the two teams , they are allowing an average of 215 rushing yards, 224 for NT and 206 for Southern Miss. Running the ball has been a hallmark of success under Dan McCarney for NT, as they are 12-2 when rushing for over 200-yards in his tenure.

Lynn A Semifinalist For Campbell Trophy

North Texas senior fullback Jarrod Lynn was named a semifinalist by the National Football Foundation for the William V. Campbell Trophy. The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced the 135 semifinalists for the 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. Lynn is one of only 56 players from FBS football to be named a semifinalist and one of just three players from Conference USA. The NFF will announce 15 finalists on Oct. 29, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class.

Very Mellow With Yellow

North Texas remains one of the least penalized teams in Conference USA, averaging just 6.3 penalties per game, fifth-fewest in the league and tied for the 58th nationally, and for 60.0 penalty yards per game, seventh-fewest in the league and tied for 67th nationally.

Walkons Making A Difference

Since he arrived, North Texas head coach Dan McCarney has built one of the nations most productive walkon programs. 34 players have been put on scholarship since 2011. Four players have been named all-conference: WR Darnell Smith (2013), center Kaydon Kirby (2013, Lombardi- and Rimington-Award nominee in 2015), DB Kenny Buyers (2013), punter Blake Macek (2013). Defensive lineman Brandon McCoy was the winner of the Armed Forces Merit Award in 2013 and, since 2011, walkons have made a total of 146 starts in four seasons. They have combined to rush for 1,686 yards and 19 TDs. The wide receivers have combined for 2,985 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns. In 2012, the top two receivers were walkons and three of the top-five were walkons. On defense since 2011, walkons have accounted for 400 tackles.

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. Head coach Dan McCarney has 22 victories at NT, which ranks eighth all-time. With two more wins, he will pass Theron Fouts. If NT wins eight games, not only would that be the 500th victory, but McCarney would also move into sixth place for coaching wins at NT.

Award Candidates

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 25 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

Eight Is Enough

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

Gotta Love(ing) Him

Tight end Chris Loving is the second leading receiving for North Texas with 10 grabs on the year, and they have virtually all been important. Seven of his 10 catches have gone for either a touchdown or a first-down. Last season Loving had only one catch the entire season.

Red Zone Success

North Texas ranks fifth in red zone offense in C-USA, scoring six times in seven trips to the red zone, good for a conversion percentage of 85.7, and is also tied for fifth in redzone defense, allowing opponents to score 13 times in 17 trips to the red zone, good for a conversion percentage of 76.5.

Quick Hitters

Quarterback Andrew McNulty ranks sixth in Conference USA in passing yards per game (189.3), highlighted by a 303-yard passing game against Rice, the first 300-yard passing game by a North Texas player since Derek Thompson in 2013.....Running back Antoinne Jimmerson ranks sixth in Conference USA averaging 5.41 yards per carry, rushing 37 times for 200 yards on the ground....Wide receiver Carlos Harris ranks eighth in Conference USA in receptions per game (6.0), fourth in receiving yards per game (92.0) and is tied for eighth with two receiving touchdowns.

Targeting Harris

The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is fifth in Conference USA in receiving yards a game at 92.0. Harris moved into fifth place at North Texas with 155 career receptions after grabbing eight catches against Rice. He needs 45 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris jumped over Marcus Camper and Pete Harvey against Iowa in receiving yards for his career. He now stands eighth with 1,955 career receiving yards.

Up Tempo

North Texas ran a season-high 88 plays against Iowa. It was the most plays run in a game since 2013, when the Mean Green ran 89 plays at Southern Miss. The 88 plays are the third most that the Mean Gree has run in a game under head coach Dan McCarney. North Texas also had a season-high in time of possession against Iowa, holding onto the ball for 28:15.

One Final Act For The Jimmy Show

Antoinne Jimmerson moved into 13th place all-time in career rushing, carrying for 15 times against Iowa for 66 yards and giving him 1,779 career rushing yards. He scored his 23rd career touchdown against SMU and moved into seventh place all-time. He needs just 221 more yards to become the 11th running back in school history to reach 2,000 career yards.

One Of The Biggest

True freshman offensive lineman Jordan Murray checks in at 6-9 and 359 pounds. He made his first start of his career against Rice, he's the first true freshman offensive lineman to start a game since Cyril Lemon in 2011. He also happens to be one of the biggest players in FBS football. He is tied for third-tallest player in the nation at 6-9, trailing two 6-10 players, but is the biggest player in the nation when it comes to being 6-9 or taller and 359 pounds.

The Magic Numbers

Under head coach Dan McCarney, when scores 30 points or more, North Texas is a perfect 16-0. When leading after three quarters, NT is 19-2 under McCarney. North Texas is 9-0 when allowing 10 points or less under McCarney, but, dating back to 1988, that streak is 37-straight wins when holding opponents to 10 points or less.

Rebuilding Up Front

The Mean Green offensive line, which featured a veteran group in 2014, entered 2015 with the possibility of only 33 combined starts among the five. The unit saw true freshman Jordan Murray and Creighton Barr see action against SMU, along with Ryan Rentfro and redshirt freshman Chris Miles. Kaydon Kirby has 27 straight starts while guard Sam Rice, who sat out 2014 after transferring, made his first start.

Among The Nation's Tops In Stops

Safety Kishawn McClain ranks second in Conference USA and is tied for sixth nationally in total tackles, averaging 11.7 tackles per game. He's also the leader in total tackles among C-USA defensive backs and ranks second nationally among defensive backs. He leads the nation in solo tackles per game with 9.7 Fellow safety James Gray ranks third in Conference USA and is tied for 30th nationally averaging 9.7 tackles per game. He also ranks second among C-USA defensive backs and ranks fifth nationally among defensive backs. North Texas is one of just four schools in the nation to have two of the top three tacklers in its league (Louisville, South Alabama, Tulsa) and also one of just four schools to have two players ranked in the top 32 nationally in tackles per game (Bowling Green, Kentucky, Tulsa).

Bringing The Heat

North Texas ranks third in sacks per game (2.33/game) and eighth in tackles for loss per game (5.67/game). Defensive end Jarrian Roberts leads C-USA and is tied for eighth nationally averaging 1.33 sacks per game. He also ranks second in the league and is tied for 18th nationally averaging 1.8 tackles for loss per game. Roberts had sacks in consecutive games for the first time in his career against Rice and Iowa.

3rd Down Woes

The North Texas defense has struggled to get off the field when it has been 3rd down this season. It hasn't been 1st or 2nd down that has put them in a hole, it has been 3rd and long (more than seven yards) that has given them trouble. The QB's in 3rd-and-long against NT this season have completed 15-of-17, 88.2 percent of their passes. 12 of those have gone for a 1st down, three of them have gone for touchdowns. Against the run on 3rd down, opponents have converted 13 times on 20 rushing attempts, 65 percent of the time.

Punt Return Troubles

North Texas the last two seasons, has been one of the best teams in the nation in punt returns and punt return converage. 2015 hasn't been able to match the previous year's success yet. NT is averaging just 5.3 yards a punt return but is giving up 23.8 yards a return on punts. Punter Eric Keena has made it difficult for opponents to return kicks as he has pinned five of his 13 punts inside the 20-yard line, forced five fair catches and had zero touchbacks.

Freshman All-America

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. He has made 42 straight PATs, leaving him 19 away from tying the school record Moore ranks 5th nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 84.0. This season Moore has made 6-of-8 kicks. Moore was a Lou Groza Award nominee.

That Kid Is One Of A Kind

Darvin Kidsy was one of six players in FBS to return a punt and a kickoff for a touchdown in 2014. He's one of three active players who completed the feat in 2014. The other five players are Marcus Murphy (Missouri), Tyreek Hill (Oklahoma State), William Likely (Maryland), Isaiah McKenzie (Georgia) and Kaelin Clay (Utah). It marked the second-straight season NT had a player return both a punt and kickoff for a TD, as Brelan Chancellor accomplished the feat in 2013.

Can't Touch This

Dan McCarney has emphasized special teams since his arrival in 2011 and the North Texas punt team has delivered. North Texas has not had a single punt blocked in the Dan McCarney era. The last NT punt that was blocked was in 2010 by Rice, a streak that is currently at 61 games. That streak is the fourth longest in the nation.

Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive

Since 2011 under Dan McCarney, NT has scored 21 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 19 touchdowns and two safeties. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and six fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 21 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power-5 teams in the nation with 21 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26), Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power-5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.

Dan McCarney knows how to build football programs. He was a part of a historic turnaround at Iowa State, and now you can add North Texas to that list. McCarney has turned around North Texas and taken the program to heights that were unthinkable when he arrived in 2011.

On their way to the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl Championship, the Mean Green won nine games in 2013, tied for the second most in school history and just the sixth time in 100 years North Texas has won nine games. The season culminated with North Texas winning the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl 36-14 over UNLV on January 1.

In 2014 McCarney powered North Texas to a 43-6 win over rival SMU, just the fifth win for NT in 34 games against the Mustangs. North Texas posted 77 points in a game in 2014, the fourth-highest total in a game in school history. 2014 also saw one of McCarney's first recruits at North Texas, offensive lineman Cyril Lemon, earn his fourth straight all-conference honor as he was named to the Conference USA first-team.

Lemon was the only player in the nation to start 49 straight games and earn all-conference honors in four straight years.

McCarney led the Mean Green to a 6-2 record in the inaugural season in Conference USA, tying for second place and the second most conference wins in school history. Along the way, the Mean Green broke offensive, defensive, special teams and attendance records.


The Mean Green achieved the biggest single season turnaround since 1982-83. The North Texas offense set a new school record for total offense in a single season, topping the 5,000-

yard mark for the first time. North Texas rushed for over 300-yards three times in 2013, which is the most in a season since 1959.

The North Texas defense allowed the fewest points per game since 2002, and tied for the second most sacks in school history.

McCarney is establishing a record of dominance at Apogee Stadium as North Texas has a home record of 16-7 at Apogee Stadium since 2011. The Mean Green went 5-1 at home in 2013, tying for the

second most wins in school history. The three seasons before 2011, the Mean Green went just 1-16 at home.



He has brought out the best individually at North Texas as the Mean Green had 12 players earn 14 spots on the C-USA all-conference team in 2013, the second most in school history. Brelan Chancellor became just the second player in league history to earn first-team all-conference honors as a kick and punt returner, and was the only player in the nation to rank in the top 10 in punt and kick returns in 2013.

The North Texas resurgence was fueled by all three phases: offense, defense and special teams. Under McCarney, the Mean Green ranked in the top 10 in the nation in 2013 in fourth down conversion defense (fifth), blocked kicks (first), blocked punts (first), blocked punts allowed (first), fumbles recovered (fourth), sacks allowed (seventh), punt returns (fifth), red zone defense (second), scoring defense (eighth), sacks (seventh) and turnovers (fourth).

With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, including 13 years as a head coach at Iowa State University, McCarney is an established leader. He came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach at the University of Florida where he had been since 2008. He helped win a national championship at Florida.

McCarney began his coaching career at the University of Iowa, where he was an assistant under Fry for 11 years. He continued his career as the defensive coordinator at the University of Wisconsin under Alvarez, directing some of the best defensive teams in that schools history. At Wisconsin, McCarney helped turn a team that had won 10 games in five years into a Big 10 Conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance in his fourth year.

McCarney took over as head coach at Iowa State in 1995, assuming responsibility of a program that had enjoyed just three winning seasons in the 16 years prior to his arrival. McCarney led Iowa State to five bowl games from 2000-05 and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2004 when his team earned a Big 12 North cochampionship.

DALLAS - An inconsistent North Texas offense, which had rolled up and down the field a year ago against SMU, coughed and sputtered and struggled in Saturday night's season opener, losing two fumbles, throwing two interceptions, and failing to generate scoring chances or to take advantage of opportunities presented to it in a 31-13 loss to the Mustangs at Gerald J. Ford Stadium.

The North Texas defense generated three first-half turnovers of its own, stopped SMU three times inside the Mean Green five-yard line, and kept SMU quarterback Matt Davis under control for three quarters, but wore down and surrendered 21-straight points in a decisive fourth quarter.

"They outplayed us in the second half," North Texas coach Dan McCarney said. "They made the plays, we didn't. You turn the ball over four times, you're rarely going to win football games. That was the difference in the game."

DENTON - North Texas put up some impressive first-half numbers in the first home game of the season Saturday. Ouarterback Andrew McNulty completed 65 percent of his passes for 171 yards, the ground game rushed for 98 yards and averaged 7.5 yards per carry, the offense converted five-of-seven third downs, and the defense recorded three sacks. It should have added up to a nice lead in the Conference USA opener against Rice. And it was all undone by turnovers.

Two critical, crippling lost fumbles - one on a punt return and one that cut short a Mean Green drive deep in Rice territory - led to 10 first-half Rice points, and a third-quarter tipped-ball interception led to another Rice touchdown, sending North Texas to a 38-24 loss at Apogee Stadium.

"The thing we built this program on, the foundation that is so important to winning, is turnover margin and taking care of the football," North Texas head coach Dan Mc-Carney said. "When you're minus three on the day against a good team, you're going to have trouble winning."
