#### HOMECOMING FOR NORTH TEXAS SHOOTING FOR FIRST WIN AGAINST PSU

→ North Texas is back at home to begin a stretch of three of the next four games at Apogee Stadium, starting with at homecoming date with Portland State. The Mean Green is 0-4 and looking to avoid its first 0-5 start to a year since 2008. Portland State, a member of the Big Sky Conference, dropped its first game of the season to North Dakota, but is 3-1 on the year including a win at Washington State. The Vikings are ranked No. 23 in the FCS top-25. The two teams have never met.

- → North Texas holds an 8-0 record against FCS schools since rejoining the FBS level, including a 2-0 mark under Dan McCarney, defeating Nicholls State by a score of 77-3 in the last such matchup.
- → North Texas committed a season-low one turnover but lost the turnover battle for the fourth consecutive game against Southern Miss. For the season, North Texas minus-six, which ranks 10th in Conference USA and 113th nationally. In two of the four games this season, NT has yet to cause one turnover. In the previous four seasons under Dan McCarney, the Mean Green failed to cause a turnover in only six of the 49 games.
- → Running back Jeffrey Wilson rushed for a career-high 136 on a career-high 22 carries against Southern Miss. It was the most rushing yards in a game since Brandin Byrd ran for 251 against Tulsa in 2013. It was his second career 100-yard rushing game, and in two of the last games Wilson has played he has rushed for over 100 yards.
- → QB DaMarcus Smith saw his first extended period of playing time for North Texas at Southern Miss. While he finished 3-for-11, he did complete a 61-yard pass to Carlos Harris, which is the second longest passing play for NT since 2013.
- → Carlos Harris notched his fifth 100-yard receiving game with 136 yards and nine grabs against Southern Miss. He's averaging seven catches a game and could threaten the all-time receptions mark of 229 set by Casey Fitzgerald. He is 66 grabs away from him. Harris is also one of just 17 active players in the nation that have thrown, caught and run for a TD.
- → The Mean Green is looking for its first win of the season, and homecoming could be the right tonic. NT is 42-22-1 in homecoming games and has won two straight.
- → The turnover bug has gotten to North Texas the first three-games. NT is a -6 on the year and has 11 turnovers on the year, that have led to 44 points in three games. Under Dan McCarney, NT has won the turnover battle in 27 games, and won 18 of those. When losing the turnover battle under McCarney, the Mean Green is just 1-17.
- → Dan McCarney has 22 career victories as the head coach at North Texas, which puts him in eighth place all-time at NT. He needs just one more win to tie Theron Fouts for seventh place. The SMU game was McCarney's 50th game at North Texas. He is only the seventh coach in school history to reach that mark and just the third since Hayden Fry.

#### THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

- **0** The Mean Green secondary is still searching for its first interception of the year after four games. NT is one of only nine teams left in FBS without an interception on defense this season. Portland State enters the game ranked fourth in FCS with eight interceptions this season. The Vikings are also third in FCS in turnover margin and fourth in scoring defense.
- **12 -** Through the first four games, the Mean Green has allowed 12 sacks on the year. Portland State has had the same issues, giving up 10 sacks through its first four games. In the last 16 games for NT, the offensive line has allowed 36 sacks. The previous 37 games, the Mean Green offensive line allowed a combined 32 sacks over three years. The two teams have combined for 13 sacks between them.
- **15:00** The Mean Green has had trouble getting out of the locker room this season. NT is being outscored 28-6 in the first quarter of games and 51-17 in the third quarter. In 2014, it was the same problem as NT was outscored 100-62 in the first quarter and 108-57 in the third quarter. Portland State is outscoring its opponents 24-13 in the first quarter and 31-10 in the third quarters this season.
- **16** Another area that has been a strength for Portland State has been penalties. They are third-fewest penalized team in FCS this season, with only 16 total flags this season. North Texas has been nearly as good, with a total of 24 penalties this season.
- **100** Four different running backs for Portland State have over 100 yards rushing this season. The Vikings are averaging 205.5 yards a game on the ground this season, while the Mean Green rush defense has given up 230 yards a game. Conversely the Mean Green ground game, which has rushed for over 180 yards in two straight games, faces a Viking team allowing only 113 yards a game on the ground this season.
- 110 The North Texas pass defense catches a slight break this week against Portland State. The Vikings come in averaging only 111.0 yards through the air this season. The Mean Green secondary is giving up 286 yards a game.

#### Lynn A Semifinalist For Campbell Trophy

North Texas senior fullback Jarrod Lynn was named a semifinalist by the National Football Foundation for the William V. Campbell Trophy. The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced the 135 semifinalists for the 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. Lynn is one of only 56 players from FBS football to be named a semifinalist and one of just three players from Conference USA. The NFF will announce 15 finalists on Oct. 29, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class.

#### Very Mellow With Yellow

North Texas remains one of the least penalized teams in Conference USA. North Texas ranks fifth in Conference USA in both penalties per game (6.0) and penalty yards per game (55.0). The Mean Green had a season-low five penalties for just 40 yards against Southern Miss.

#### Walkons Making A Difference

Since he arrived, North Texas head coach Dan McCarney has built one of the nations most productive walkon programs. 34 players have been put on scholarship since 2011. Four players have been named all-conference: WR Darnell Smith (2013), center Kaydon Kirby (2013, Lombardi- and Rimington-Award nominee in 2015), DB Kenny Buyers (2013), punter Blake Macek (2013). Defensive lineman Brandon McCov was the winner of the Armed Forces Merit Award in 2013 and, since 2011, walkons have made a total of 146 starts in four seasons. They have combined to rush for 1,686 yards and 19 TDs. The wide receivers have combined for 2,985 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns. In 2012, the top two receivers were walkons and three of the top-five were walkons. On defense since 2011, walkons have accounted for 400 tackles.

#### 100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. Head coach Dan McCarney has 22 victories at NT, which ranks eighth all-time. With two more wins, he will pass Theron Fouts. If NT wins eight games, not only would that be the 500th victory, but McCarney would also move into sixth place for coaching wins at NT.

#### **Award Candidates**

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 29 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

#### **Eight Is Enough**

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

#### Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

#### No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

#### **Quick Hitters**

North Texas ranks sixth in Conference USA in third-down conversion percentage (38.8 percent) and ranks fifth in fourth-down conversion percentage (55.6 percent).... North Texas ranks fifth in Conference USA in both penalties per game (6.0) and penalty yards per game (55.0).....North Texas has only allowed 5.25 tackles for loss per game. the fourth-lowest rate in Conference USA..... Andrew McNulty has thrown for 174.8 yards per game, which ranks seventh in Conference USA. His 303-yard passing game against Rice is the 17th-most passing yards by a quarterback in Conference USA this season. If he had enough games played and attempts to qualify, Jeffrey Wilson would rank third in Conference USA and 31st nationally averaging 105.5 rushing yards per game. .... Carlos Harris ranks fourth in Conference USA in receptions per game (6.8) and third in receiving yards per game. He is one of 12 players nationally to rank in the top 20 in both receptions per game (18th) and receiving yards per game (15th).....Carlos Harris ranks ninth in Conference USA in all-purpose yards, averaging 108.3 all-purpose yards per game.

#### Targeting Harris

The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is fifth in Conference USA in receiving yards a game at 92.0. Harris is two catches away from moving into fourth place at North Texas with 163 career receptions after grabbing nine catches against USM. He needs 37 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris jumped over Marcus Camper and Pete Harvey against Iowa in receiving yards for his career. He now stands eighth with 2,091 career receiving yards.

#### The Magic Numbers

Under head coach Dan McCarney, when scores 30 points or more, North Texas is a perfect 16-0. When leading after three quarters. NT is 19-2 under McCarney. North Texas is 9-0 when allowing 10 points or less under McCarney, but, dating back to 1988, that streak is 37-straight wins when holding opponents to 10 points or less.

#### **Red Zone Troubles**

The North Texas offense, which last season was the best in the nation inside the red zone, is having trouble in 2015. The Mean Green is scoring just 70 percent of the time inside the red zone, which is 11th in C-USA and 117th nationally. North Texas has only been inside the red zone 10 times this year, but only three touchdowns to show for it. The Mean Green has four field goals, but two turnovers this season inside the red zone.

#### First Down Woes

While North Texas is converting only 39 percent on 3rd down this season, digging deeping shows the trouble for the Mean Green offense on first-down has put them behind the chains. Of the 122 1st down plays run by North Texas this season, 70 of them have gone for five-yards or less, 57.3 percent. That has led to 44 3rd and long situations (3rd and 6 or more) of which North Texas has converted just 14-of-44, 31.8 percent.

#### One Final Act For The Jimmy Show

Antoinne Jimmerson moved into 13th place all-time in career rushing, carrying for 15 times against Iowa for 66 yards and giving him 1,794 career rushing yards. He scored his 23rd career touchdown against SMU and moved into seventh place all-time. He needs just 206 more yards to become the 11th running back in school history to reach 2,000 career yards.

#### One Of The Biggest

True freshman offensive lineman Jordan Murray checks in at 6-9 and 359 pounds. He made his first start of his career against Rice, he's the first true freshman offensive lineman to start a game since Cyril Lemon in 2011. He also happens to be one of the biggest players in FBS football. He is tied for thirdtallest player in the nation at 6-9, trailing two 6-10 players, but is the biggest player in the nation when it comes to being 6-9 or taller and 359 pounds.

#### **Among The Nation's Tops In Stops**

Kishawn McClain leads the nation averaging 8.8 solo tackles per game and also tallied a nation-best 14 solo tackles against Rice. He is followed closely behind by fellow safety James Gray ranks second in Conference USA and ranks sixth nationally averaging 7.0 solo tackles per game. They are one of two pairs of teammates (Salamo Fiso and Jordan Simone, Arizona State) who both rank among the top six tacklers in the nation. Kishawn McClain (2nd, 10.5 tackles/game) and James Gray (4th, 9.0 tackles/game) also rank among the top four tacklers in Conference USA. North Texas is one of seven teams nationally to have two tackles among its league's top four tacklers, along with Tulsa (AAC), Louisville (ACC), Bowling Green (MAC), Nevada (Mountain West), Georgia State and New Mexico State (Sun Belt).

#### **Bringing The Heat**

Jarrian Roberts ranks second in Conference USA and 12th nationally averaging 1.0 sacks per game. His career-high 3.0 sacks against Rice, tied for the most by a player in Conference USA this season and tied for the by a North Texas player since 1998. Roberts ranks third in Conference USA and 42nd nationally averaging 1.4 tackles for loss per game. His career-high 4.5 tackles for loss is the second-most by a Conference USA player this season.

#### 3rd Down Woes

The North Texas defense has struggled to get off the field when it has been 3rd down this season. It hasn't been 1st or 2nd down that has put them in a hole, it has been 3rd and long (more than seven yards) that has given them trouble. The QB's in 3rd-and-long against NT this season have completed 21-of-24, 87.5 percent of their passes. 15 of those have gone for a 1st down, four of them have gone for touchdowns. Against the run on 3rd down, opponents have converted 15 times on 26 rushing attempts, 60 percent of the time.

#### **Punt Return Troubles**

North Texas the last two seasons, has been one of the best teams in the nation in punt returns and punt return converage. 2015 hasn't been able to match the previous year's success yet. NT is averaging just 4.8 yards a punt return but is giving up 21.8 yards a return on punts. Punter Eric Keena has made it difficult for opponents to return kicks as he has pinned five of his 19 punts inside the 20-yard line, forced nine fair catches and had just one touchbacks.

#### Freshman All-America

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. He has made 42 straight PATs, leaving him 19 away from tying the school record Moore ranks 5th nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 84.0. This season Moore has made 6-of-9 kicks. Moore was a Lou Groza Award nominee.

#### That Kid Is One Of A Kind

Darvin Kidsy was one of six players in FBS to return a punt and a kickoff for a touchdown in 2014. He's one of three active players who completed the feat in 2014. The other five players are Marcus Murphy (Missouri), Tyreek Hill (Oklahoma State), William Likely (Maryland), Isaiah McKenzie (Georgia) and Kaelin Clay (Utah). It marked the second-straight season NT had a player return both a punt and kickoff for a TD, as Brelan Chancellor accomplished the feat in 2013.

#### Can't Touch This

Dan McCarney has emphasized special teams since his arrival in 2011 and the North Texas punt team has delivered. North Texas has not had a single punt blocked in the Dan McCarney era. The last NT punt that was blocked was in 2010 by Rice, a streak that is currently at 61 games. That streak is the fourth longest in the nation.

#### **Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive**

Since 2011 under Dan McCarney, NT has scored 21 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 19 touchdowns and two safeties. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and six fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 21 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power-5 teams in the nation with 21 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26), Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power-5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.



Dan McCarney knows how to build football programs. He was a part of a historic turnaround at Iowa State, and now you can add North Texas to that list. McCarney has turned around North Texas and taken the program to heights that were unthinkable when he arrived in 2011.

On their way to the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl Championship, the Mean Green won nine games in 2013, tied for the second most in school history and just the sixth time in 100 years North Texas has won nine games. The season culminated with North Texas winning the 2014 Heart of Dallas Bowl 36-14 over UNLV on January 1.

In 2014 McCarney powered North Texas to a 43-6 win over rival SMU, just the fifth win for NT in 34 games against the Mustangs. North Texas posted 77 points in a game in 2014, the fourth-highest total in a game in school history. 2014 also saw one of McCarney's first recruits at North Texas, offensive lineman Cyril Lemon, earn his fourth straight all-conference honor as he was named to the Conference USA first-team.

Lemon was the only player in the nation to start 49 straight games and earn all-conference honors in four straight years.

McCarney led the Mean Green to a 6-2 record in the inaugural season in Conference USA, tying for second place and the second most conference wins in school history. Along the way, the Mean Green broke offensive, defensive, special teams and attendance records.

The Mean Green achieved the biggest single season turnaround since 1982-83. The North Texas offense set a new school record for total offense in a single season, topping the 5,000-

yard mark for the first time. North Texas rushed for over 300-yards three times in 2013, which is the most in a season since 1959.

The North Texas defense allowed the fewest points per game since 2002, and tied for the second most sacks in school history.

McCarney is establishing a record of dominance at Apogee Stadium as North Texas has a home record of 16-7 at Apogee Stadium since 2011. The Mean Green went 5-1 at home in 2013, tying for the

second most wins in school history. The three seasons before 2011, the Mean Green went just 1-16 at home.

McCarney has won 22 games at North Texas, which already ranks in the top-10 all-time as he enters the 2015 season eighth in coaching wins. McCarney reached 18 wins faster at North Texas than any coach since Rod Rust in 1967-69 after his first three seasons.

He has brought out the best individually at North Texas as the Mean Green had 12 players earn 14 spots on the C-USA all-conference team in 2013, the second most in school history. Brelan Chancellor became just the second player in league history to earn first-team all-conference honors as a kick and punt returner, and was the only player in the nation to rank in the top 10 in punt and kick returns in 2013.

The North Texas resurgence was fueled by all three phases: offense, defense and special teams. Under McCarney, the Mean Green ranked in the top 10 in the nation in 2013 in fourth down conversion defense (fifth), blocked kicks (first), blocked punts (first), blocked punts allowed (first), fumbles recovered (fourth), sacks allowed (seventh), punt returns (fifth), red zone defense (second), scoring defense (eighth), sacks (seventh) and turnovers (fourth).

With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, including 13 years as a head coach at Iowa State University, McCarney is an established leader. He came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach at the University of Florida where he had been since 2008. He helped win a national championship at Florida.

McCarney began his coaching career at the University of Iowa, where he was an assistant under Fry for 11 years. He continued his career as the defensive coordinator at the University of Wisconsin under Alvarez, directing some of the best defensive teams in that schools history. At Wisconsin, McCarney helped turn a team that had won 10 games in five years into a Big 10 Conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance in his fourth year.

McCarney took over as head coach at Iowa State in 1995, assuming responsibility of a program that had enjoyed just three winning seasons in the 16 years prior to his arrival. McCarney led Iowa State to five bowl games from 2000-05 and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2004 when his team earned a Big 12 North cochampionship.





The North Texas defense generated three first-half turnovers of its own, stopped SMU three times inside the Mean Green five-yard line, and kept SMU quarterback Matt Davis under control for three quarters, but wore down and surrendered 21-straight points in a decisive fourth quarter.

DENTON - North Texas put up some impressive first-half numbers in the first home game of the season Saturday. Ouarterback Andrew McNulty completed 65 percent of his passes for 171 yards, the ground game rushed for 98 yards and averaged 7.5 yards per carry, the offense converted five-of-seven third downs, and the defense recorded three sacks. It should have added up to a nice lead in the Conference USA opener against Rice. And it was all undone by turnovers.

Two critical, crippling lost fumbles - one on a punt return and one that cut short a Mean Green drive deep in Rice territory - led to 10 first-half Rice points, and a third-quarter tipped-ball interception led to another Rice touchdown, sending North Texas to a 38-24 loss at Apogee Stadium.

"The thing we built this program on, the foundation that is so important to winning, is turnover margin and taking care of the football," North Texas head coach Dan Mc-Carney said. "When you're minus three on the day against a good team, you're going to have trouble winning."

HATTIESBURG, MS - Four weeks into the 2015 season, North Texas continues its search for consistency.

The return of running back Jeffrey Wilson paid big dividends Saturday night against Southern Miss, but even with his careerbest rushing performance, the Mean Green offense continued to be sporadic and mistake prone, and couldn't match a Golden Eagles' attack that steadily built momentum on its way to a 49-14 win over the Mean Green at Roberts Stadium. This is the first time North Texas has started the season 0-4 since 2008, and is the Mean Green's fifth loss in a row dating back to last year. Southern Miss improved to 3-2.

With sophomore Wilson back from injury and in the starting lineup for the first time this season, North Texas generated offense on the ground, rushing for 97 yards by half-time, with Wilson accounting for 77. Wilson finished with 136 yards, the second 100-plusyard game of his career and the most yards rushing for North Texas since Brandon Byrd had 251 against Tulsa in 2013.
