MEAN GREEN LOOK TO REGROUP ON THURSDAY NIGHT HOSTING WKU

→ North Texas has a quick turnaround as they face WKU on Thursday night at Apogee Stadium. The Mean Green is coming off 66-7 loss to Portland State to fall to 0-5 on the year, the first 0-5 start since 2008. WKU enters the game at 5-1 and a perfect 3-0 in C-USA play. North Texas holds a 4-2 series edge over the Hilltoppers and a 2-1 mark in Denton. WKU won the last matchup between the two teams, 25-24 in 2012.

- → Offensive coordinator Mike Canales has been named the interim head coach for the remainder of the season. It is the second stint for Canales as the Mean Green's interim head coach, as he coached the final five games in 2010, notching a 2-3 record.
- → North Texas is 0-5 to start the season for just the seventh time in school history. NT was last 0-5 in 2008. The Mean Green also lost back-to-back games at Apogee Stadium for the first time since it opened in 2011. North Texas has lost six straight games dating back to the end of 2014.
- → The loss at home to PSU was the largest margin of defeat at home in school history. The 66 points allowed were the most allowed at home since 2007 when Navy scored 74. The loss to Portland State represented the largest margin of defeat since Arkansas defeated North Texas by the same score on Sept. 29, 2007.
- → QB DaMarcus Smith will face his former team in WKU. Smith, spent two seasons at WKU in 2012 and 2013. He played in five games with WKU in 2013. Through three games thus far at North Texas, Smith is 6-for-18 for 105 yards and one touchdown.
- → Carlos Harris notched his fifth 100-yard receiving game with 136 yards and nine grabs against Southern Miss. He's averaging seven catches a game and could threaten the all-time receptions mark of 229 set by Casey Fitzgerald. He is 57 grabs away from him. He needs to average just over eight catches a game to potentially break the record. Harris is on pace for 87 catches this season, which would be the fourth-most in school history. Harris is also one of just 17 active players in the nation that have thrown, caught and run for a TD.
- → 16 of the 36 catches for Harris this season have gone for either a first-down or a touchdown. Since 2014, of the 106 receptions for Harris, 49.4 percent of them have been either a first-down or a touchdown.
- → North Texas committed a season-low one turnover but lost the turnover battle for the fourth consecutive game against Portland State. For the season, North Texas -7, which ranks 12th in Conference USA and 119th nationally. In three of the five games this season, NT has yet to cause one turnover.
- → While the turnover bug has gotten to North Texas the first three games, the defense the last two games has kept the opposition at bay. After allowing 44 points off of turnovers in the first three games, the Mean Green has only given up three points in the last two games off of turnovers.

#### THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

- **0** The Mean Green secondary is still searching for its first interception of the year after four games. NT is one of only eight teams left in FBS without an interception on defense this season. WKU has nine interceptions on the year, which is second in Conference USA
- **12** One big reason for the 5-1 start for WKU has been the turnover margin. The Hilltoppers are a +12 entering the game against the Mean Green, which is tied for No. 1 in the nation this season. North Texas meanwhile is -7 this year in turnover margin, which is 12th in the league and 119th in the nation.
- **15:00** The Mean Green has had trouble getting out of the locker room this season. NT is being outscored 42-6 in the first quarter of games and 65-17 in the third quarter. In 2014, it was the same problem as NT was outscored 100-62 in the first quarter and 108-57 in the third quarter. WKU is outscoring its opponents 91-17 in the first quarter of games this season.
- **33** Interim coach Mike Canales is familiar with WKU not just as the offensive coordinator for NT. The first game Canales coaches as the interim coach for the Mean Green in 2010 was against WKU and was a 33-6 North Texas win on the road in Bowling Green. That North Texas team was 1-6 entering the game in 2010.
- **43.9** Carlos Harris has done a bulk of the work for NT at the wide receiver position, having caught 36 of the 82 completions this season. That's 43.9 percent of the catches. Only two other players for the Mean Green has 10 or more catches, both tight ends in Marcus Smith and Chris Loving. WKU has five different players with 22 or more catches this season. The rest of the Mean Green wide receivers season have combined for just 19 receptions.
- **58.5** The Mean Green has had its trouble getting off the field on 3rd downs this season. Opponents are converting 58.5 percent on 3rd-down this season, which is last in FBS football this season. WKU is third in Conference USA coming into the game at 45 percent on 3rd down.

#### **Canales Takes The Reins**

Mike Canales, in his sixth year as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Mean Green, his 31st year in coaching at the collegiate and professional level, will serve as interim head coach for the second time during his tenure at North Texas. Taking over in 2010, he led North Texas to a 2-3 record.

#### **Weekday Warriors**

For the fourth straight year, North Texas plays a weeknight home game, and for the third straight year, North Texas plays a Thursday night home game. North Texas is 1-1 in those Thursday night contests with a 28-16 win over Rice in 2013 and a 42-21 loss to Louisiana Tech in 2014. North Texas also defeated Louisiana-Lafayette, on a Tuesday night, by a score of 30-23.

#### Lynn A Semifinalist For Campbell Trophy

North Texas senior fullback Jarrod Lynn was named a semifinalist by the National Football Foundation for the William V. Campbell Trophy. The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced the 135 semifinalists for the 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. Lynn is one of only 56 players from FBS football to be named a semifinalist and one of just three players from Conference USA. The NFF will announce 15 finalists on Oct. 29, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class.

#### Walkons Making A Difference

Since 2011 the North Texas walkon program has been thriving. 34 players have been put on scholarship since 2011. Four players have been named all-conference: WR Darnell Smith (2013), center Kaydon Kirby (2013, Lombardi- and Rimington-Award nominee in 2015), DB Kenny Buyers (2013), punter Blake Macek (2013). Defensive lineman Brandon McCov was the winner of the Armed Forces Merit Award in 2013 and. since 2011, walkons have made a total of 146 starts in four seasons. They have combined to rush for 1,686 yards and 19 TDs. The wide receivers have combined for 2,985 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns. In 2012, the top two receivers were walkons and three of the top-five were walkons. On defense since 2011, walkons have accounted for 400 tackles.

#### 100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. During the 100 seasons of football, North Texas has been to eight bowl games and won three. The program has also won 25 conference championships.

#### **Award Candidates**

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 29 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

#### **Eight Is Enough**

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

#### Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

#### No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

#### **Quick Hitters**

Carlos Harris ranks fourth in Conference USA in receptions (7.2/game), fifth in receiving yards per game (93.8/game) and tied for sixth with four receiving touchdowns for the season. He ranks 16th nationally in receptions per game and 22nd nationally in receiving yards per game ..... Offensively, North Texas ranks 11th in Conference USA in red-zone conversion scoring offense (72.7 percent) and 12th in the league in red-zone conversion touchdown scoring offense (36.4 percent).....Carlos Harris ranks 16th in Conference USA in all-purpose yards averaging 98.0 yards per game..... North Texas ranks seventh in Conference USA in both penalties per game (6.4/game) and penalty yards per game (58.8/game).

#### **Grounding It Out**

Jeffrey Wilson wasn't able to notch his second straight 100-yard rushing game of his career against Portland State, but he continues to lead the team on the ground, rushing for 260 yards on 46 carries in three games this season. If he had enough games played and rushing attempts to qualify, he would rank sixth in Conference USA in rushing (86.7 yards/game) and seventh in yards per carry (5.7 yards/carry), despite missing the first two games due to injury.

#### **Targeting Harris**

The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is fifth in Conference USA in receiving yards a game at 93.8. Harris is two catches away from moving into fourth place at North Texas with 172 career receptions after grabbing nine catches against USM. He needs 28 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris jumped to seventh in receiving yards with 56 against Portland State as he has 2,148 career receiving yards.

#### **Red Zone Troubles**

The North Texas offense, which last season was the best in the nation inside the red zone, is having trouble in 2015. The Mean Green is scoring just 72 percent of the time inside the red zone, which is 11th in C-USA and 117th nationally. North Texas has only been inside the red zone 11 times this year, but only four touchdowns to show for it. The Mean Green has four field goals, but two turnovers this season inside the red zone.

#### First Down Woes

While North Texas is converting only 34 percent on 3rd down this season, digging deeper shows the trouble for the Mean Green offense on first-down has put them behind the chains. Of the 148 1st down plays run by North Texas this season, 98 of them have gone for five-yards or less, 66.3 percent. That has led to 55 3rd and long situations (3rd and 6 or more) of which North Texas has converted just 15-of-55, 27.2 percent.

#### One Final Act For The Jimmy Show

Antoinne Jimmerson moved into 13th place all-time in career rushing, carrying for 15 times against Iowa for 66 yards and giving him 1,789 career rushing yards. He scored his 23rd career touchdown against SMU and moved into seventh place all-time. He needs just 211 more yards to become the 11th running back in school history to reach 2,000 career yards.

True freshman offensive lineman Jordan Murray checks in at 6-9 and 359 pounds. He made his first start of his career against Rice, he's the first true freshman offensive lineman to start a game since Cyril Lemon in 2011. He also happens to be one of the biggest players in FBS football. He is tied for third-tallest player in the nation at 6-9, trailing two 6-10 players, but is the biggest player in the nation when it comes to being 6-9 or taller and 359 pounds.

#### **Among The Nation's Tops In Stops**

Kishawn McClain and James Gray continue to rank first and second in Conference USA in solo tackles per game). McClain average 7.8 solo stops per game, while Gray average 6.6 solo stops per game. McClain leads all defensive backs nationally, while Gray is tied for fourth nationally. They are one of two pairs of teammates (Arizona State) ranked in the top 10 nationally in solo tackles per game. McClain's 14 solo tackles against Rice is tied for the most nationally this season. McClain and Gray are also tied for third in Conference USA, tied for 30th nationally, averaging 9.2 total tackles per game. Their 9.2 total tackles per game leads all C-USA defensive backs.

#### Streak Broken

North Texas had a rare special teams mistake against Portland State as a they blocked a punt. It was the first blocked punt allowed since Sept. 11, 2010 against Rice. It snapped a streak of 63 consecutive games without allowing a blocked punt, the fourth-longest streak in the nation.

#### Seeing Red In The Zone

Defensively, North Texas ranks 10th in Conference USA red-zone conversion scoring defense (85.2 percent) and last in the league in red-zone conversion touchdown scoring defense (77.8 percent). North Texas ranks fifth in Conference USA in tackles for loss allowed per game (5.8/game) and ranks ninth in sacks allowed per game (3.0/game).

#### 3rd Down Woes

The North Texas defense has struggled to get off the field when it has been 3rd down this season. It hasn't been 1st or 2nd down that has put them in a hole, it has been 3rd and long (more than seven yards) that has given them trouble. The QB's in 3rd-and-long against NT this season have completed 23-of-27, 85.1 percent of their passes. 17 of those have gone for a 1st down, four of them have gone for touchdowns. Against the run on 3rd down, opponents have converted 17 times on 31 rushing attempts, 55 percent of the time.

#### The Long Leg Of Keena

Eric Keena leads Conference USA and ranks seventh nationally averaging 46.7 yards per punt. He has had 10 punts of 50-plus years, including a season-long of 63 yards, and has downed six punts inside the 20-yard line in his 27 punt attempts this season.

#### **Punt Return Troubles**

North Texas the last two seasons, has been one of the best teams in the nation in punt returns and punt return converage. 2015 hasn't been able to match the previous year's success yet. NT is averaging just 4.9 yards a punt return but is giving up 21.8 yards a return on punts. Punter Eric Keena has made it difficult for opponents to return kicks as he has pinned six of his 27 punts inside the 20-yard line, forced 15 fair catches and had just one touchback.

#### Freshman All-America

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. Moore is a perfect 8-for-8 in PATs in 2015. He has made 45 straight PATs, leaving him 17 away from tying the school record Moore ranks 5th nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 84.0. This season Moore has made 6-of-9 kicks. Moore was a Lou Groza Award nominee.

#### That Kid Is One Of A Kind

Darvin Kidsy was one of six players in FBS to return a punt and a kickoff for a touchdown in 2014. He's one of three active players who completed the feat in 2014. The other five players are Marcus Murphy (Missouri), Tyreek Hill (Oklahoma State), William Likely (Maryland), Isaiah McKenzie (Georgia) and Kaelin Clay (Utah). It marked the second-straight season NT had a player return both a punt and kickoff for a TD, as Brelan Chancellor accomplished the feat in 2013.

#### **Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive**

Since 2011 NT has scored 21 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 19 touchdowns and two safeties. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and six fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 21 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power-5 teams in the nation with 21 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26), Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power-5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.

The return of running back Jeffrey Wilson paid big dividends Saturday night against Southern Miss, but even with his careerbest rushing performance, the Mean Green offense continued to be sporadic and mistake prone, and couldn't match a Golden Eagles attack that steadily built momentum on its way to a 49-14 win over the Mean Green at Roberts Stadium. This is the first time North Texas has started the season 0-4 since 2008, and is the Mean Green's fifth loss in a row dating back to last year. Southern Miss improved to 3-2.
