MEAN GREEN OPEN THE SECOND HALF OF THE SEASON AT MARSHALL

→ North Texas begins the second half of the season with a road-battle against the Marshall Thundering Herd. This marks a stretch of four of the next five games away from home as well for NT. The Mean Green is searching for its first win of the season. Marshall enters the game on a roll, having won five straight games. Marshall is unbeaten at home this season at 4-0.

- → The two teams are meeting for only the second time in series history. The only other previous meeting was in the I-AA playoffs when Marshall shutout North Texas 7-0 in 1988 in
- → North Texas has won 37 straight games when holding teams to 10 points or less. That streak dates back to 1988, and the last team to beat the Mean Green when scoring 10 points or less? Marshall.
- → Offensive coordinator Mike Canales has been named the interim head coach for the remainder of the season. It is the second stint for Canales as the Mean Green's interim head coach, as he coached the final five games in 2010, notching a 2-3 record.
- → North Texas is 0-6 to start the season for just the third time in school history. NT was last 0-6 in 2008. North Texas has lost seven straight games dating back to the end of 2014. The worst start in school history is 0-8, which was in 2008.
- → DaMarcus Smith became the first quarterback in school history to pass for 200 yards and run for 100 yards in the same game, completing 17-of-35 passes for 228 yards and rushing 16 times for 122 yards. His 122 yards rushing was also the most by a quarterback since Scott Davis rushed 34 times for 203 yards and two touchdowns against SMU in 1990.
- → The 121 points allowed against Portland State (66 points) and Western Kentucky (55 points) is the fourth-most points allowed in consecutive games in school history and the most points allowed in consecutive games since 2007.
- → North Texas looks to avoid running its losing streak to eight consecutive games, which would be the longest such streak since 2007-08, when the Mean Green lost nine straight games. The longest losing streak in school history is nine.
- → Carlos Harris notched his fifth 100-yard receiving game with 136 yards and nine grabs against Southern Miss. He's averaging just under seven catches a game and could threaten the all-time receptions mark of 229 set by Casey Fitzgerald. He is 53 grabs away from him. He needs to average just over eight catches a game to potentially break the record. Harris is on pace for 83 catches this season, which would be the fourth-most in school history. Harris is also one of just 17 active players in the nation that have thrown, caught and run for a TD.
- → 19 of the 40 catches for Harris this season have gone for either a first-down or a touchdown. Since 2014, of the 110 receptions for Harris, 49.6 percent of them have been either a first-down or a touchdown.

THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

- **23** Coming out of the locker room has been problematic for North Texas this season. In the first-quarter, the Mean Green has been outscored 56-6 while the third-quarter has seen NT outscored 79-17. North Texas has scored just a combined 23 points in the first and third-quarters. Marshall is outscoring its opponents 57-44 in the first quarter, but in the third-quarter that figure climbs to 62-20.
- **59** The Mean Green has had its trouble getting off the field on 3rd downs this season. Opponents are converting 59 percent on 3rd-down this season, which is last in FBS football this season. Marshall on the other hand has been very good on 3rd down, allowing just a 34 percent conversion rate, which is 40th in the nation.
- **84.9** Winning on the road has been a touch chore for North Texas of late, having lost nine straight games away from home. The last road win for the Mean Green was in 2013 at Tulsa. Marshall's home field advantage is one of the best in the nation. The Herd have won 84.9 percent of their game at Joan C. Edwards Stadium since opening (145-26), which is the second-best in the nation. Add to that, Marshall is perfect at home against teams from Texas at 11-0.
- **189.2** Marshall brings in the leagues top passing defense and second-best team in the league in total defense. The Thundering Herd are allowing just 189.2 yards through the air, while North Texas is 12th in the league in passing defense and last in total defense. Marshall is the league leader in points allowing, giving up just an average of 17.2 points a game while North Texas is last in the league, giving up 50.2 points a game.
- **200** North Texas has struggled to defend the run this season, allowing 261.8 yards on the ground this season. The Mean Green has allowed over 200-yards rushing in five of the six games this season. Marshall ran for a season-high 326 yards against FAU in their 33-17 win. The Thundering Herd are fourth in the league in rushing offense and have five different players with 100 yards rushing this season.

Canales Takes The Reins

Mike Canales, in his sixth year as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Mean Green, his 31st year in coaching at the collegiate and professional level, will serve as interim head coach for the second time during his tenure at North Texas. Taking over in 2010, he led North Texas to a 2-3 record.

Forgetting Marshall

The Mean Green and Thundering Herd are battling for just the second time in series history, and the first matchup went to Marshall 7-0 in the 1988 NCAA I-AA Playoffs. The two teams came into the game averaging a combined 694 yards of offense and 62 points a game, but the only score came when Marcus Camper fumbled a punt while attempting a fair catch. Marshall recovered it at the 40-yard line and six plays later scored the game's only touchdown, in the first quarter. NT had two chances late in the fourth-quarter, but were unable to get the game tying score.

Lynn A Semifinalist For Campbell Trophy

North Texas senior fullback Jarrod Lynn was named a semifinalist by the National Football Foundation for the William V. Campbell Trophy. The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced the 135 semifinalists for the 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. Lynn is one of only 56 players from FBS football to be named a semifinalist and one of just three players from Conference USA. The NFF will announce 15 finalists on Oct. 29, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class.

Walkons Making A Difference

Since 2011 the North Texas walkon program has been thriving. 34 players have been put on scholarship since 2011. Four players have been named all-conference: WR Darnell Smith (2013), center Kaydon Kirby (2013, Lombardi- and Rimington-Award nominee in 2015), DB Kenny Buyers (2013), punter Blake Macek (2013). Defensive lineman Brandon McCoy was the winner of the Armed Forces Merit Award in 2013 and, since 2011, walkons have made a total of 146 starts in four seasons. They have combined to rush for 1,686 yards and 19 TDs. The wide receivers have combined for 2,985 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns. In 2012, the top two receivers were walkons and three of the top-five were walkons. On defense since 2011, walkons have accounted for 400 tackles.

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. During the 100 seasons of football, North Texas has been to eight bowl games and won three. The program has also won 25 conference championships.

Award Candidates

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 29 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

Eight Is Enough

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

Jeffrey Wilson, if he had enough games played and rushing attempts to qualify, he would rank sixth in Conference USA in rushing (87.8 yards/game) and yards per carry (5.9 yards/carry).... Carlos Harris ranks 20th in Conference in all-purpose yards averaging 87.8 yards per game.... North Texas ranks sixth in Conference USA in both penalties per game (6.2/game) and sevenths in penalty yards per game (55.2/game)..... North Texas ranks seventh in Conference USA in tackles for loss allowed per game (6.2/game) and ranks ninth in sacks allowed per game (2.5/game).... The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is fifth in Conference USA in receiving yards a game at 85.3. Harris is two catches away from moving into fourth place at North Texas with 176 career receptions after grabbing nine catches. He needs 24 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris jumped to sixth in receiving yards with 43 against WKU as he has 2,191 career receiving yards. Harris has 12 careeer receiving touchdowns, which leaves him just two away from the top-10 all-time in that category.

Red Zone Troubles

The North Texas offense, which last season was the best in the nation inside the red zone, is having trouble in 2015. The Mean Green is scoring just 72 percent of the time inside the red zone, which is 11th in C-USA and 117th nationally. North Texas has only been inside the red zone 11 times this year, but only four touchdowns to show for it. The Mean Green has four field goals, but two turnovers this season inside the red zone.

First Down Woes

While North Texas is converting only 35 percent on 3rd down this season, digging deeper shows the trouble for the Mean Green offense on first-down has put them behind the chains. Of the 179 1st down plays run by North Texas this season, 119 of them have gone for five-yards or less, 66.4 percent. That has led to 73 3rd and long situations (3rd and 6 or more) of which North Texas has converted just 17-of-73, 23.2 percent.

One Final Act For The Jimmy Show

Antoinne Jimmerson moved into 13th place all-time in career rushing, carrying for 15 times against Iowa for 66 yards and giving him 1,789 career rushing yards. He scored his 23rd career touchdown against SMU and moved into seventh place all-time. He needs just 211 more yards to become the 11th running back in school history to reach 2,000 career yards.

Freshman Get The Call

True freshmen Nate Brooks and Ashton Preston made their first-career starts at cornerback, the first freshman duo to start at cornerback since redshirt freshmen Antoine Bush and Desmon Chatman started the last game of the 2006 season. Freshman line-backer Darrien McNair also saw his first action of the season against WKU. North Texas has had a bit of youth movement this season, as 18 either true or redshirt freshman have seen action this season for the Mean Green.

A Pick From The Defense

Zac Whitfield intercepted Brandon Doughty in the second quarter. It was the eighth of Whitfield's career, the Mean Green's first interception of the season, and it was just the fourth time that Doughty had been picked off this season. Whitfield's interception was also the first turnover forced in three games, last recovering two fumbles against Iowa on Sept. 26.

Among The Nation's Tops In Stops

Kishawn McClain and James Gray continue to rank first and second in Conference USA in solo tackles per game). McClain averages 7.5 solo stops per game, while Gray average 6.2 solo stops per game. McClain leads all defensive backs nationally, while Gray ranks sixth nationally. They are one of three pairs of teammates (Arizona State and Maryland State) ranked in the top 14 nationally in solo tackles per game. Kishawn McClain's 14 solo tackles against Rice is tied for the most nationally this season. Gray ranks third in Conference USA, 23rd nationally, averaging 9.3 tackles per game, while McClain ranks fifth in Conference USA, 27th nationally, averaging 9.2 tackles per game. They are one of three pairs of teammates (Marshall and Tulsa) ranked in the top 30 nationally in tackles per game.

Points Allowed

The 170 points allowed against Southern Miss (49 points), Portland State (66 points) and Western Kentucky (55) is the secondmost points allowed over three games in school history, second only to a three-game stretch in 2008.

Seeing Red In The Zone

Defensively, North Texas ranks ninth in Conference USA red-zone conversion scoring defense (87.9 percent) and last in the league in red-zone conversion touchdown scoring defense (78.8 percent). North Texas ranks sixth in Conference USA in both penalties per game (6.2/game) and seventh in penalty yards per game (55.2/game). North Texas ranks seventh in Conference USA in tackles for loss allowed per game (6.2/game) and ranks ninth in sacks allowed per game (2.5/game).

3rd Down Woes

The North Texas defense has struggled to get off the field when it has been 3rd down this season. It hasn't been 1st or 2nd down that has put them in a hole, it has been 3rd and long (more than seven yards) that has given them trouble. The QB's in 3rd-and-long against NT this season have completed 28-of-35, 80.1 percent of their passes. 20 of those have gone for a 1st down, four of them have gone for touchdowns. Against the run on 3rd down, opponents have converted 21 times on 35 rushing attempts, 60 percent of the time.

The Long Leg Of Keena

Eric Keena leads Conference USA and ranks seventh nationally averaging 45.9 yards per punt. He has had 10 punts of 50-plus years, including a season-long of 63 yards, and has downed seven punts inside the 20-yard line in his 32 punt attempts this season.

Streak Broken

North Texas had a rare special teams mistake against Portland State as a they blocked a punt. It was the first blocked punt allowed since Sept. 11, 2010 against Rice. It snapped a streak of 63 consecutive games without allowing a blocked punt, the fourth-longest streak in the nation.

Freshman All-America

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. Moore is a perfect 12-for-12 in PATs in 2015. He has made 49 straight PATs, leaving him 12 away from tying the school record Moore ranks 5th nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 84.0. This season Moore has made 6-of-9 kicks. Moore was a Lou Groza Award nominee.

Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive

Since 2011 NT has scored 21 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 19 touchdowns and two safeties. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and six fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 21 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power-5 teams in the nation with 21 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26), Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power-5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.

DALLAS - An inconsistent North Texas offense, which had rolled up and down the field a year ago against SMU, coughed and sputtered and struggled in Saturday night's season opener, losing two fumbles, throwing two interceptions, and failing to generate scoring chances or to take advantage of opportunities presented to it in a 31-13 loss to the Mustangs at Gerald J. Ford Stadium.

The North Texas defense generated three first-half turnovers of its own, stopped SMU three times inside the Mean Green five-yard line, and kept SMU quarterback Matt Davis under control for three quarters, but wore down and surrendered 21-straight points in a decisive fourth quarter.

"They outplayed us in the second half," North Texas coach Dan McCarney said. "They made the plays, we didn't. You turn the ball over four times, you're rarely going to win football games. That was the difference in the game."
