HALLOWEEN BATTLE WITH UTSA ON TAP FOR THE MEAN GREEN

→ North Texas returns home to Apogee for a Halloween visit from UTSA. The Mean Green is still searching for its first win of the season after a 30-13 loss to Marshall. UTSA has only one win on the year as they enter the game at 1-6. The Roadrunners are coming off a bye week. UTSA has won the only two meetings between the two teams, which has been by less than 10 points. The Roadrunners won 21-13 in Denton in 2013 and 34-27 in San Antonio, in 2014.

→ Offensive coordinator Mike Canales has been named the interim head coach for the remainder of the season. It is the second stint for Canales as the Mean Green's interim head coach, as he coached the final five games in 2010, notching a 2-3 record.

 \rightarrow Running back Jeffrey Wilson notched his second 100-yard rushing performance of the year with a career-high 138 yards against Marshall. He was just the third RB to rush for 100-yards against Marshall as he averaged 8.1 yards a rush.

→ Wilson, will qualify with one more game for the conference rankings, would rank fourth in C-USA with 97.8 yards a game. He is averaging 6.4 yards per carry, which is on pace to be the most yards per carry by a North Texas RB (min.100 carries) since Lance Dunbar had 6.9 a rush in 2009.

→ North Texas has been susceptible to the big play this season (20 yards or more). Opponents have had 49 plays of 20-or-more yards against the Mean Green defense, while the NT offense has only 26 plays of 20-or-more yards through the first seven games.

→ North Texas is 0-7 to start the season for just the third time in school history. NT was last 0-7 in 2008. North Texas has lost eight straight games dating back to the end of 2014. The worst start in school history is 0-8, which was in 2008. The Mean Green must beat UTSA to avoid tying the longest losing streak in school history at nine.

→ DaMarcus Smith became the first quarterback in school history to pass for 200 yards and run for 100 yards in the same game, completing 17-of-35 passes for 228 yards and rushing 16 times for 122 yards against WKU. His 122 yards rushing was also the most by a quarterback since Scott Davis rushed 34 times for 203 yards and two touchdowns against SMU in 1990.

→ Carlos Harris notched his fifth 100-yard receiving game with 136 yards and nine grabs against Southern Miss. He's averaging just under seven catches a game and could threaten the all-time receptions mark of 229 set by Casey Fitzgerald. He is 51 grabs away from him. He needs to average just over eight catches a game to potentially break the record. Harris is on pace for 80 catches this season, which would be the fourth-most in school history. Harris is also one of just 17 active players in the nation that have thrown, caught and run for a TD.

→ 19 of the 42 catches for Harris this season have gone for either a first-down or a touchdown. Since 2014, of the 112 receptions for Harris, 49.3 percent of them have been either a first-down or a touchdown.

THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

1 - Coming out of the locker room has been problematic for North Texas this season. In the first-quarter, the Mean Green has been outscored 73-6 while the third-quarter has seen NT outscored 82-20. UTSA hasn't been much better. The Roadrunners are being outscored 57-13 in the first quarter of games this season. UTSA is a better third-quarter team than NT, as they have scored 52 points, the most of any quarter this season.

6 - North Texas is on pace for its worst turnover margin since the 2009 season. The Mean Green is -9 for the year, and in conference games NT is -6. UTSA in conference this year is best in Conference USA at +6 in turnover margin.

12:21 - After scoring first in the first two games of the season against SMU and Rice, North Texas has allowed its opponent to score first in the last five. North Texas has rarely found itself in the lead this season. For only 12 minutes and 21 seconds the Mean Green has enjoyed a lead in a game. Not since early in the second quarter against Rice has North Texas had a lead in a game, which covers a span of 341 minutes and 35 seconds.

31 - For the second time in three years, NT is at home on Halloween night. 2013 brought a 28-16 win over Rice, which catapulted the Mean Green to the top of the West Division standings. Overall the Mean Green is 7-4-1 when playing on Halloween night.

59 - The Mean Green has had its trouble getting off the field on 3rd downs this season. Opponents are converting 55.2 percent on 3rd-down this season, which is last in FBS football this season. UTSA on the other hand is only converting 37.8 percent on 3rd-downs this season.

200 - North Texas has struggled to defend the run this season, allowing 254.9 yards on the ground this season. The Mean Green has allowed over 200-yards rushing in six of the seven games this season. UTSA on the ground this season is only averaging 147.7, which is ninth in the league. In conference games only, North Texas is third in rushing with just under 200-yards a game, 198.7, while UTSA is 11th at 116.3.

Canales Takes The Reins

Mike Canales, in his sixth year as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Mean Green, his 31st year in coaching at the collegiate and professional level, will serve as interim head coach for the second time during his tenure at North Texas. Taking over in 2010, he led North Texas to a 2-3 record.

Smashing Start

DaMarcus Smith became the 10th different quarterback in school history to throw four or more touchdown passes in a game against WKU. It was the 16th four-touchdown passing game in school history, the first since Riley Dodge threw for four touchdown passes against Western Kentucky in 2009. Lynn A Semifinalist For Campbell Trophy North Texas senior fullback Jarrod Lynn was named a semifinalist by the National Football Foundation for the William V. Campbell Trophy. The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced the 135 semifinalists for the 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. Lynn is one of only 56 players from FBS football to be named a semifinalist and one of just three players from Conference USA. The NFF will announce 15 finalists on Oct. 29, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class.

Walkons Making A Difference

Since 2011 the North Texas walkon program has been thriving. 34 players have been put on scholarship since 2011. Four players have been named all-conference: WR Darnell Smith (2013), center Kaydon Kirby (2013, Lombardi- and Rimington-Award nominee in 2015), DB Kenny Buyers (2013), punter Blake Macek (2013). Defensive lineman Brandon McCoy was the winner of the Armed Forces Merit Award in 2013 and, since 2011, walkons have made a total of 146 starts in four seasons. They have combined to rush for 1,686 yards and 19 TDs. The wide receivers have combined for 2,985 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns. In 2012, the top two receivers were walkons and three of the top-five were walkons. On defense since 2011, walkons have accounted for 400 tackles.

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green enter the year needing eight wins to reach 500 victories in school history. During the 100 seasons of football, North Texas has been to eight bowl games and won three. The program has also won 25 conference championships.

Award Candidates

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 29 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

Eight Is Enough

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

Ouick Hitters

Carlos Harris ranks seventh in Conference USA in receptions (6.0/game), sixth in receiving yards per game (74.6/game) and fourth with six receiving touchdowns for the season. He ranks 19th nationally in receptions per game and 31st nationally in receiving yards per game Jeffrey Wilson, if he had enough games played and rushing attempts to qualify, he would rank third in Conference USA in rushing (97.8 yards/ game) and fourth in yards per carry (6.6 yards/carry)..... North Texas ranks 12th in Conference USA, 117th of 128 teams nationally, in yards per play (4.69 yards/play) and ranks 12th in the league, 124th of 128 teams nationally, in yards per play allowed (7.21 yards/play).....North Texas ranks last in the nation in scoring margin (-30.9 points/per game), 127th of 128 teams in scoring defense (47.3 points per game) and 124th in scoring offense (16.4 points per game).....North Texas ranks last in Conference USA, 108th of 128 teams nationally in third-down conversion percentage (33.9 percent) and ranks last in the nation in third-down conversion percentage defense (55.7 percent).

The Offense Gets Running

The rushing attack for North Texas had yet to find its rhythm until the last two games. The Mean Green has topped the 200-yard rushing mark in two straight games, the first time over 200-yards this season. The first five games NT was averaging just 146.2 yards a game on the ground, the last two that number has jumped to 206.0 yards a game. The total offensive output has also climbed to 384.0 yards the last two games, up from 331.6 the first five.

Targeting Harris

The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is fifth in Conference USA in receiving yards a game at 85.3. Harris is five catches away from moving into third place at North Texas with 178 career receptions. He needs 22 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris jumped to sixth in receiving yards with 43 against WKU as he has 2,201 career receiving touchdowns, which leaves him just two away from the top-10 all-time in that category.

Red Zone Troubles

The North Texas offense, which last season was the best in the nation inside the red zone, is having trouble in 2015. The Mean Green is scoring just 76 percent of the time inside the red zone, which is 9th in C-USA and 109th nationally. North Texas has only been inside the red zone 17 times this year, but has only seven touchdowns to show for it. The Mean Green has four field goals, but two turnovers this season inside the red zone.

First Down Woes

While North Texas is converting only 35 percent on 3rd down this season, digging deeper shows the trouble for the Mean Green offense on first-down has put them behind the chains. Of the 211 1st down plays run by North Texas this season, 137 of them have gone for five-yards or less, 64.9 percent. That has led to 74 3rd and long situations (3rd and 6 or more) of which North Texas has converted just 19-of-74, 25.6 percent.

One Final Act For The Jimmy Show

Antoinne Jimmerson moved into 13th place all-time in career rushing, carrying for 15 times against Iowa for 66 yards and giving him 1,799 career rushing yards. He scored his 23rd career touchdown against SMU and moved into seventh place all-time. He needs just 201 more yards to become the 11th running back in school history to reach 2,000 career yards.

True freshman offensive lineman Jordan Murray checks in at 6-9 and 359 pounds. He made his first start of his career against Rice, he's the first true freshman offensive lineman to start a game since Cyril Lemon in 2011. He also happens to be one of the biggest players in FBS football. He is tied for thirdtallest player in the nation at 6-9, trailing two 6-10 players, but is the biggest player in the nation when it comes to being 6-9 or taller and 359 pounds.

Defense Gets Stout

The Mean Green defense allowed a seasonlow 402 yards and 30 points against Marshall. In the second half, the Mean Green limited Marshall to only six points and 141 yards, 27 of which came on a fake punt. NT outscored Marshall 10-6 in the second half, which is the first time this season the Mean Green has outscored an opponent in the second half of a game.

Freshman Get The Call

True freshmen Nate Brooks and Ashton Preston made their first-career starts at cornerback, the first freshman duo to start at cornerback since redshirt freshmen Antoine Bush and Desmon Chatman started the last game of the 2006 season. Freshman linebacker Darrien McNair also saw his first action of the season against WKU. North Texas has had a bit of youth movement this season, as 18 either true or redshirt freshman have seen action this season for the Mean Green. That ranks 27th in terms of number of freshman that have played in the nation this season.

A Pick From The Defense

Zac Whitfield intercepted Brandon Doughty in the second quarter. It was the eighth of Whitfield's career, the Mean Green's first interception of the season, and it was just the fourth time that Doughty had been picked off this season. Whitfield's interception was also the first turnover forced in three games, last recovering two fumbles against Iowa on Sept. 26. North Texas however has only forced six turnovers on the season. In 2014, seven different defensive backs come up with an interception.

Among The Nation's Tops In Stops

Kishawn McClain and James Grav continue to rank first and second in Conference USA in solo tackles per game). McClain averages 6.9 solo stops per game, sixth-best in the nation, while Gray average 5.6 solo stops per game, which ranks 22nd nationally. They are one of four pairs of teammates (Arizona State, Buffalo and Maryland) ranked in the top 22 nationally in solo tackles per game. Kishawn McClain's 14 solo tackles against Rice is tied for the second-most nationally this season. Gray ranks third in Conference USA, 22th nationally, averaging 9.9 tackles per game, while McClain ranks fourth in Conference USA, 30th nationally, averaging 9.6 tackles per game. They are one of three pairs of teammates (Bowling Green and Texas Tech) ranked in the top 30 nationally in tackles per game.

Flawless PAT Man

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. Moore is a perfect 13-for-13 in PATs in 2015. He has made 50 straight PATs, leaving him 12 away from breaking the school record Moore ranks 5th nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 82.1. This season Moore has made 8-of-11 kicks. Moore was a Lou Groza Award nominee.

Seeing Red In The Zone

Defensively, North Texas ranks 10th in Conference USA red-zone conversion scoring defense (87.5 percent) and last in the league in red-zone conversion touchdown scoring defense (72.5 percent). Offensively, North Texas ranks ninth in Conference USA in red-zone conversion scoring offense (76.5 percent) and 10th in the league in red-zone conversion touchdown scoring offense (41.2 percent).

3rd Down Woes

The North Texas defense has struggled to get off the field when it has been 3rd down this season. It hasn't been 1st or 2nd down that has put them in a hole, it has been 3rd and long (more than seven yards) that has given them trouble. The QB's in 3rd-andlong against NT this season have completed 32-of-42, 76.1 percent of their passes. 22 of those have gone for a 1st down, four of them have gone for touchdowns. Against the run on 3rd down, opponents have converted 25 times on 41 rushing attempts, 61 percent of the time.

The Long Leg Of Keena

Eric Keena leads Conference USA and ranks 10th nationally averaging 45.5 yards per punt. He has had 10 punts of 50-plus yards, including a season-long of 63 yards, and has downed nine punts inside the 20-yard line in his 36 punt attempts this season.

Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive

Since 2011 NT has scored 21 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 19 touchdowns and two safeties. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and six fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 21 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power-5 teams in the nation with 21 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26), Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power-5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.

DALLAS - An inconsistent North Texas offense, which had rolled up and down the field a year ago against SMU, coughed and sputtered and struggled in Saturday night's season opener, losing two fumbles, throwing two interceptions, and failing to generate scoring chances or to take advantage of opportunities presented to it in a 31-13 loss to the Mustangs at Gerald J. Ford Stadium.

The North Texas defense generated three first-half turnovers of its own, stopped SMU three times inside the Mean Green five-yard line, and kept SMU quarterback Matt Davis under control for three quarters, but wore down and surrendered 21-straight points in a decisive fourth quarter.

"They outplayed us in the second half," North Texas coach Dan McCarney said. "They made the plays, we didn't. You turn the ball over four times, you're rarely going to win football games. That was the difference in the game."

The return of running back Jeffrey Wilson paid big dividends Saturday night against Southern Miss, but even with his careerbest rushing performance, the Mean Green offense continued to be sporadic and mistake prone, and couldn't match a Golden Eagles' attack that steadily built momentum on its way to a 49-14 win over the Mean Green at Roberts Stadium. This is the first time North Texas has started the season 0-4 since 2008, and is the Mean Green's fifth loss in a row dating back to last year. Southern Miss improved to 3-2.

With sophomore Wilson back from injury and in the starting lineup for the first time this season, North Texas generated offense on the ground, rushing for 97 yards by halftime, with Wilson accounting for 77. 


