FRESH OFF THE FIRST WIN OF THE SEASON, NT BEGINS THREE GAME ROAD TRIP

→ North Texas begins the final month of the regular season with three straight games on the road, starting with a battle at West Division leader Louisiana Tech. The Mean Green snapped its eight-game losing streak and grabbed its first win of the year over UTSA. La Tech is 6-3 on the year and sits tied with Southern Miss atop the West Division standings at 4-1. They have won five of their last six games and are perfect at 4-0 at home this season.

→ Louisiana Tech captured the meeting last season in Apogee 42-21 and have a one-game edge in the series 7-6 over NT. The Mean Green leads 5-3 in games in Ruston, including a 28-13 win in 2013.

→ QB DaMarcus Smith and running back Jeffrey Wilson made history against UTSA, becoming the first QB and RB combination in school history to rush for 100-yards in the same game. It was also the first time since 2012 that NT has had two players rush for over 100-yards in the same game.

→ Smith has tied Scott Davis for the school record for most 100-yard rushing games by a quarterback with two. Smith's two 100-yard rushing games in a single season are a school record, as Davis rushed for over 100 yards twice, one in 1988 and again in 1990.

→ North Texas reached 30 points for the first time in 2015 and also won its 17 straight game when scoring 30 points or more. The last time the Mean Green scored 30 points or more and lost was the final game of the 2010 season against Kansas State.

→ Jeffrey Wilson leads Conference USA and ranks 23rd nationally in all-purpose yards averaging 140.2 yards per game. Wilson ranks fourth in Conference USA and 31st nationally in rushing, averaging 102.7 yards per game. In conference games, he ranks second in the league, averaging 123.0 yards per game.

→ North Texas is seeking to snap its 10-game road losing streak and pick up their first road win since defeating Tulsa 42-10 on Nov. 30, 2013. North Texas is seeking back-to-back wins for the first time since defeating Tulsa 42-10 and UNLV 36-14 to end the 2013 season. North Texas is also seeking back-to-back regular season wins for the first time since winning five games in a row, also during the 2013 season.

→ Wilson notched his second straight 100 yard rushing game of the year and his third of the year with 127 yards against UTSA. He now has four 100-yard rushing games for his career. If Wilson goes for 100 yards against La Tech, he will be just the 10th player in school history to run for 100 yards in three straight games, and the first since Lance Dunbar in 2011.

→ Carlos Harris notched his fifth 100-yard receiving game of his career with 136 yards and nine grabs against Southern Miss. He's averaging six catches a game and could threaten the all-time receptions mark of 229 set by Casey Fitzgerald. He is 45 grabs away from him. He needs to average just over 11 catches a game to potentially break the record. Harris is on pace for 72 catches this season. Harris is also one of just 17 active players in the nation that have thrown, caught and run for a TD.

THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

1 - Coming out of the locker room has been problematic for North Texas this season. In the first-quarter, the Mean Green has been outscored 80-6 while the third-quarter has seen NT outscored 89-27. The Bulldogs are outscoring their opponents 90-56 in the first quarter, but the second quarter that figure balloons to 139-46. North Texas for the season has scored 145 points.

20 - In 2014 the Mean Green had the best red-zone offense in the nation, this season that figure has slipped and NT is converting just 72.7 percent of the time, compared to 94.3 percent last season. Louisiana Tech however is last in C-USA and 108th in the nation in red-zone defense, giving up points 90 percent of the time.

26.5 - The last two games the North Texas defense has been much improved, allowing just a combined 26.5 points a game and 438.5 yards of total offense. The previous six games the Mean Green defense had been allowing 50.1 points a game and 570 yards of total offense. La Tech presents a big challenge for the defense as they are the second highest scoring team in the league. WR Trent Taylor is third in the nation with 1,003 receiving yards and is averaging 111.4 yards per game.

100 - This game features two of the top backs in Conference USA in Jeffrey Wilson and Kenneth Dixon. Both players are averaging over 100 yards a game, Dixon is third in the league in rushing at 105.4 yards per game and Wilson is fourth at 102.7. Dixon is the leading scorer in Conference USA and he is fourth in the nation in scoring with 14 touchdowns this season. Wilson is 22nd in the nation in yards per carry averaging 6.3.

226 - In the last three games the North Texas running game has found its stride, averaging 226 yards a game and topping the 200-yard mark in all three. That will put to the test against La Tech. The Bulldogs bring in the best rushing defense in the league, allowing just 100.1 yards a game on the ground, which is also ninth best in the nation. The last two games the North Texas defense has been much improved, allowing 438.5 yards of total offense and

Canales Takes The Reins

Mike Canales, in his sixth year as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Mean Green, his 31st year in coaching at the collegiate and professional level, will serve as interim head coach for the second time during his tenure at North Texas. Taking over in 2010, he led North Texas to a 2-3 record.

Davis And McClain Named Players Of The Week

After providing two of the most pivotal plays in the win over UTSA, Kishawn McClain and Chad Davis were named Defensive and Special Teams Players of the Week by Conference USA. McClain had the pivotal fumble recovery and return for a 45-yard touchdown return in the third quarter. The scoop and score was the first defensive score by North Texas this season and gave the Mean Green the lead its first lead over UTSA. He notched a game-high 11 tackles and had 0.5 tackles for loss. The fumble return for a TD was the first by a NT defender since 2014 and it was the longest fumble return for a TD since 2013. Davis had a game-changing return of a blocked PAT for North Texas against UTSA. With UTSA poised to go up by three points in the fourth quarter after scoring a touchdown to retake the lead, Davis returned the blocked extra point 80 yards for a two-point conversion to tie the game, instead of having his team go down by three points.

Smashing Start

DaMarcus Smith became the 10th different quarterback in school history to throw four or more touchdown passes in a game against WKU. It was the 16th four-touchdown passing game in school history, the first since Riley Dodge threw for four touchdown passes against Western Kentucky in 2009. Lynn A Semifinalist For Campbell Trophy

North Texas senior fullback Jarrod Lynn was named a semifinalist by the National Football Foundation for the William V. Campbell Trophy. The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced the 135 semifinalists for the 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. Lynn is one of only 56 players from FBS football to be named a semifinalist and one of just three players from Conference USA.

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green needs seven wins to reach 500 victories in school history. During the 100 seasons of football, North Texas has been to eight bowl games and won three. The program has also won 25 conference championships.

Award Candidates

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 29 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

Eight Is Enough

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

Quick Hitters

DaMarcus Smith leads Conference USA quarterbacks and ranks 12th among all C-USA players, averaging 51.7 yards per game. He is averaging 5.9 yards per carry, which also leads C-USA quarterbacks and ranks sixth among all C-USA players.... Smith ranks 21st among all quarterbacks nationally averaging 51.7 rushing yards per game.... Carlos Harris ranks fifth in Conference USA in receptions/game (6.0), sixth in receiving yard/game (74.3) and seventh in receiving touchdowns (6).... In conference games, North Texas ranks ninth in scoring offense (21.8 ppg) and 11th in scoring defense (39.0 ppg)....North Texas ranks fourth in Conference USA and 63rd nationally averaging 176.25 yards per game. In conference games, the Mean Green ranks second in the league averaging 207.8 yards per game.... North Texas also ranks second in the league in yards per carry (4.73 ypc) and second in the league in yards per carry in conference games (5.50 ypc).

The Offense Gets Running

The rushing attack for North Texas had yet to find its rhythm until the last three games. The Mean Green has topped the 200-yard rushing mark in three straight games, the first time with three 200-yard rushing performances since 2012. The first five games NT was averaging just 146.2 yards a game on the ground, the last three that number has jumped to 226.0 yards a game. The total offensive output has also climbed to 381.0 yards the last two games, up from 331.6 the first five. If North Texas can top the 200-yard mark on the ground against Louisiana Tech, it would be the first time since 2004 that the Mean Green has had four straight games of rushing for over 200-yards.

Targeting Harris

The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is sixth in Conference USA in receiving yards a game at 74.3. Harris moved into third place at North Texas with 184 career receptions with six grabs against UTSA, and is just four away from climbing to second. He needs 16 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris has 2,273 career receiving yards. Harris has 12 career receiving touchdowns, which leaves him just two away from the top-10 all-time in that category. Harris can also climb into the top-10 in all-purpose yardage at North Texas. He has 2,973 for his career and needs only 39 more yards to move into the top-10.

Red Zone Troubles

The North Texas offense, which last season was the best in the nation inside the red zone, is having trouble in 2015. The Mean Green is scoring just 76 percent of the time inside the red zone, which is 9th in C-USA and 109th nationally. North Texas has only been inside the red zone 17 times this year, but has only seven touchdowns to show for it. The Mean Green has four field goals, but two turnovers this season inside the red zone.

First Down Woes

While North Texas is converting only 35 percent on 3rd down this season, digging deeper shows the trouble for the Mean Green offense on first-down has put them behind the chains. Of the 239 1st down plays run by North Texas this season, 154 of them have gone for five-yards or less, 64.9 percent. That has led to 80 3rd and long situations (3rd and 6 or more) of which North Texas has converted just 19-of-80, 23.7 percent.

Treats On Halloween Again

The Mean Green won for the second straight Halloween night in Apogee Stadium, and registered some of the same numbers from the Rice win in 2013 as they did against UTSA. North Texas won despite being outgained for the first time since Halloween Night 2013, when North Texas was outgained 355-253 but defeated Rice by a score of 28-16. In addition, Kishawn McClain had a scoop and score of a fumble for 45-yards for a touchdown, which was the longest fumble return for a TD since Zach Orr went for 55-yards against Rice on Halloween night.

A Tackling Machine

Safety Kishawn McClain has been automatic when it comes to making tackles this season, leading the Mean Green with 80. McClain has four games this season with 10 or more tackles. He is well on his way to becoming the first safety to lead NT in tackles since Aaron Weathers did in 2006. At his current pace of 10 tackles a game, McClain will end up with 120 for the season, which would be the eighth most in school history and the most by a member of the secondary in school history. James Gray isn't far behind McClain with 75 tackles on the season and the pair could become the first two safeties in school history to each register 100 tackles in a season.

Blocking Out

North Texas notched its first blocked kick of the season against UTSA, which resulted in a two-point play as Chad Davis returned the block 80-yards for the two points. Since 2013, North Texas has 10 blocked kicks on special teams, which is tied for the fourth most in the nation with Oklahoma State and Rutgers. Only Georgia Tech, BYU and Air Force have more blocked kicks than NT since 2013.

Freshman Get The Call

True freshmen Nate Brooks and Ashton Preston made their first-career starts at cornerback, the first freshman duo to start at cornerback since redshirt freshmen Antoine Bush and Desmon Chatman started the last game of the 2006 season. Freshman linebacker Darrien McNair also saw his first action of the season against WKU. North Texas has had a bit of youth movement this season, as 18 either true or redshirt freshman have seen action this season for the Mean Green. That ranks 27th in terms of number of freshman that have played in the nation this season.

Among The Nation's Tops In Stops

Kishawn McClain and James Gray rank first and second in Conference USA with 7.0 solo tackles and 5.6 solo tackles per game, respectively. McClain is tied for fifth nationally, while Gray is tied for 21st. They are one of four pairs of teammates (Arizona State, Maryland, Virginia) with two players ranked among the top 24 nationally in solo stops. Kishawn McClain and James Gray rank second and fourth in Conference USA with 10.0 and 9.4 total tackles per game, respectively. McClain is tied for 16th nationally, while Gray is tied for 23rd. They are one of two pairs of teammates (Virginia) with two players ranked among the top 27 nationally in total stops.

Flawless PAT Man

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. Moore is a perfect 17-for-17 in PATs in 2015. He has made 54 straight PATs, leaving him eight away from breaking the school record Moore ranks 21st nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 79.1. This season Moore has made 8-of-12 kicks. Moore was a Lou Groza Award nominee.

Seeing Red In The Zone

Defensively, North Texas ranks 11th in Conference USA and 104th nationally in red-zone scoring percentage defense (88.6) and last in the league and 116th nationally in red-zone touchdown scoring percentage defense (72.7). Offensively, North Texas ranks 11th in Conference USA and 119th nationally in red-zone scoring percentage (72.7) and 10th in the league and 117th nationally in red-zone touchdown scoring percentage (45.5).

3rd Down Woes

The North Texas defense has struggled to get off the field when it has been 3rd down this season. It hasn't been 1st or 2nd down that has put them in a hole, it has been 3rd and long (more than seven yards) that has given them trouble. The QB's in 3rd-and-long against NT this season have completed 37-of-48, 77.0 percent of their passes. 24 of those have gone for a 1st down, four of them have gone for touchdowns. Against the run on 3rd down, opponents have converted 32 times on 52 rushing attempts, 61 percent of the time.

The Long Leg Of Keena

Eric Keena ranks third in Conference USA and 13th nationally in punting average (44.9). He has 10 punts of 50 or more yards and has landed 10 of his 40 punts inside the 20-yard line. In addition Keena was a nominee for the Ray Guy Award in 2015, which is awarded to the nation's top punter.

Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive

Since 2011 NT has scored 23 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 20 touchdowns, two safeties and one blocked PAT returned for two points. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and seven fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 23 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power-5 teams in the nation with 23 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26), Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power-5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.

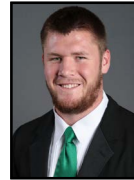
