MEAN GREEN STEP OUT OF LEAGUE PLAY FOR BATTLE WITH VOLUNTEERS

→ North Texas closes out non-conference play as they visit the Tennessee Volunteers. The Mean Green dropped a 56-13 game to Louisiana Tech to begin the three-game road trip. Tennessee snuck by South Carolina with a 27-24 win to improve to 5-4 on the year. The Vols have won three of their last four games.

- → North Texas and Tennessee are meeting for only the second time in series history. The only other meeting was perhaps the greatest win in program history for NT, a 21-14 victory in Knoxville in 1975. The win over Tennessee is one of only three wins for the Mean Green over a team from the SEC.
- → Jeffrey Wilson has 683 yards rushing yards through seven games. He needs 317 more yards on the ground to record his first career 1,000 yard rushing season, which would be the 15th 1,000 yard season in school history and the fifth one in the last seven years. Wilson for his career has 907 rushing yards.
- → Carlos Harris moved into the top-10 all-time at North Texas in all-purpose yardage. Harris has 3,047 all-purpose yards, which is ninth all-time in Mean Green history.
- The Mean Green has dropped 13 straight non-conference road games and since 2001 is 1-38 on the road in non-conference games. The only non-conference road win came in 2009 at Ball State to begin the season.
- → Harris also moved into second-place all-time with 188 receptions, passing Johnny Quinn. In addition Harris notched his seventh TD catch of the season and 13th for his career. He is one receiving touchdown away from moving into the top-10 all-time. Harris has 14 total touchdowns for his career, which is now tied for seventh all-time.
- → Zac Whitfield had his second interception of the year and the ninth of his career. He needs one more to become the eighth player in school history with 10 interceptions for a career. His nine career interceptions is tied for ninth among all Division I FBS players.
- → Jeffrey Wilson ranks second in Conference USA and ranks 28th nationally in all-purpose yards averaging 133.9 yards per game. Wilson ranks fourth in Conference USA and 36th nationally in rushing, averaging 97.6 yards per game. In conference games, he ranks fifth in the league, averaging 111.8 yards per game.
- → North Texas is seeking to snap its 11-game road losing streak and pick up their first road win since defeating Tulsa 42-10 on Nov. 30, 2013. North Texas is seeking back-to-back wins for the first time since defeating Tulsa 42-10 and UNLV 36-14 to end the 2013 season.
- → Carlos Harris notched his fifth 100-yard receiving game of his career with 136 yards and nine grabs against Southern Miss. He's averaging six catches a game and could threaten the all-time receptions mark of 229 set by Casey Fitzgerald. He is 40 grabs away from him. He needs to average just over 12 catches a game to potentially break the record. Harris is also one of just 17 active players in the nation that have thrown, caught and run for a TD.

## THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

- **1** Coming out of the locker room has been problematic for North Texas this season. In the first-quarter, the Mean Green has been outscored 101-6 while the third-quarter has seen NT outscored 103-27. Tennessee on the other hand is outscoring its opponents in the first-quarter 93-45 and 83-55 in the third-quarter.
- 17 Tennessee has dropped four games on the season, but by just a combined 17 points in the four games. At home the Volunteers have lost two games by seven points and four points. The Mean Green on the road this season has give up an average of 45.6 points a game.
- **20** North Texas has lost the turnover battle in eight of the nine games this season and for the year is a -10 with a total of 20 turnovers. Opponents have made North Texas pay for their mistakes, outscoring the Mean Green 89-34 in points off of turnovers. Tennessee has only 11 turnovers on the year but limited the damage to only 28 points allowed off of their mistakes.
- **40.6** Evan Berry is perhaps the most dangerous kickoff return man in the nation with three returns for a TD. He is averaging 40.6 yards a return, which is tops in the nation. The Mean Green might have found a new weapon in Tre Johnson as a kickoff return man. Against Louisiana Tech, Johnson had four kickoff returns for an average of 32.8 yards.
- **55** North Texas has continued to struggle to get off the field on third down. The Mean Green is allowing its opponents to convert 55 percent of the time on third downs, which remains last in the nation. Tennessee is converting at a rate of 46 percent on third downs this season, which ranks 25th in the country on third down.
- **200** The last four games North Texas has rushed for over 200 yards and is averaging 190.2 yards a game during that four-game stretch. The 200-yard mark has been a bit of a magic number for North Texas since 2011 as they have a record of 13-4 when rushing for over 200 yards. Tennessee has run for over 200 yards five times this season and the Volunteers are this in the SEC in rushing at 207.3 yards a game.

#### **Canales Takes The Reins**

Mike Canales, in his sixth year as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Mean Green, his 31st year in coaching at the collegiate and professional level, will serve as interim head coach for the second time during his tenure at North Texas. Taking over in 2010, he led North Texas to a 2-3 record.

## Davis And McClain Named Players Of The Week

After providing two of the most pivotal plays in the win over UTSA, Kishawn McClain and Chad Davis were named Defensive and Special Teams Players of the Week by Conference USA. McClain had the pivotal fumble recovery and return for a 45-yard touchdown return in the third quarter. The scoop and score was the first defensive score by North Texas this season and gave the Mean Green the lead its first lead over UTSA. He notched a game-high 11 tackles and had 0.5 tackles for loss. The fumble return for a TD was the first by a NT defender since 2014 and it was the longest fumble return for a TD since 2013. Davis had a game-changing return of a blocked PAT for North Texas against UTSA. With UTSA poised to go up by three points in the fourth quarter after scoring a touchdown to retake the lead, Davis returned the blocked extra point 80 yards for a two-point conversion to tie the game, instead of having his team go down by three points.

#### **Smashing Start**

DaMarcus Smith became the 10th different quarterback in school history to throw four or more touchdown passes in a game against WKU. It was the 16th four-touchdown passing game in school history, the first since Riley Dodge threw for four touchdown passes against Western Kentucky in 2009. ## Lynn A Semifinalist For Campbell Trophy

North Texas senior fullback Jarrod Lynn was named a semifinalist by the National Football Foundation for the William V. Campbell Trophy. The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced the 135 semifinalists for the 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. Lynn is one of only 56 players from FBS football to be named a semifinalist and one of just three players from Conference USA.

#### 100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green needs seven wins to reach 500 victories in school history. During the 100 seasons of football, North Texas has been to eight bowl games and won three. The program has also won 25 conference championships.

#### **Award Candidates**

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 29 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

### **Eight Is Enough**

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

#### **Three Named First-Team C-USA**

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

## No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

#### **Quick Hitters**

DaMarcus Smith leads Conference USA quarterbacks and ranks 12th among all C-USA players, averaging 50.7 rushing yards per game. He is averaging 5.3 yards per carry, which also leads C-USA quarterbacks and ranks ninth among all C-USA players... Smith ranks 23rd among all quarterbacks nationally averaging 50.7 rushing yards per game..... Jeffrey Wilson is averaging 6.0 yards per carry, which ranks fourth in Conference USA. In conference games, he is averaging 6.2 yards per carry, which ranks fifth in the league.... North Texas ranks seventh in Conference USA and 76th nationally in rushing offense averaging 165.78 yards per game. In conference play, the Mean Green ranks fourth in the league averaging 186.83 yards per game.... North Texas also ranks fifth in the league in yards per carry (4.47 ypc) and fifth in the league in yards per carry in conference games (4.98 ypc)....North Texas ranks last in Conference USA and 109th nationally in total offense (345.9 ypg) and 12th in the league and 116th nationally in yards per play (4.73 ypp).

#### The Offense Gets Running

Last four games, the ground attack of has been revitalized by Jeffrey Wilson and DaMarcus Smith. North Texas has rushed for 190.2 yards a game in the last four, and topped the 200 yard mark in three of the last four games. Wilson and Smith have been doing nearly all of the work, as the two have combined to rush for 743 of the 761 yards during that time, which is 97.6 percent of the rushing yards. Smith and Wison have each rushed for 100 yards twice in the last four games. With one more 100 yard rushing game, Smith will have the school record for most 100 yard rushing performances by a QB, as he sits with two.

## **Targeting Harris**

The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is sixth in Conference USA in receiving yards a game at 74.3. Harris moved into second place at North Texas with 189 career receptions with fivegrabs against LA Tech, and is now chasing only Casey Fitzgerald for the record. He needs 11 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris has 2,347 career receiving yards. Harris has 13 careeer receiving touchdowns, which leaves him just one away from the top-10 all-time in that category.

#### **Red Zone Troubles**

The North Texas offense, which last season was the best in the nation inside the red zone, is having trouble in 2015. The Mean Green is scoring just 76 percent of the time inside the red zone, which is ninth in C-USA and 109th nationally. North Texas has only been inside the red zone 25 times this year, but has only 12 touchdowns to show for it. The Mean Green has six field goals, but five turnovers this season inside the red zone.

#### First Down Woes

While North Texas is converting only 35 percent on 3rd down this season, digging deeper shows the trouble for the Mean Green offense on first-down has put them behind the chains. Of the 270 1st down plays run by North Texas this season, 177 of them have gone for five-yards or less, 65.5 percent. That has led to 90 3rd and long situations (3rd and 6 or more) of which North Texas has converted just 22-of-90, 24.4 percent.

### **Treats On Halloween Again**

The Mean Green won for the second straight Halloween night in Apogee Stadium, and registered some of the same numbers from the Rice win in 2013 as they did against UTSA. North Texas won despite being outgained for the first time since Halloween Night 2013, when North Texas was outgained 355-253 but defeated Rice by a score of 28-16. In addition, Kishawn McClain had a scoop and score of a fumble for 45-yards for a touchdown, which was the longest fumble return for a TD since Zach Orr went for 55-yards against Rice on Halloween night.

#### One Of The Biggest

True freshman offensive lineman Jordan Murray checks in at 6-9 and 359 pounds. He made his first start of his career against Rice, he's the first true freshman offensive lineman to start a game since Cyril Lemon in 2011. He also happens to be one of the biggest players in FBS football. He is tied for third-tallest player in the nation at 6-9, trailing two 6-10 players, but is the biggest player in the nation when it comes to being 6-9 or taller and 359 pounds.

#### A Tackling Machine

Safety Kishawn McClain has been automatic when it comes to making tackles this season, leading the Mean Green with 83. McClain has four games this season with 10 or more tackles. He is well on his way to becoming the first safety to lead NT in tackles since Aaron Weathers did in 2006. At his current pace of 9.2 tackles a game, McClain will end up with 111 for the season, which would be the 12th most in school history and the second highest by a member of the secondary in school history. Fellow safety James Gray isn't far behind McClain with 80 tackles on the season and the pair could become the first two safeties in school history to each register 100 tackles in a season.

## A Big Little Man

Return man Tre Johnson has been very hard to find and bring down the last few weeks on special teams. Johnson, who stands at just 5-6, the smallest on the roster, had four kickoff returns for an average of 32.8 yards against LA Tech, which included a long of 53. He also ripped off a 37 yard punt-return against LA Tech and is averaing 16.6 yards a return.

#### **Blocking Out**

North Texas notched its first blocked kick of the season against UTSA, which resulted in a two-point play as Chad Davis returned the block 80-yards for the two points. Since 2013, North Texas has 10 blocked kicks on special teams, which is tied for the fourth most in the nation with Oklahoma State and Rutgers. Only Georgia Tech, BYU and Air Force have more blocked kicks than NT since 2013.

## Freshman Get The Call

True freshmen Nate Brooks and Ashton Preston made their first-career starts at cornerback, the first freshman duo to start at cornerback since redshirt freshmen Antoine Bush and Desmon Chatman started the last game of the 2006 season. Freshman linebacker Darrien McNair also saw his first action of the season against WKU. North Texas has had a bit of youth movement this season, as 18 either true or redshirt freshman have seen action this season for the Mean Green. That ranks 27th in terms of number of freshman that have played in the nation this season.

#### **Among The Nation's Tops In Stops**

Kishawn McClain and James Gray rank first and second in Conference USA with 6.6 solo tackles and 5.4 solo tackles per game, respectively. McClain is tied for sixth nationally, while Gray is tied for 28th. McClain and Gray rank third and fourth in Conference USA with 9.2 and 8.9 total tackles per game, respectively. McClain is tied for 26th nationally, while Gray is tied for 36th. two pairs of teammates (Virginia) with two players ranked among the top 27 nationally in total stops.

#### Flawless PAT Man

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. Moore is a perfect 18-for-18 in PATs in 2015. He has made 55 straight PATs, leaving him seven away from breaking the school record Moore ranks 21st nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 79.1. This season Moore has made 8-of-12 kicks. Moore was a Lou Groza Award nominee.

#### Seeing Red In The Zone

Defensively, North Texas ranks 12th in Conference USA and 113th nationally in redzone scoring percentage defense (90.0) and last in the league and 123rd nationally in redzone touchdown scoring percentage defense (76.0). Offensively, North Texas ranks 12th in Conference USA and 121st nationally in redzone scoring percentage (72.0) and ninth in the league and 112th nationally in redzone touchdown scoring percentage (48.0).

#### 3rd Down Woes

The North Texas defense has struggled to get off the field when it has been 3rd down this season. It hasn't been 1st or 2nd down that has put them in a hole, it has been 3rd and long (more than seven yards) that has given them trouble. The QB's in 3rd-and-long against NT this season have completed 39-of-52, 75.0 percent of their passes. 25 of those have gone for a 1st down, four of them have gone for touchdowns. Against the run on 3rd down, opponents have converted 35 times on 55 rushing attempts, 63 percent of the time.

### The Long Leg Of Keena

Eric Keena ranks second in Conference USA and 11th nationally in punting average (44.8). He has 10 punts of 50 or more yards and has landed 10 of his 41 punts inside the 20-yard line. In addition Keena was a nominee for the Ray Guy Award in 2015, which is awarded to the nation's top punter.

## **Defense and Special Teams Getting Offensive**

Since 2011 NT has scored 23 times on defense or special teams. The Mean Green has 20 touchdowns, two safeties and one blocked PAT returned for two points. The Mean Green has four blocked punts that resulted in TDs, two punt returns, one kickoff return, six interception returns for TD, and seven fumble returns for a touchdown. Dating back to the 2010 season, the Mean Green has scored 23 touchdowns from either the defense or special teams, which ranks 16th in the nation. North Texas is one of only four non-Power-5 teams in the nation with 23 or more TDs since 2010. Only Houston (26). Boise State (24) and Fresno State (23) rank ahead of NT of schools from a non-Power-5 league. Oregon leads the nation since 2010 with 32.
