MEAN GREEN FINISH ROAD TRIP WITH ANOTHER VISIT TO VOLUNTEER STATE

→ North Texas closes out the three-game road trip by heading back to Tennessee, this time
to face the Blue Raiders of MTSU. The Mean Green has dropped two straight games after
falling 24-0 to Tennessee. Middle Tennessee is 5-5 on the year and coming off a 24-17 win at
Florida Atlantic. The Blue Raiders are 4-1 this season at home.

- → NT and MTSU are meeting for the 14th time in series history. The Mean Green has a series edge of 8-5 over the Blue Raiders and three of the last four games. NT is 4-2 in games in Murfreesboro and one of the three wins under Interim HC Mike Canales came at MTSU, 23-17 in 2010.
- \rightarrow North Texas was shutout for the first time since 2011 by Tennessee. The Mean Green defense held the Volunteers to 24 points, which was the fewest points allowed to an SEC team since giving up only 19 points to Vanderbilt in 1996.
- → The Mean Green defense allowed a season-low 24 points at Tennessee. In the second half, the defense held the Volunteers scoreless in the third-quarter, the first time the Mean Green hasn't given up a point in the third quarter this season. In the 20 second-half quarters played, it is just the second (Rice, fourth-quarter) that North Texas held a team scoreless.
- → The first quarter has been treacherous for North Texas this season. They have been outscored 108-6 and have not scored a first-quarter TD this season. The offensive totals show struggles as teams are averaging 143.1 yards in the first quarter this season against North Texas, while the Mean Green is averaging only 56.3 yards in the first quarter.
- → Now at 1-9 on the season, the Mean Green need wins in their final two games to avoid double-digit losses this year. In the program's first 91 seasons, North Texas had just one campaign (1972) with 10 or more defeats. But with a loss in either of the final two games this year, North Texas will have its fourth double-digit-loss season in the last 10 years.
- → Jeffrey Wilson has 735 yards rushing yards through eight games. He needs 265 more yards on the ground to record his first career 1,000 yard rushing season, which would be the 15th 1,000 yard season in school history and the fifth one in the last seven years. Wilson for his career has 959 rushing yards, leaving him 41 away from 1,000 career rushing yards.
- → Carlos Harris moved into the top-10 all-time at North Texas in all-purpose yardage. Harris has 3,067 all-purpose yards, which is ninth all-time in Mean Green history.
- → Harris also moved into second-place all-time with 191 receptions, passing Johnny Quinn. In addition Harris notched his seventh TD catch of the season and 13th for his career. He is one receiving touchdown away from moving into the top-10 all-time. Harris has 14 total touchdowns for his career, which is now tied for seventh all-time.
- → Zac Whitfield has nine interceptions for his career. He needs one more to become the eighth player in school history with 10 interceptions for a career. His nine career interceptions is tied for ninth among all Division I FBS players.
- → North Texas is seeking to snap its 12-game road losing streak and pick up their first road win since defeating Tulsa 42-10 on Nov. 30, 2013.

THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

- 1 Coming out of the locker room has been problematic for North Texas this season. In the first-quarter, the Mean Green has been outscored 108-6 while the third-quarter has seen NT outscored 103-27. MTSU has scored 93 first quarter points, but allowed 89 through 10 games this season. The Blue Raiders in the third quarter this season have outscored their opponents 62-30
- 7 North Texas is still searching for its first touchdown of the season in the first quarter. The Mean Green has managed only two field goals. The last first quarter points NT scored came against Rice. MTSU has allowed 12 first-quarter touchdowns this season.
- 15 MTSU enters the game at a -5 in turnover margin and most of that can be attributed to the 15 fumbles the Blue Raiders have lost this season. That is the most in the nation this season. NT has had troubles of their own holding the ball having lost 11 fumbles.
- 18 In the four wins at Middle Tennessee, the Mean Green has done it with defense, holding the Blue Raiders to an average of 18 points a game. In the two losses, the Blue Raiders have scored an average of 36.5 points a game.
- **33** North Texas enters the game last in C-USA in 3rd down conversion percentage at 33 percent this season. The Mean Green in the last four games have only converted 17 third-downs and a rate of 30 percent. MTSU is seventh in the league at surrendering 39 percent on third-down this season.
- **3,000** MTSU freshman QB Brent Stockstill is the fourth 3,000 yard passer that North Texas has faced this season. Stockstill has thrown for 3,099 yards, which is third in C-USA and the most yards by a freshman in the FBS football in the nation. The Mean Green defense is coming off a game that saw them hold Tennessee to just 172 yards through the air, the second lowest total allowed this season and the third-time NT has held a team to less than 200-yards passing.

Canales Takes The Reins

Mike Canales, in his sixth year as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for the Mean Green, his 31st year in coaching at the collegiate and professional level, will serve as interim head coach for the second time during his tenure at North Texas. Taking over in 2010, he led North Texas to a 2-3 record.

Davis And McClain Named Players Of The Week

After providing two of the most pivotal plays in the win over UTSA, Kishawn McClain and Chad Davis were named Defensive and Special Teams Players of the Week by Conference USA. McClain had the pivotal fumble recovery and return for a 45-yard touchdown return in the third quarter. The scoop and score was the first defensive score by North Texas this season and gave the Mean Green the lead its first lead over UTSA. He notched a game-high 11 tackles and had 0.5 tackles for loss. The fumble return for a TD was the first by a NT defender since 2014 and it was the longest fumble return for a TD since 2013. Davis had a game-changing return of a blocked PAT for North Texas against UTSA. With UTSA poised to go up by three points in the fourth quarter after scoring a touchdown to retake the lead, Davis returned the blocked extra point 80 yards for a two-point conversion to tie the game, instead of having his team go down by three points.

Smashing Start

DaMarcus Smith became the 10th different quarterback in school history to throw four or more touchdown passes in a game against WKU. It was the 16th four-touchdown passing game in school history, the first since Riley Dodge threw for four touchdown passes against Western Kentucky in 2009. Lynn A Semifinalist For Campbell Trophy

North Texas senior fullback Jarrod Lynn was named a semifinalist by the National Football Foundation for the William V. Campbell Trophy. The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame announced the 135 semifinalists for the 2015 William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. Lynn is one of only 56 players from FBS football to be named a semifinalist and one of just three players from Conference USA.

100th Season Of Football

2015 is the 100th season of North Texas football. The Mean Green needs seven wins to reach 500 victories in school history. During the 100 seasons of football, North Texas has been to eight bowl games and won three. The program has also won 25 conference championships.

Award Candidates

Three North Texas players came out of the summer on five national award watch lists heading into the 2015 season. Junior center Kaydon Kirby, who has started 29 straight games as a former walkon, was named to the Rimington and Lombardi Award watch lists. WR Carlos Harris is the first NT player to be named to the Paul Hornung Award watch list and just the third Mean Green player to earn a Biletnikoff Award nomination. Not to be outdone, placekicker Trevor Moore was one of just 30 kickers nationwide and one of just two from C-USA to be named to the Lou Groza Award watch list.

Eight Is Enough

The Mean Green schedule is pretty daunting considering eight of the 12 opponents were bowl eligible in 2014 and five were bowl champions. NT has to face Marshall, Louisiana Tech and Tennessee on the road, all of which won their bowl games. The Mean Green still faces Iowa on the road (lost to Tennessee in a bowl game) and has Rice, WKU and UTEP at home. MTSU was bowl eligible in 2014, and NT faces the Blue Raiders on the road in November.

Three Named First-Team C-USA

Wide receiver Carlos Harris, center Kaydon Kirby and placekicker Trevor Moore were tabbed to the 2015 Conference USA preseason first-team. Harris and Moore were both C-USA honorable mention in 2014, and Moore was also named to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Kirby was a 2013 C-USA All-Freshman pick.

No Rest In 2015

North Texas had a bye week in the opening week of college football, but, following that open week, it faces a dozen weeks of football. NT plays 12-straight weeks without a break, which is tied for the third longest in the nation. Only two programs in the nation, Colorado and Hawai'i, will play 13 straight weeks without a bye in 2015.

Quick Hitters

DaMarcus Smith leads Conference USA quarterbacks and ranks 13th among all C-ÛSA players, averaging 43.6 rushing yards per game. He is averaging 4.5 yards per carry, which also leads C-USA quarterbacks and ranks 17th among all C-USA players.... DaMarcus Smith ranks 25th among all quarterbacks nationally averaging 43.6 rushing yards per game....Carlos Harris ranks eighth in Conference USA in receptions/game (5.5), eighth in receiving yard/game (68.8) and fifth in receiving touchdowns (7). Jeffrey Wilson ranks fourth in Conference USA and 41st nationally in rushing, averaging 91.9 yards per game. In conference games, he ranks third in the league, averaging 111.8 yards per game.... Wilson is averaging 5.7 yards per carry, which ranks eighth in Conference USA. In conference games, he is averaging 6.2 yards per carry, which ranks fifth in the league.....Wilson ranks second in Conference USA and ranks 28th nationally in all-purpose yards averaging 133.9 yards per game. Wilson ranks fourth in Conference USA and 36th nationally in rushing, averaging 97.6 yards per game. In conference games, he ranks fifth in the league, averaging 111.8 yards per game.

Holding The Ball

One glaring area that North Texas has been lacking in has been time of possession. Through the first eight games, the Mean Green was averaging 25:03 in time of possession. which was last in the nation. The last two games has seen North Texas have the ball for 32:53 against LA Tech and 30:59 against Tennessee, the only times the Mean Green has won the TOP battle.

One Last Push

North Texas offensively will have to make up some ground to avoid having less than 4,000 yards of total offense for the second straight year. Not since the 2005-06 season has NT had two straight years of less than 4,000 yards of total offense. North Texas is averaging just 15.8 points a game, which would be the fewest ppg since 2006, and only the fourth time since 2001 the Mean Green has been held to under 20 points a game. NT ranks 123rd in the nation in scoring offense.

Targeting Harris

The fifth-most targeted player among all receivers nationally last season, Carlos Harris is sixth in Conference USA in receiving yards a game at 74.3. Harris moved into second place at North Texas with 189 career receptions with five grabs against LA Tech, and is now chasing only Casey Fitzgerald for the record. He needs 11 more catches to become just the second player in school history with 200. Harris has 2,347 career receiving yards. Harris has 13 career receiving touchdowns, which leaves him just one away from the top-10 all-time in that category.

Red Zone Troubles

The North Texas offense, which last season was the best in the nation inside the red zone, is having trouble in 2015. The Mean Green is scoring just 76 percent of the time inside the red zone, which is ninth in C-USA and 109th nationally. North Texas has only been inside the red zone 25 times this year, but has only 12 touchdowns to show for it. The Mean Green has six field goals, but five turnovers this season inside the red zone.

First Down Woes

While North Texas is converting only 35 percent on 3rd down this season, digging deeper shows the trouble for the Mean Green offense on first-down has put them behind the chains. Of the 295 1st down plays run by North Texas this season, 194 of them have gone for five-yards or less, 65.7 percent. That has led to 98 3rd and long situations (3rd and 6 or more) of which North Texas has converted just 23-of-98, 23.4 percent.

Treats On Halloween Again

The Mean Green won for the second straight Halloween night in Apogee Stadium, and registered some of the same numbers from the Rice win in 2013 as they did against UTSA. North Texas won despite being outgained for the first time since Halloween Night 2013, when North Texas was outgained 355-253 but defeated Rice by a score of 28-16. In addition, Kishawn McClain had a scoop and score of a fumble for 45-yards for a touchdown, which was the longest fumble return for a TD since Zach Orr went for 55-yards against Rice on Halloween night.

One Of The Biggest

True freshman offensive lineman Jordan Murray checks in at 6-9 and 359 pounds. He made his first start of his career against Rice, he's the first true freshman offensive lineman to start a game since Cyril Lemon in 2011. He also happens to be one of the biggest players in FBS football. He is tied for third-tallest player in the nation at 6-9, trailing two 6-10 players, but is the biggest player in the nation when it comes to being 6-9 or taller and 359 pounds.

Tackling Machines

Safety's Kishawn McClain and James Gray has been automatic when it comes to making tackles this season, leading the Mean Green with 87 apiece. McClain has four games this season with 10 or more tackles. The pair are well on their way to becoming the first safeties to lead NT in tackles since Aaron Weathers did in 2006. At the current pace of 8.7 tackles a game, McClain and Gray will end up with 105 for the season, which would be the 12th most in school history and the secondary in school history. The pair could become the first two safeties in school history to each register 100 tackles in a season.

Ouick Hitters

North Texas allowed just 409 yards of total offense against Tennessee, their second-lowest total of the season, and held the Volunteers below their season averages in both vards and points....North Texas has forced turnovers in three consecutive games, its longest streak of the season, and won the turnover margin (plus-1) for the first time this season. It was also just the fourth time that Tennessee had lost the turnover margin this season.... Jarrian Roberts recorded his sixth sack of the season, the 10th of his career. Roberts is tied for fifth in Conference USA with 6.0 sacks this season. His 9.5 tackles for loss also ranks 10th in the league.... Chad Davis became the second North Texas player with an interception this season, his second career interception and the third interception by the Mean Green this season.

A Big Little Man

Return man Tre Johnson has been very hard to find and bring down the last few weeks on special teams. Johnson, who stands at just 5-6, the smallest on the roster, had four kickoff returns for an average of 32.8 yards against LA Tech, which included a long of 53. He also ripped off a 37 yard punt-return against LA Tech and is averaging 16.6 yards a return.

Blocking Out

North Texas notched its first blocked kick of the season against UTSA, which resulted in a two-point play as Chad Davis returned the block 80-yards for the two points. The special teams got another one at Tennessee when Calvin Minor blocked a punt. Since 2013, North Texas has 11 blocked kicks on special teams, which is tied for the second most in the nation with BYU and Air Force. Only Georgia Tech has more blocked kicks than NT in the nation since 2013.

Among The Nation's Tops In Stops

Kishawn McClain and James Gray rank first and third in Conference USA with 6.2 solo tackles and 5.5 solo tackles per game, respectively. McClain is tied for eighth nationally, while Gray is tied for 30th. They are one of four pairs of teammates ranked in the top 36 nationally in solo tackles (Arizona State, Georgia State, Hawaii). McClain and Gray are tied for third in Conference USA and tied or 44th nationally with 8.7 total tackles per game. They are both 13 tackles shy of 100 total tackles for the season.

Flawless PAT Man

Placekicker Trevor Moore earned freshman All-America honors after hitting 15-of-17 in field goals and he was a perfect 37-for-37 in PATs. Moore is a perfect 18-for-18 in PATs in 2015. He has made 55 straight PATs, leaving him seven away from breaking the school record Moore ranks 21st nationally among active kickers with a field goal percentage of 79.1. This season Moore has made 8-of-12 kicks. Moore was a Lou Groza Award nominee.

Seeing Red In The Zone

Offensively, North Texas ranks 10th in Conference USA and 119th nationally in red-zone scoring percentage (72.0) and ninth in the league and 114th nationally in red-zone touchdown scoring percentage (48.0). Defensively, North Texas ranks 11th in Conference USA and 96th nationally in red-zone scoring percentage defense (87.3) and last in the league and 119th nationally in red-zone touchdown scoring percentage defense (72.7).

3rd Down Woes

The North Texas defense has struggled to get off the field when it has been 3rd down this season. It hasn't been 1st or 2nd down that has put them in a hole, it has been 3rd and long (more than seven yards) that has given them trouble. The QB's in 3rd-and-long against NT this season have completed 44-of-59, 74.5 percent of their passes. 29 of those have gone for a 1st down, four of them have gone for touchdowns. Against the run on 3rd down, opponents have converted 38 times on 62 rushing attempts, 61 percent of the time.

The Long Leg Of Keena

Eric Keena ranks third in Conference USA and 21st nationally in punting average (44.0). He has 11 punts of 50 or more yards and has landed 12 of his 49 punts inside the 20-yard line, including a 62-yard punt downed at the 11-yard line against Tennessee. In addition Keena was a nominee for the Ray Guy Award in 2015, which is awarded to the nation's top punter.
