## IONA RETURNS HOME TO FACE NORTH TEXAS





The Gaels look to get back on the winning tracks in the friendly confines of the Hynes Athletics Center Wednesday afternoon in their first ever match up against the University of North Texas.

#### **IONA VS. NORTH TEXAS - SERIES HISTORY**

• This afternoon is the first ever tip-off between the Iona College Gaels and University of North Texas Mean Grean.

#### **SCOUTING THE MEAN GREEN**

- The Mean Green squad comes into the Hynes Center with a 3-4 overall record, earning wins against nationally ranked #17/18 Oklahoma, SMU, and IUPUI.
- Head Coach Jalie Mitchell is in the midst of her first year as the progarm's head coach
- North Texas has a balanced offensive attack with three starters averaging double-figures: Juniors Terra Ellison (10.0) and Candice Adams (11.3) and senior Acheil Tac (10.0).
- Mean Green enters the contest coming off of a 68-67 win against IUPUI. North Texas trailed by as many as 20 point, but gained the lead and held on off a three-point shot from the corner via the release of junior Kelsey Criner.

#### IONA VS. CURRENT CONFERENCE-USA MEMBERS

• The Gaels currently have an 0-8 record against current members of Conference USA. The Maroon & Gold hae gone up against Charlotte, Florida Atlantic, Florida International, Rice, and San Antonio.

#### LAST TIME OUT: Rutgers 58, Iona 33

- Iona dropped a 58-33 road decision to the Rutgers Scarlet Knights at The RAC on Wednesday, Dec. 9.
- Senior Aaliyah Robinson led the Gaels with 15 points off the bench, hitting four three-point field goals.
- Rutgers held Iona to 24.1% shooting for the game. The Maroon & Gold scored a season-low nine total points in the second half.

# Billi GODSEY

## Head Coach Hofstra '03 - Third Season

lona College announced the appointment of Billi Godsey as the seventh head coach of the women's basketball program in May of 2013. Godsey spent the previous two seasons as an assistant at Virginia Tech prior to the move to New Rochelle.

In her first season with the Gaels, Godsey led lona to a program record 26 wins and a share of its first MAAC Regular Season Championship. Her 26 wins are the most by a rookie head coach MAAC history.

In 2013-14, Godsey led the Gaels to a historic 18-game winning streak, the longest in school history. She became the first rookie coach to win the MAAC Coach of the Year honor since 1991. She led all first-time head coaches in NCAA Division I with her 26 overall wins and 18 victories in conference play.

For her efforts, Godsey was named the 2013-14 WBCA Spalding Maggie Dixon Division I Rookie Coach of the Year, given to the nation's top first year head coach, becoming the first mentor in MAAC history to claim the honor. Godsey was also named College Sports Madness Mid-Major Coach of the Year in 2014.

After finishing 15-15 in her second season with the Gaels, Godsey holds a 41-21 overall record; the mark is the best of any coach in program history during their first two seasons.

Hokies' head coach Dennis Wolff invited Godsey to join his staff after taking over the program in 2011-12. Virginia Tech improved its Atlantic Coast Conference mark in both seasons under Wolff and Godsey.

Prior to Tech, Godsey served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at UMBC under head coach Phil Stern for three seasons. During the 2010-11 campaign, the Retrievers finished 20-12 earning the America East regular season championship and a berth into the Women's NIT.

Godsey spent two seasons as an assistant at Molloy College in Rockville Centre, NY. Under the tutelage of Tim O'Hagan, she helped guide the Lions to their first-ever East Coast Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament in 2008. Molloy posted a 34-26 overall record in her two seasons on the bench.

While at Molloy, Godsey also served as an athletics administrator. She was the Lions' Associate Director of Athletics, Senior Woman Administrator and Compliance Officer. She joined the Molloy staff after two years in the conference office as Associate Commissioner for Operations and SWA for the ECC.

The Cheverly, MD native attended Archbishop Carroll High School and was a four-year letter winner at Hofstra. Godsey played in 79 games and made 28 starts from 1999-2003. She earned a bachelor's degree from Hofstra in psychology in May 2003 and a master's degree in psychology from Adelphi University in November 2005.

## Maroon & Gold Tame Broncs In MAAC Home Opeer, 59-46

- Junior Marina Lizarazu scored a team-high 19 points on six of nine shooting; also dished out six assists.
- Senior Aaliyah Robinson came off the bench and knocked down five three-point field goals, finishing with 17 points.
- Iona's major catalyst for the win came in the fourth quarter; Gaels used an 11-0 run and outscored the Broncs 26-12 in the final frame.

## Gaels Shine In MAAC Opener Against Preseason Favorite, Fairfield, 56-46

- Senior Joy Adams registered her third consecutive double-double with 16 points and 23 rebounds; it is the third highest single-game rebouding total in program history.
- Freshman Alexis Lewis came off the bench and scored 14 points; her third straight game with over 10 points.
- Gaels held the Stags to 28.1% shooting, and had a 40-12 points advantage in the paint.

## Joy Adams Climbs To Top Of MAAC Record Books

- In the opening minutes of the third quarter against USC (11/29/15), Joy Adams gathered her 1,218th career rebound. She now stands as the leading rebounder in Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference history.
- Adam's next milestone to pursue will be the alltime Iona record held by Linda McKetney, who boarded 1,430 in her Maroon & Gold career.

#### Iona Earn First Win Of 2015-16

- After falling to Yale and UNC in the opening two games of the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame Challenge, the Gaels found their winning footing against Fairleigh Dickinson.
- The Maroon & Gold dominated the Knights, 77-54. Senior Joy Adams had 20 points, and Aaliyah Robinson tied a career-high with six three-point field goals.

#### Gaels Fall In Home-Opener

• Iona dropped its first game at the Hynes Athletics Center against Virginia Commonwealth, 74-58. In the loss, junior Marina Lizarazu registered seven assists and 13 points, and freshman Treyanna Clay poured in a teamhigh 15 points and coralled seven rebounds.

#### Marina Lizarazu Shines In Season Opener

#### Ashlee Kelly Honored By MAAC

- The Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference honored Associate Head Coach Ashlee Kelly on July 20, announcing her as a member of the 2015 Basketball Hall of Fame Honor Roll Class.
- Kelly had a highlight career at the University of Quinnipiac; averaging double-digit points all four years, and was the second Bobcat player ever to record over 1,000 points and rebounds.
- Iona's own former star Toni Horvath-Killeen was inducted in the class the Gaels' representative; she was a two-time All-MAAC honoree, earning selection to the Third Team in both her junior and senior seasons, and graduated as program's all-time leader in assists.




#### What Is A Gael?


